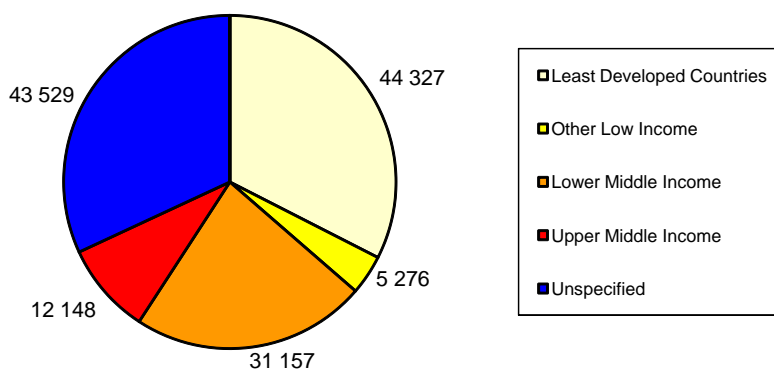

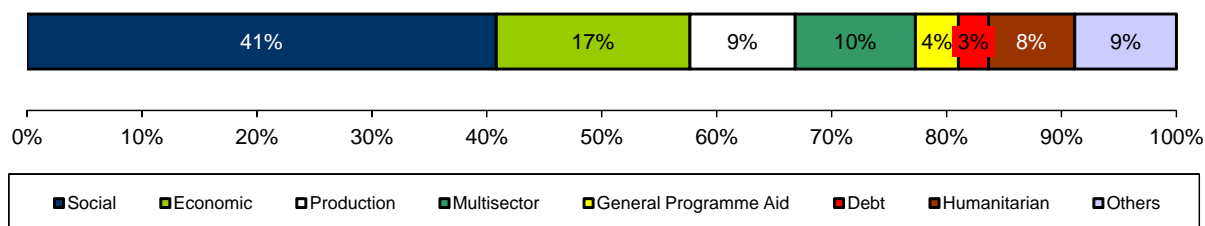
1.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2011, net disbursements

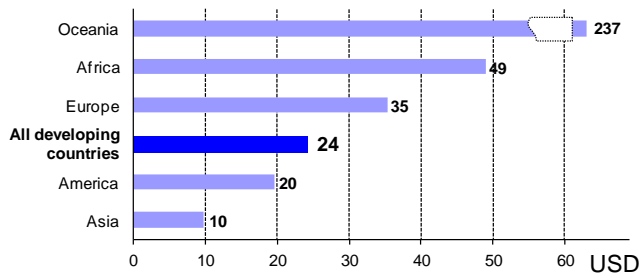

1.1.5. Sectors in 2011 commitments



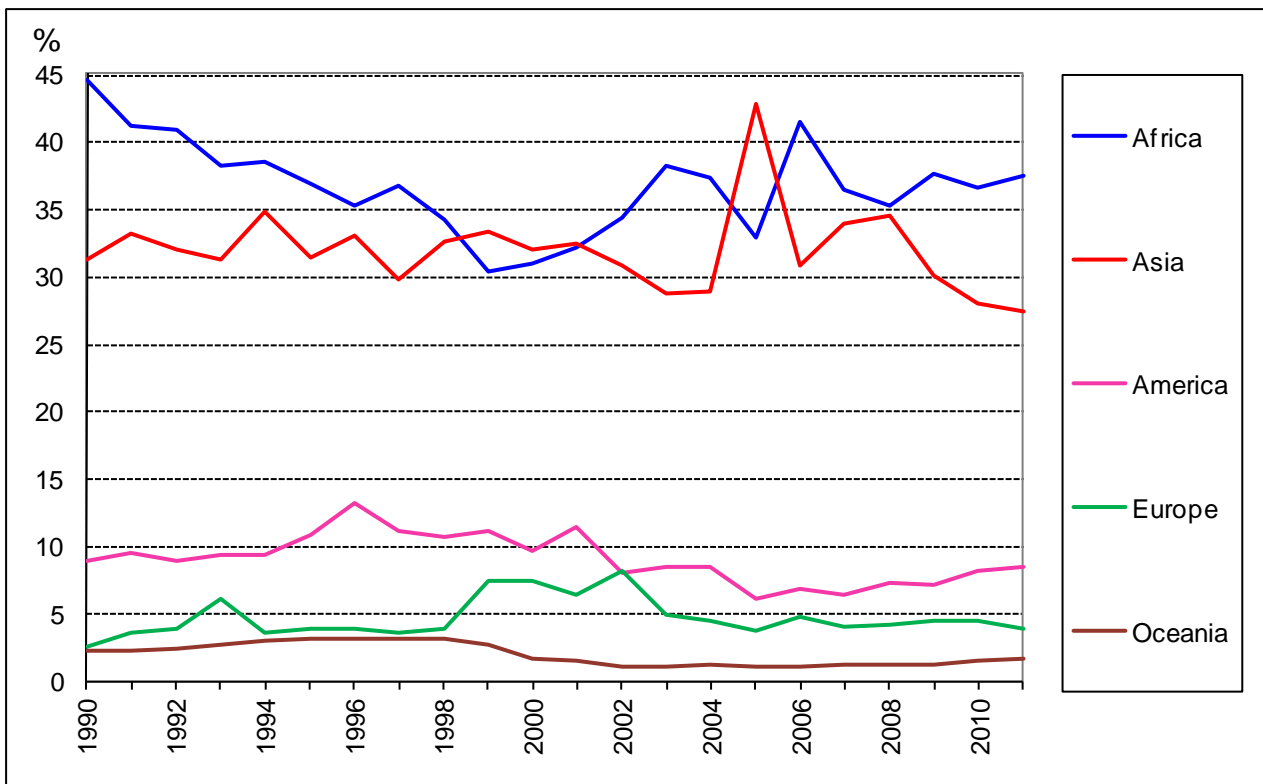
1.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2011

As a percentage of total ODA



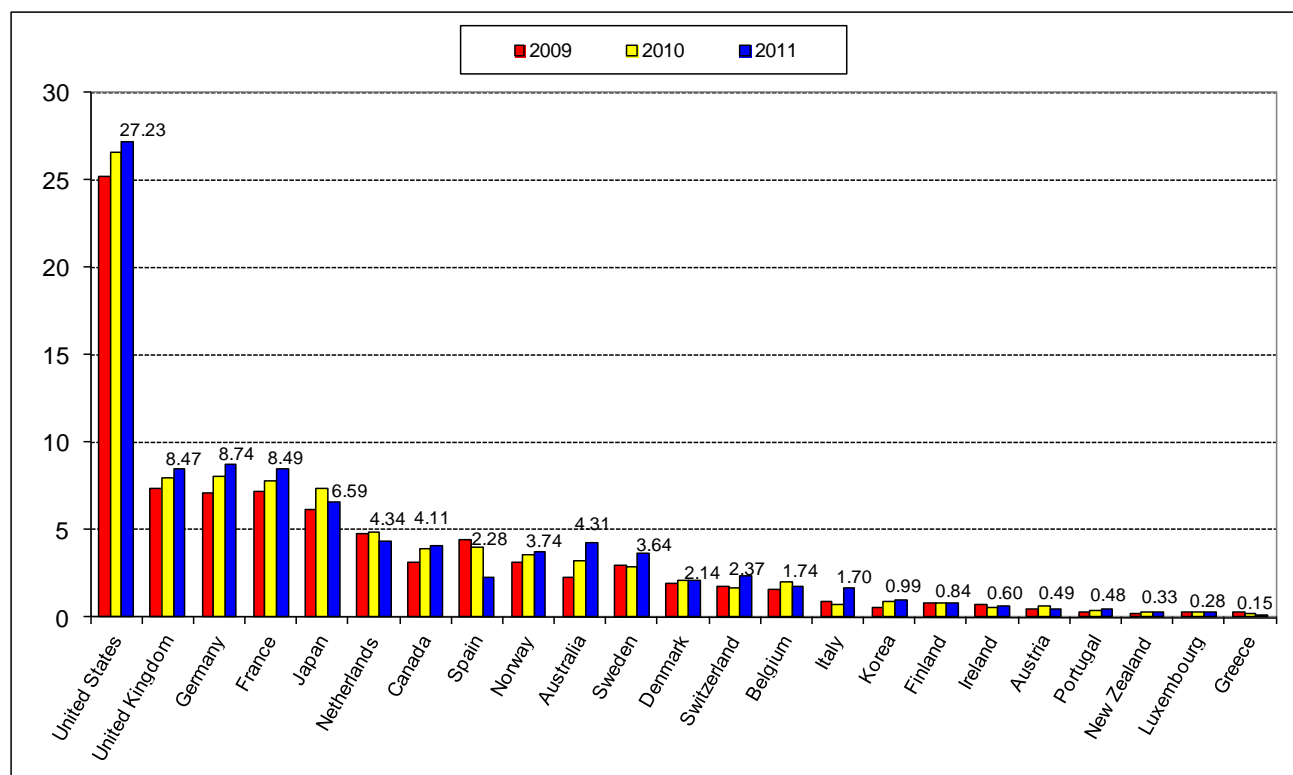

USD billion, values shown for 2011, net bilateral disbursements



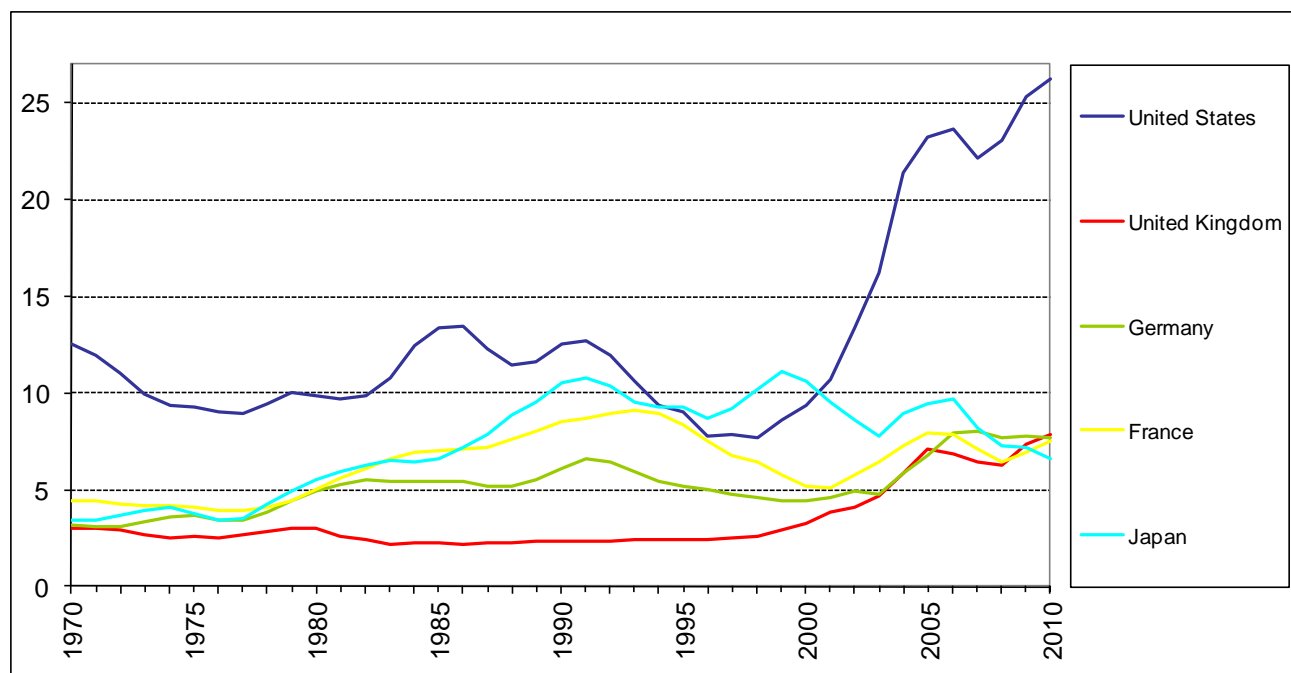

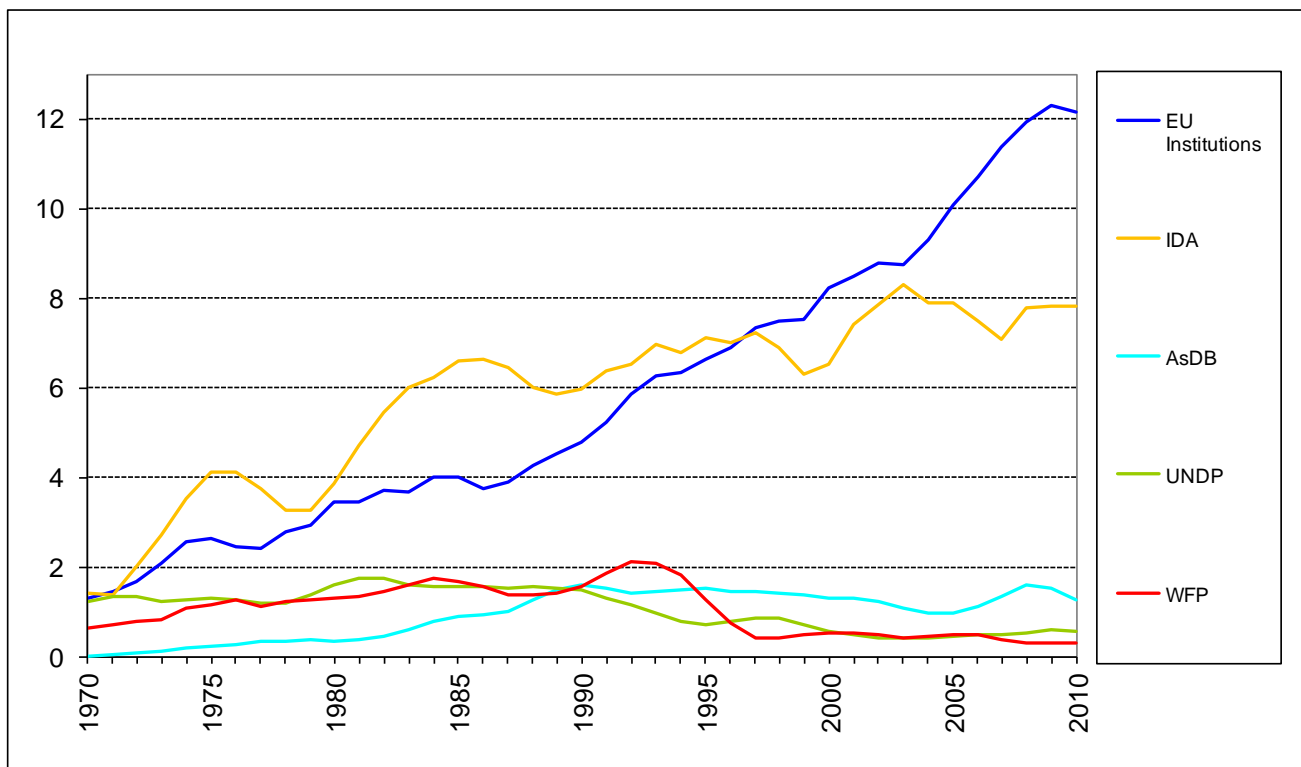
USD billion, 2010 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net bilateral disbursements

USD billion, 2010 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net disbursements



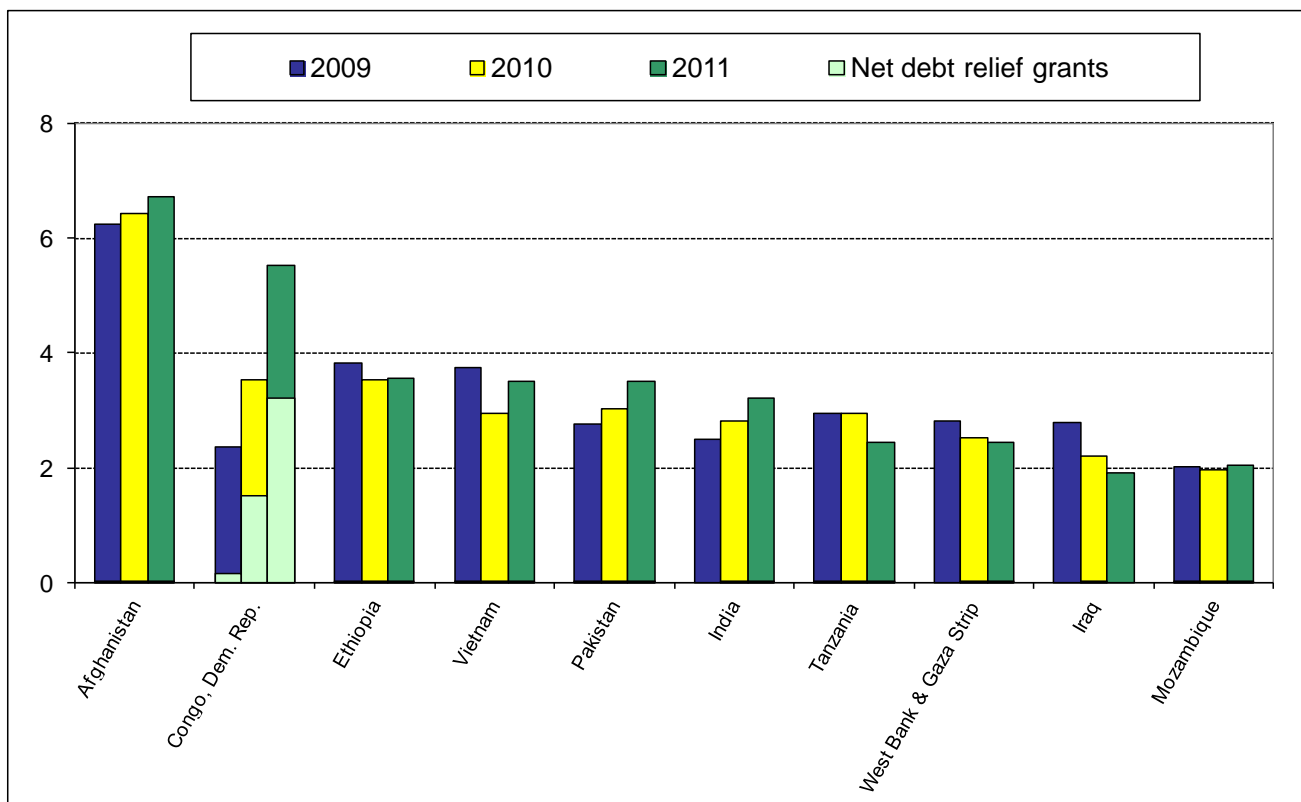

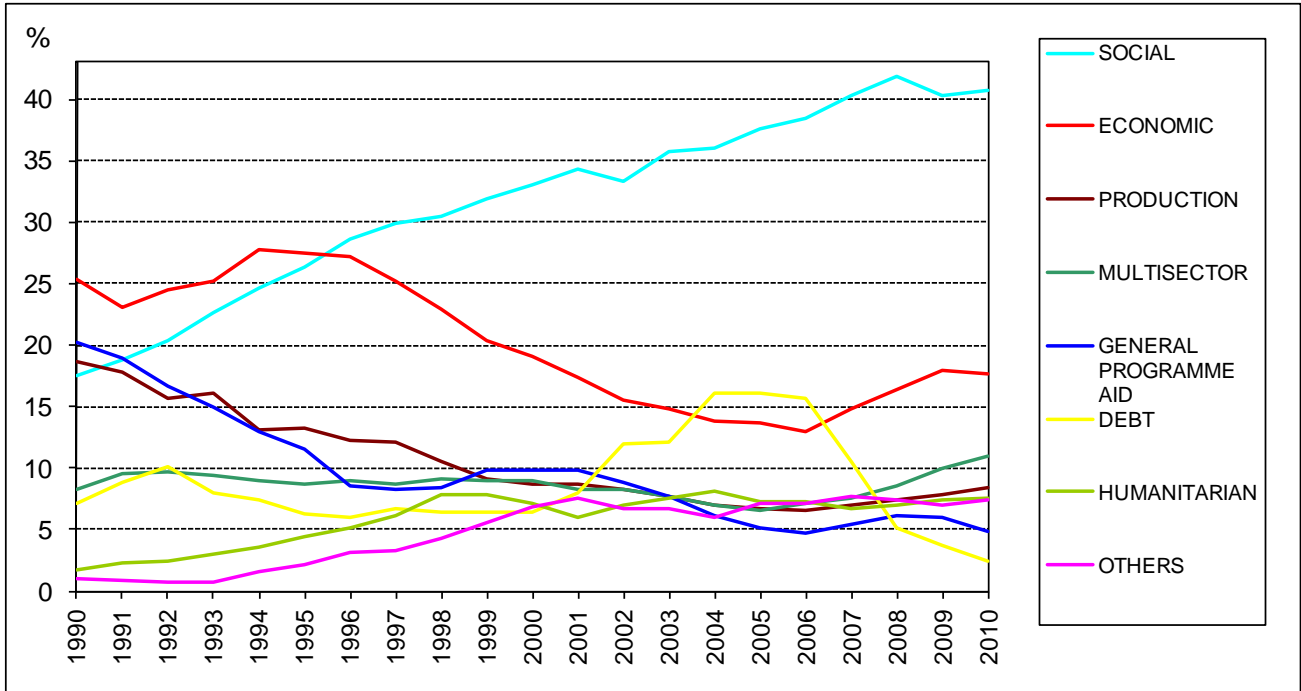
1.2.10. Trends in aid to largest recipients since 1970

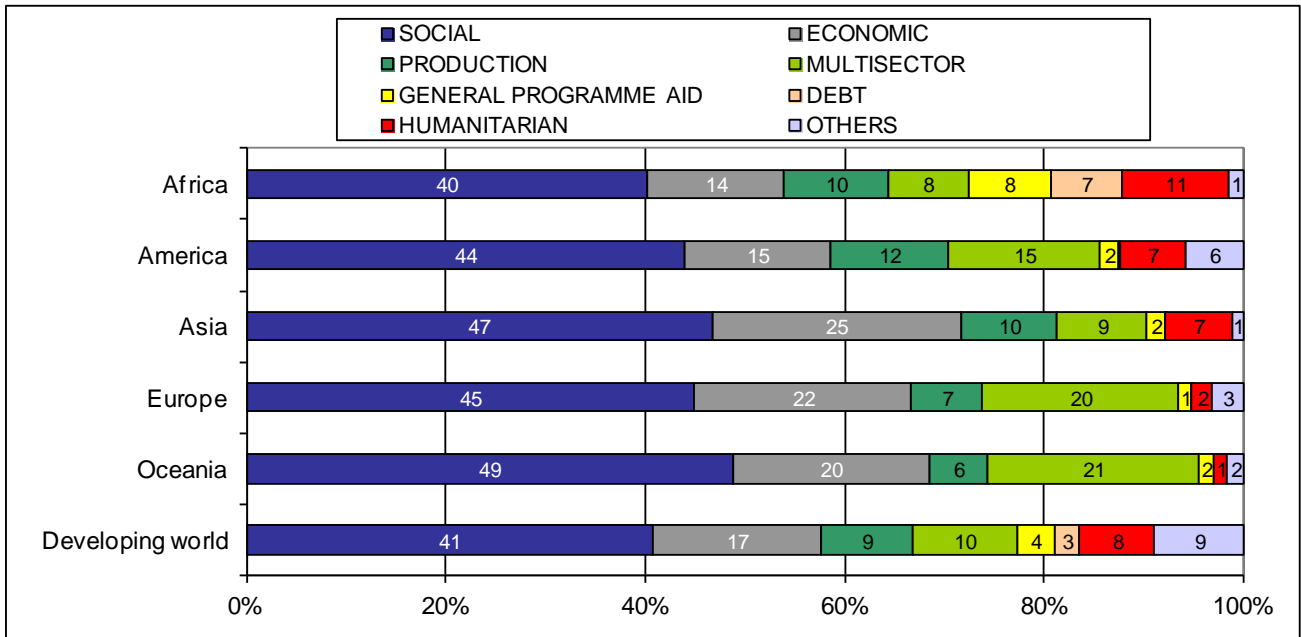
1.3.1. ODA by sector since 1990

As a percentage of total ODA for each region

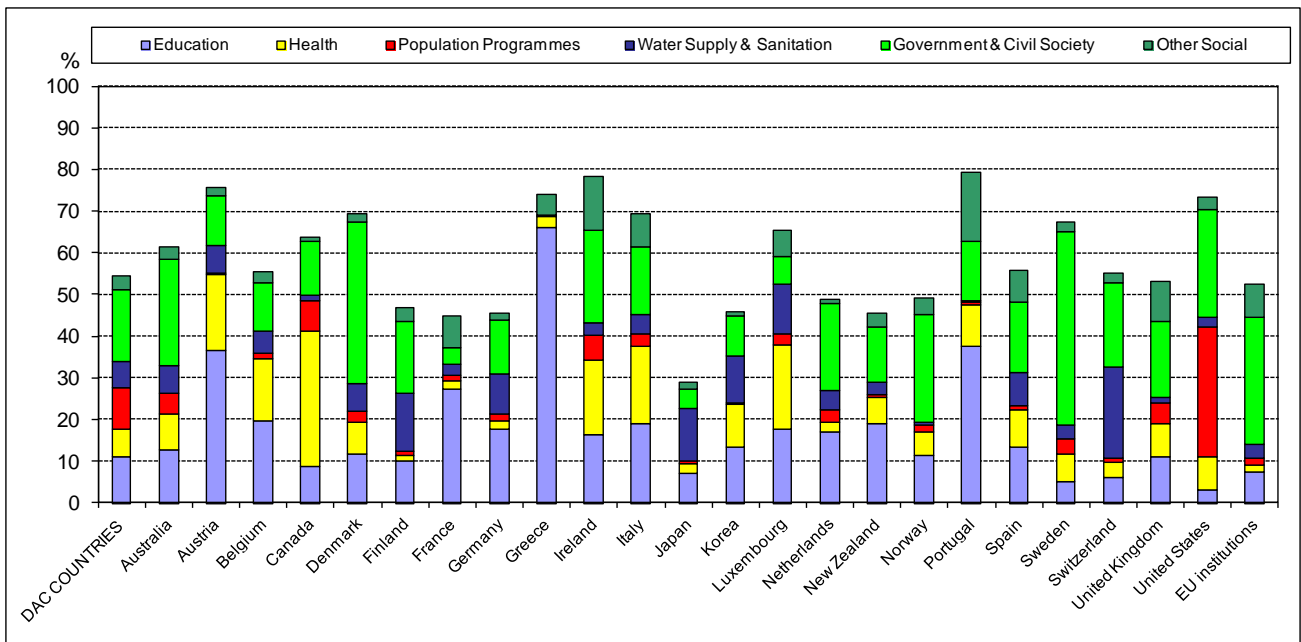

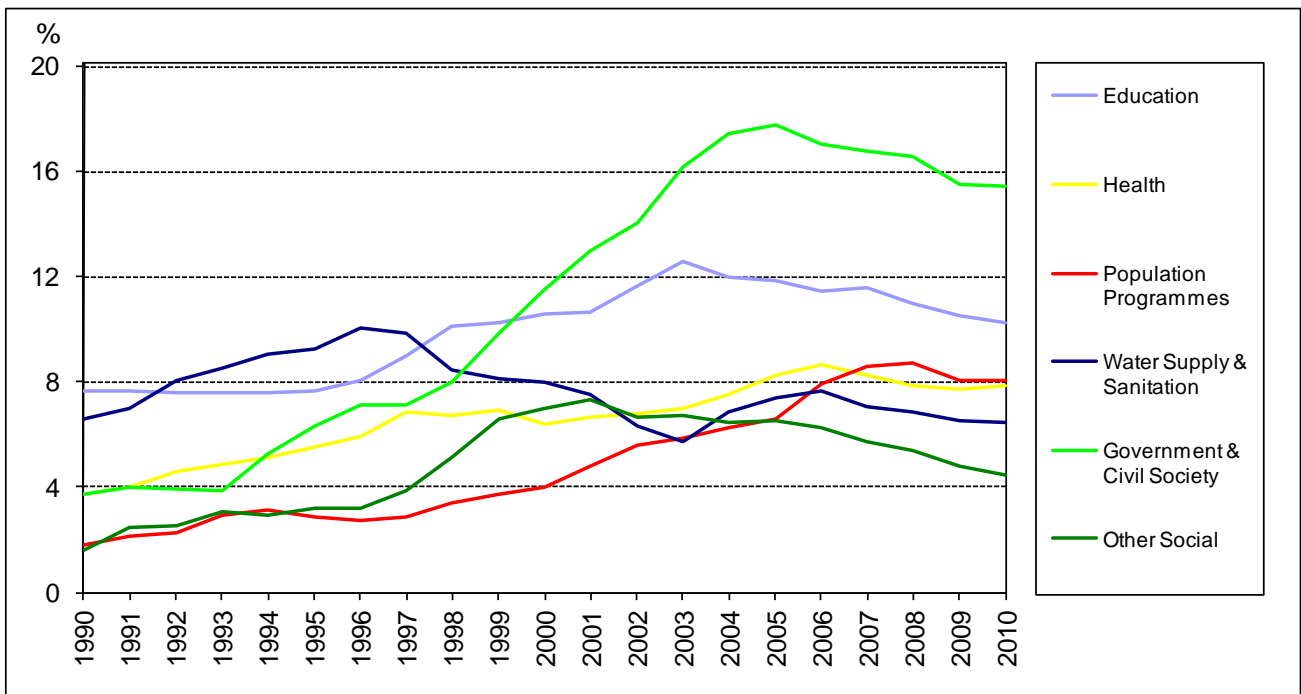

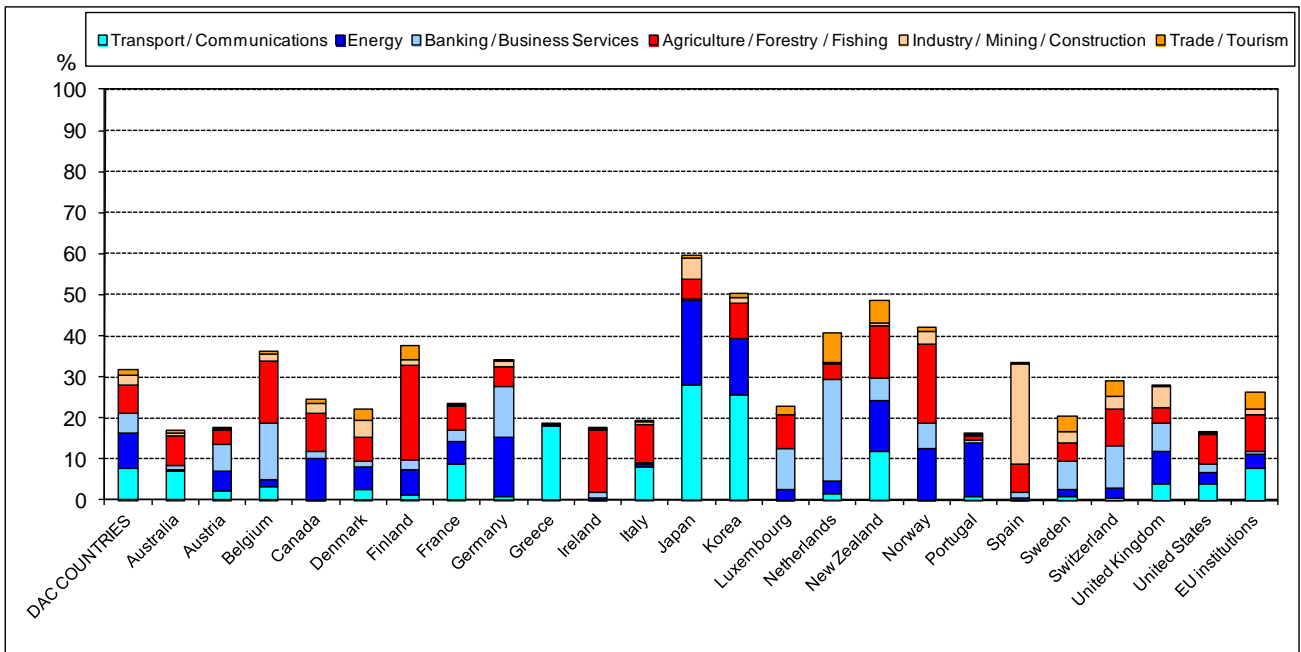
1.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA by donor
As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2011



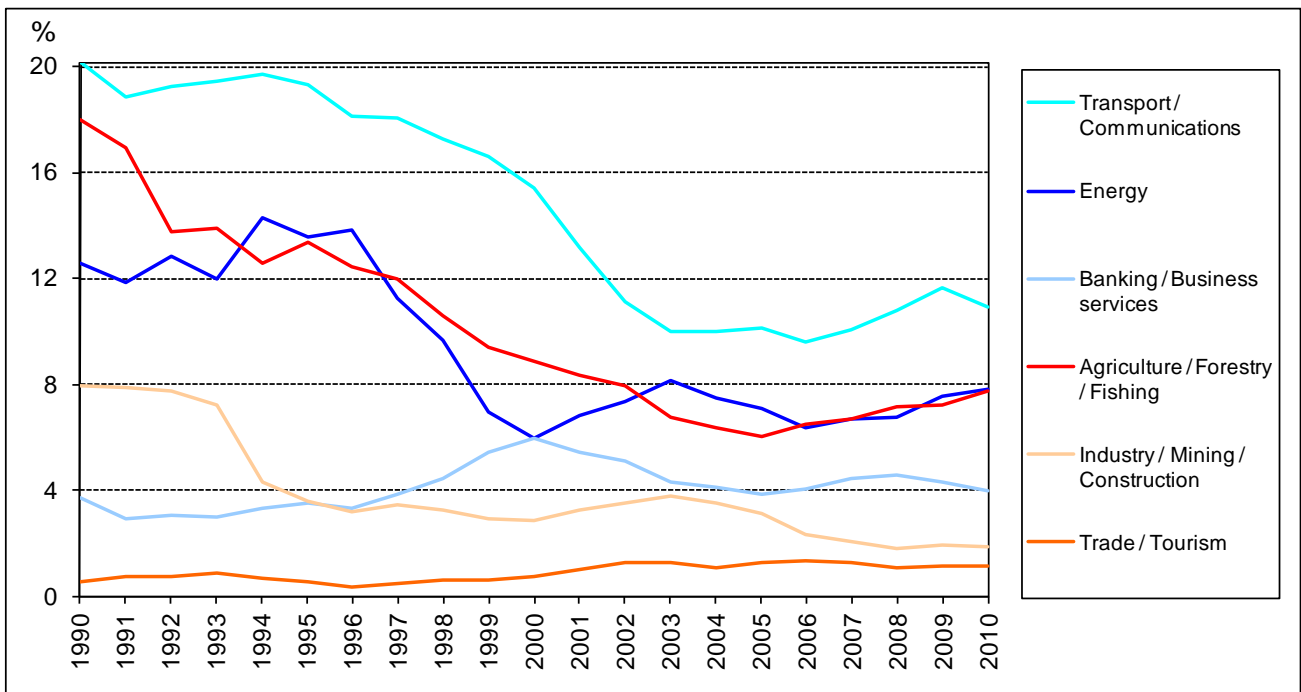
1.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA since 1990

As a percentage of total sector-allocable ODA, 3-year average commitments



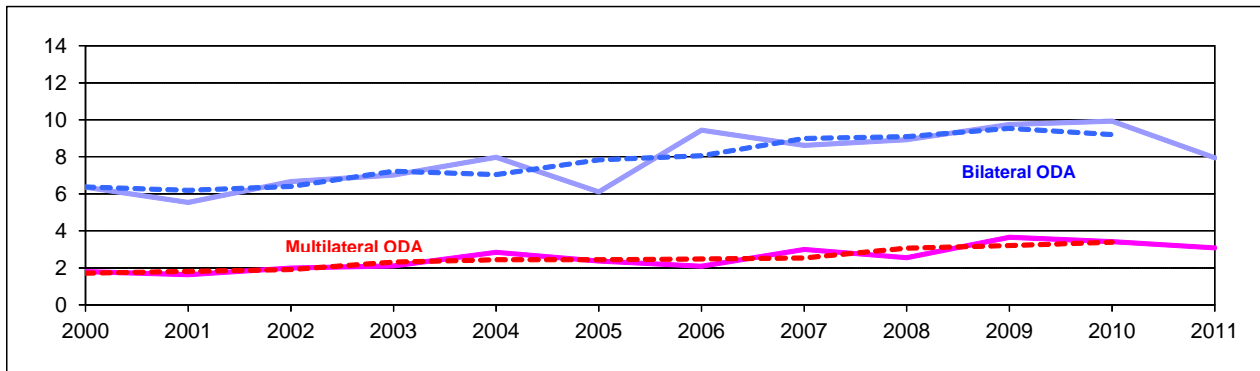

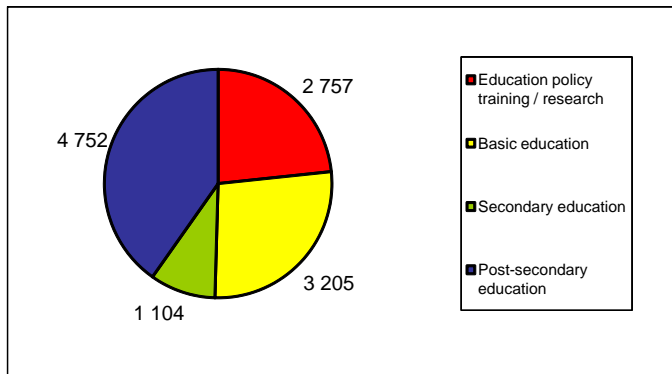

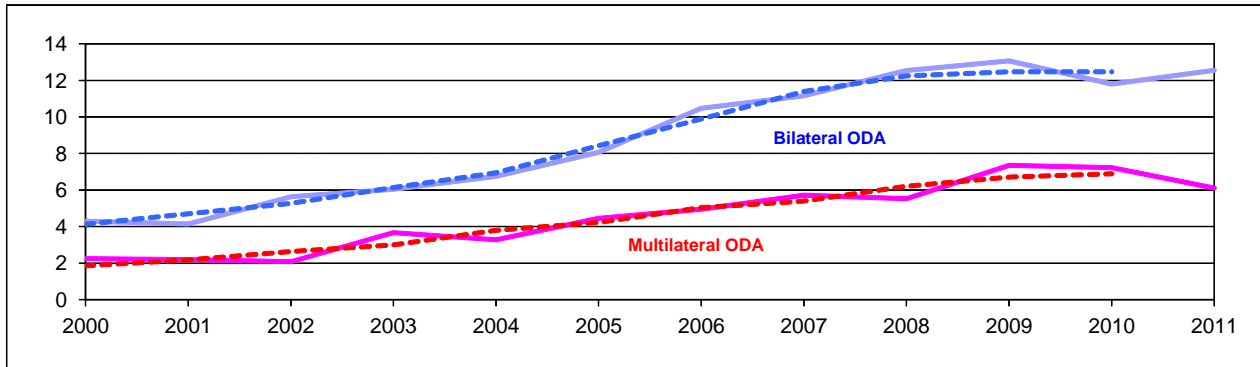

USD billion, 2010 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving average

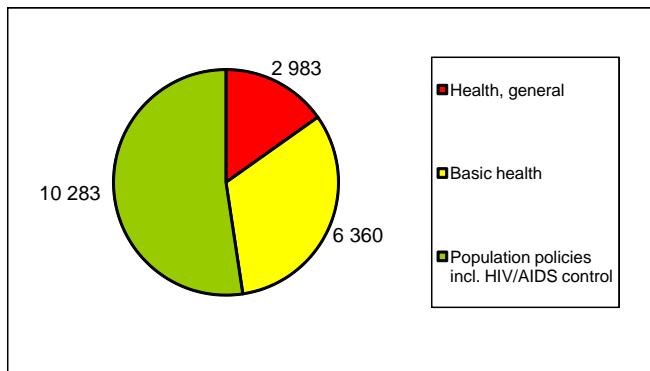

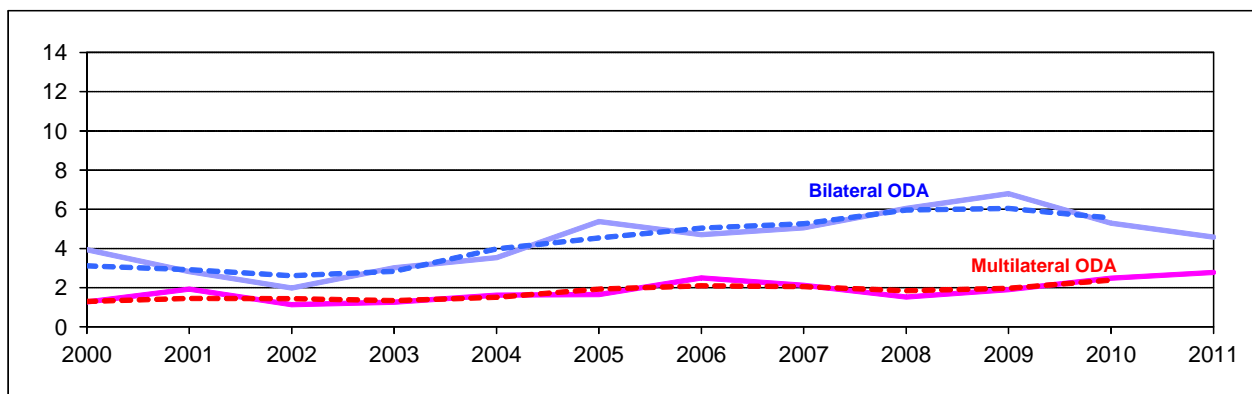

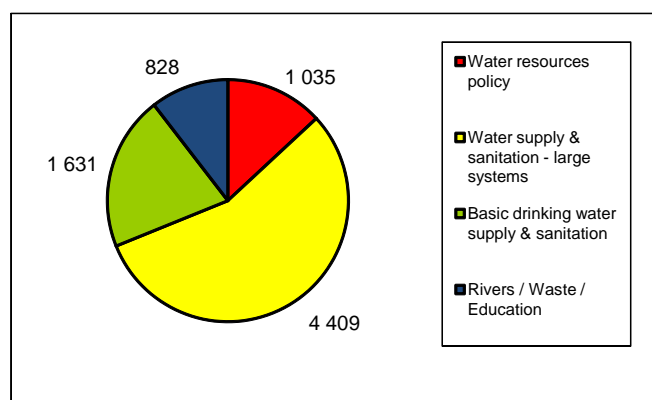
