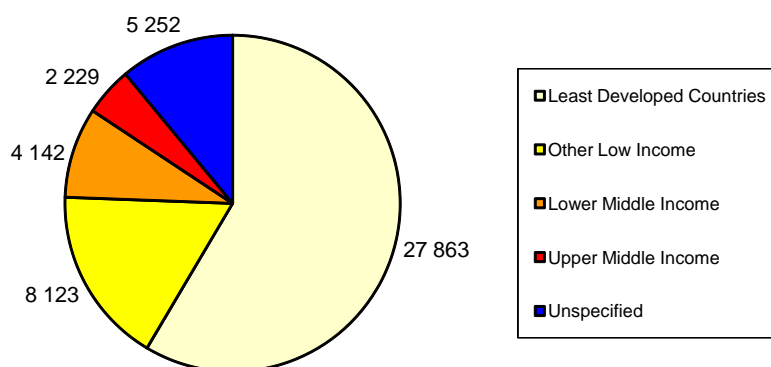

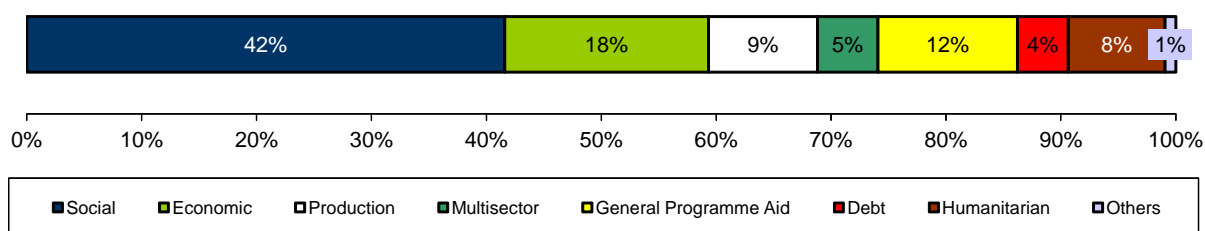
2.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2009, net disbursements



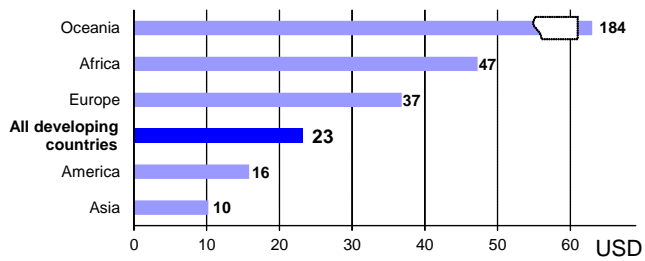

2.1.5. Sectors in 2009 commitments



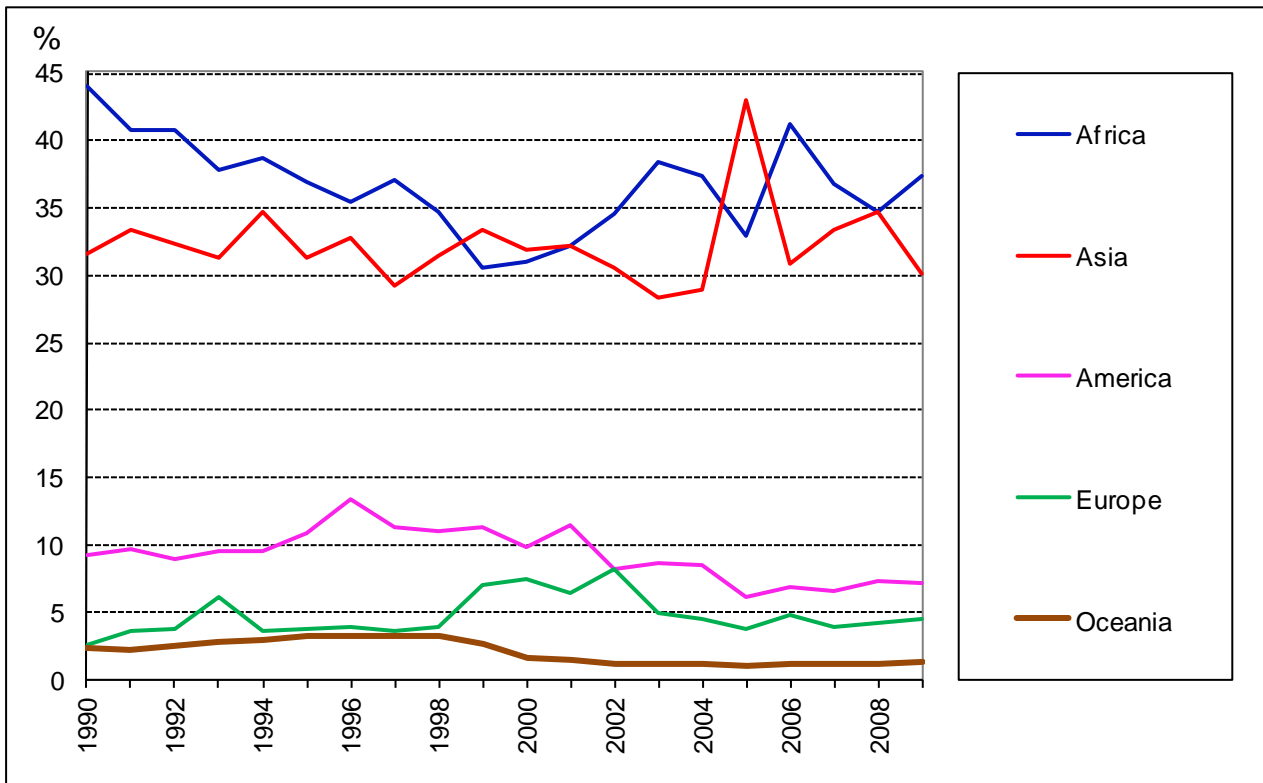
2.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2009

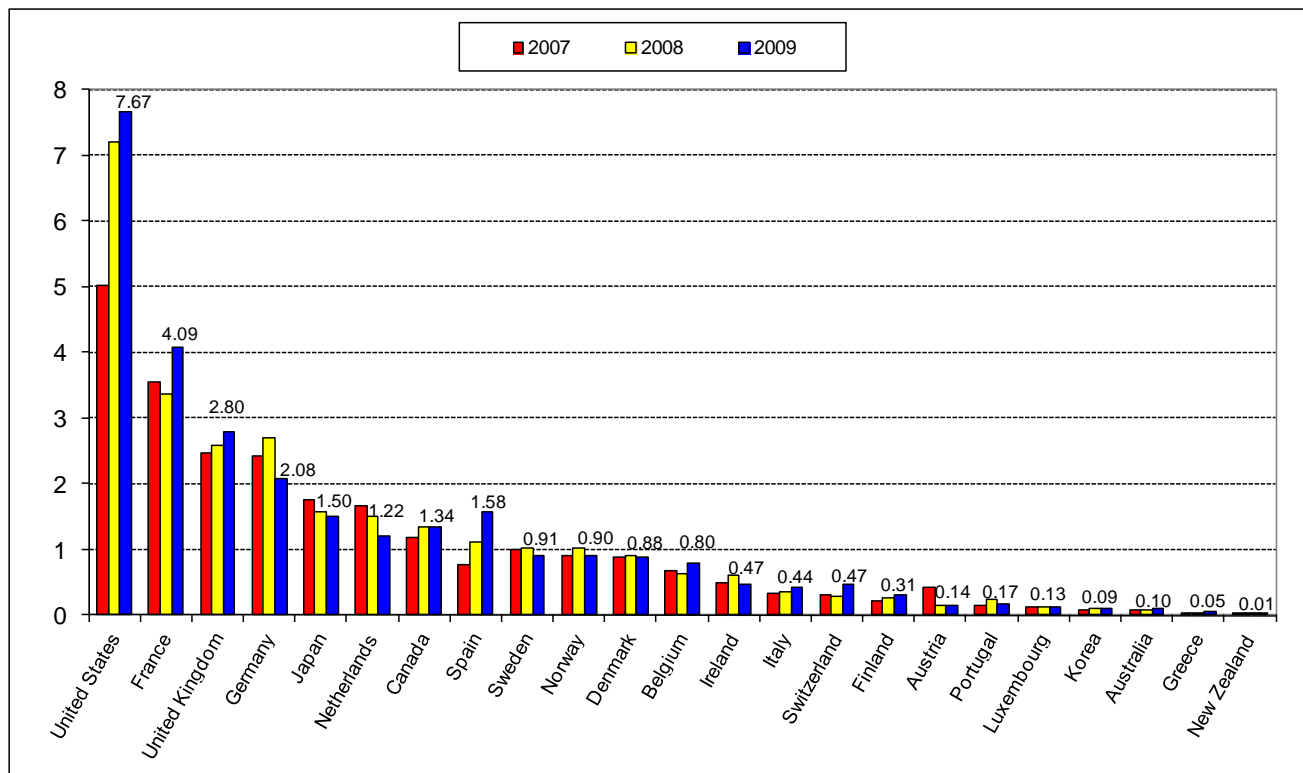

2.2.2. DAC donor countries' aid to Africa USD billion, values shown for 2009, net bilateral disbursements



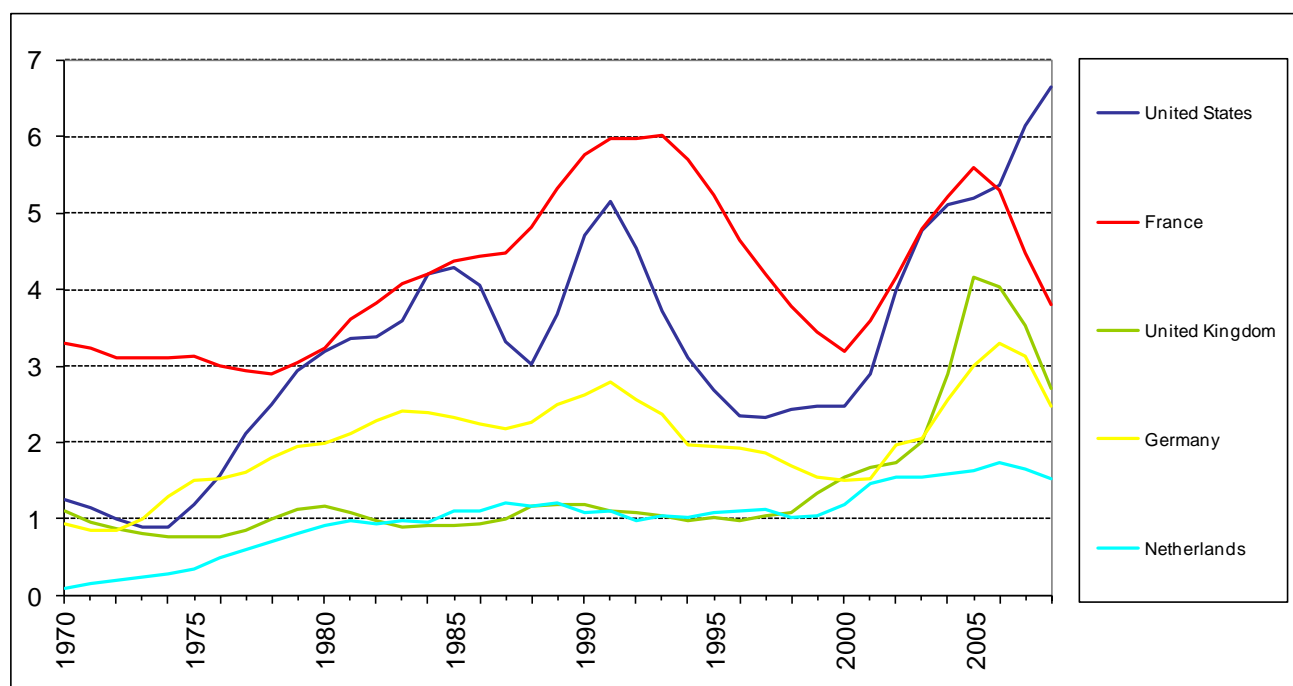

2.2.4. ODA to Africa by largest bilateral donors since 1970

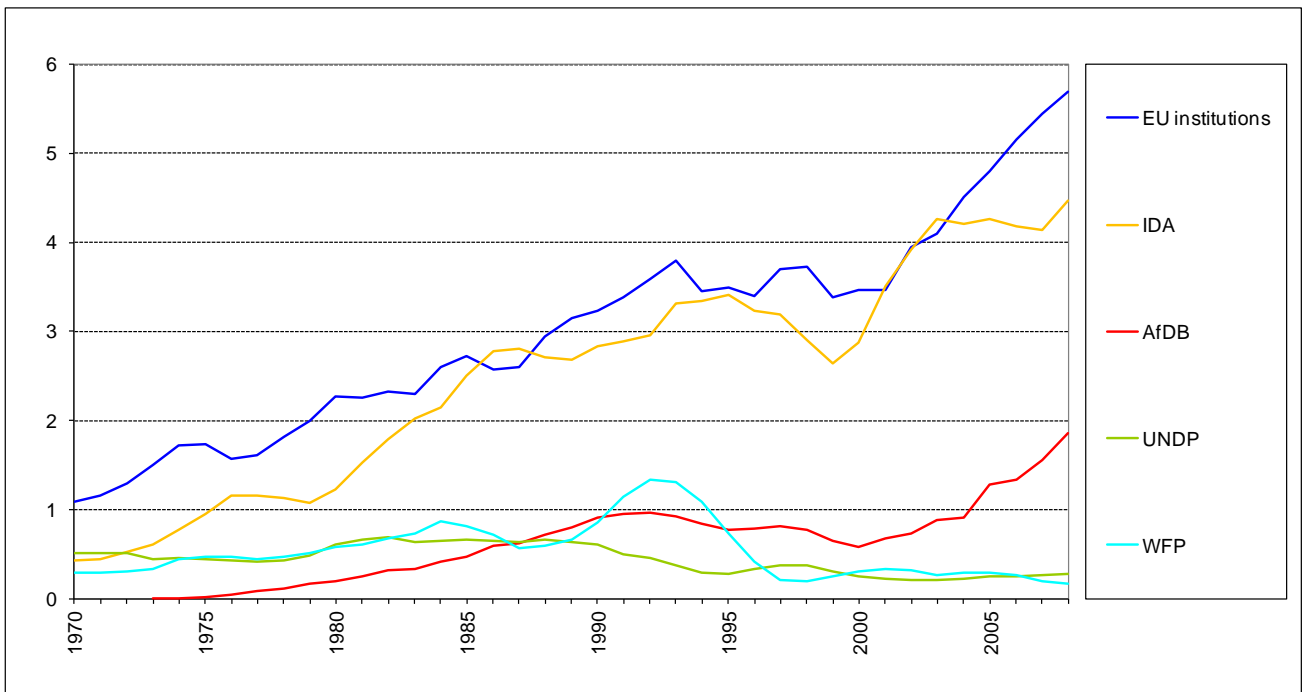
USD billion, 2008 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net bilateral disbursements

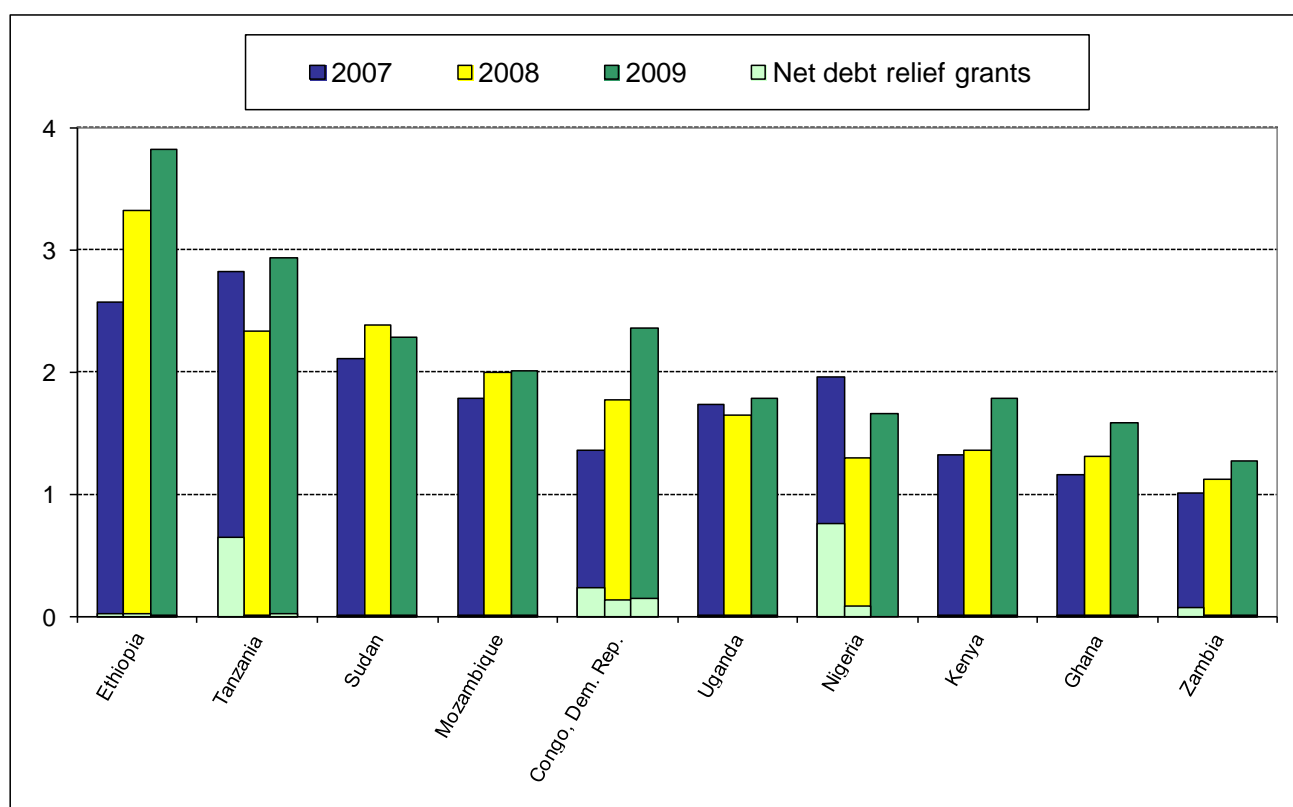
2.2.6. ODA to Africa by largest multilateral donors since 1970

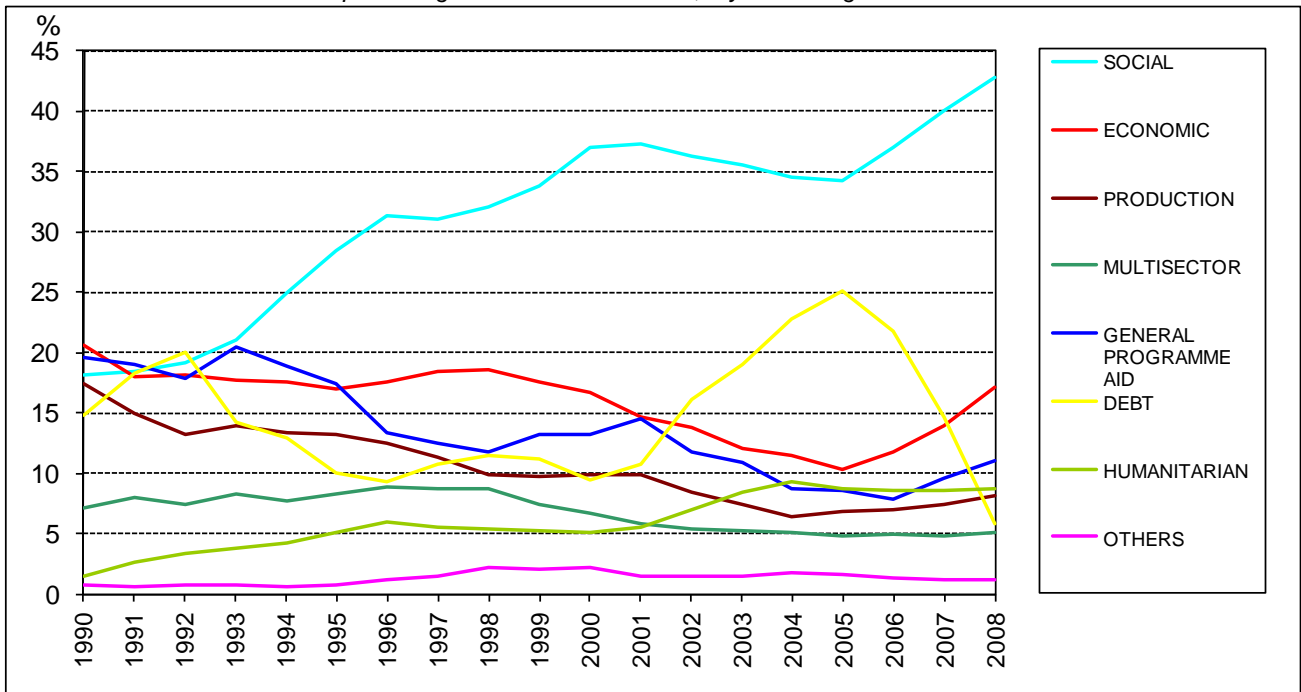
2.2.10. Trends in aid to largest African recipients since 1970

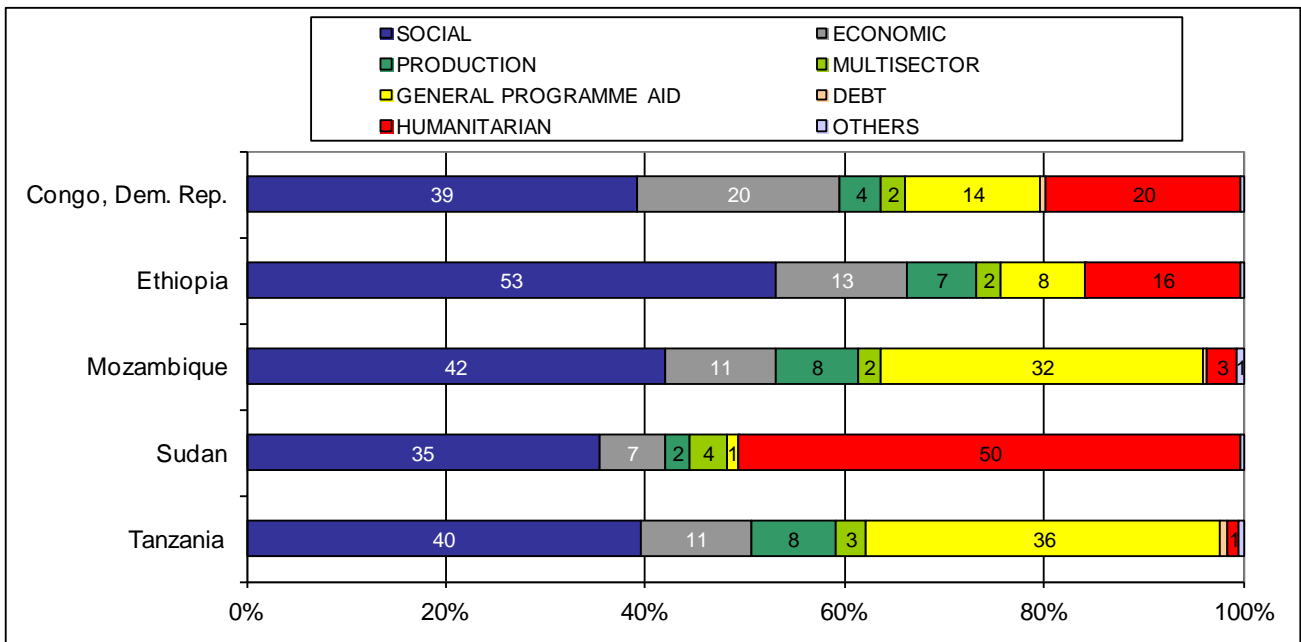
2.3.1. ODA to Africa by sector since 1990

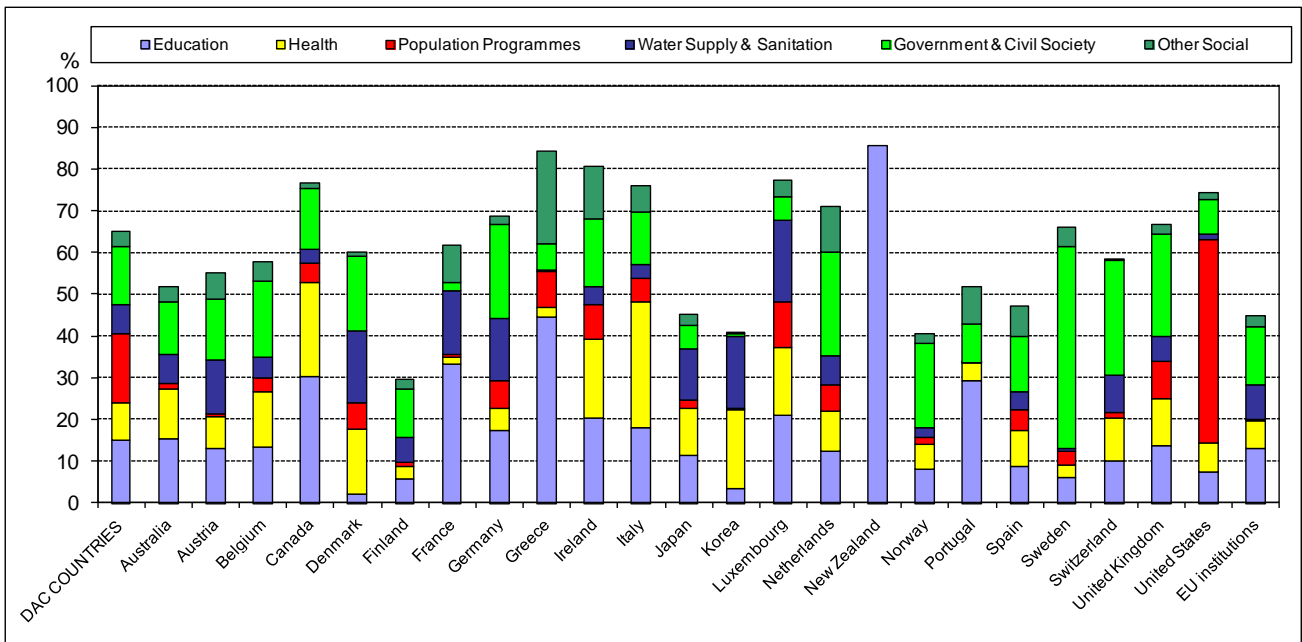

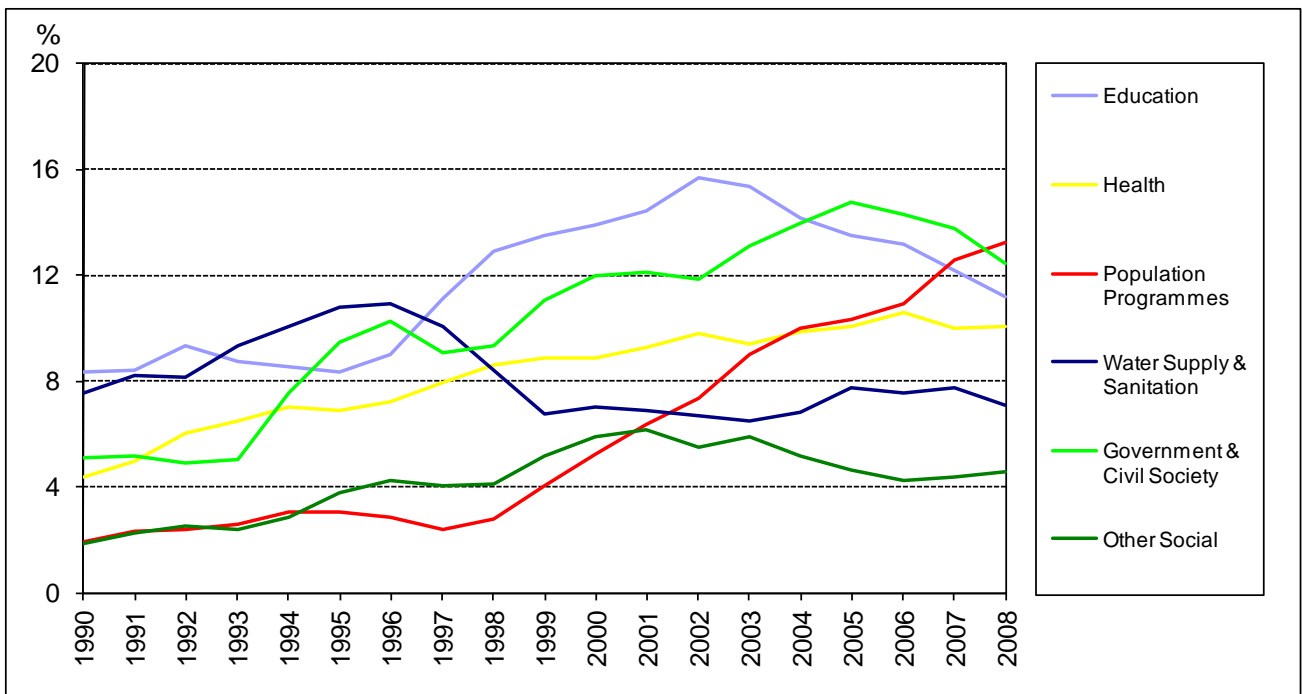

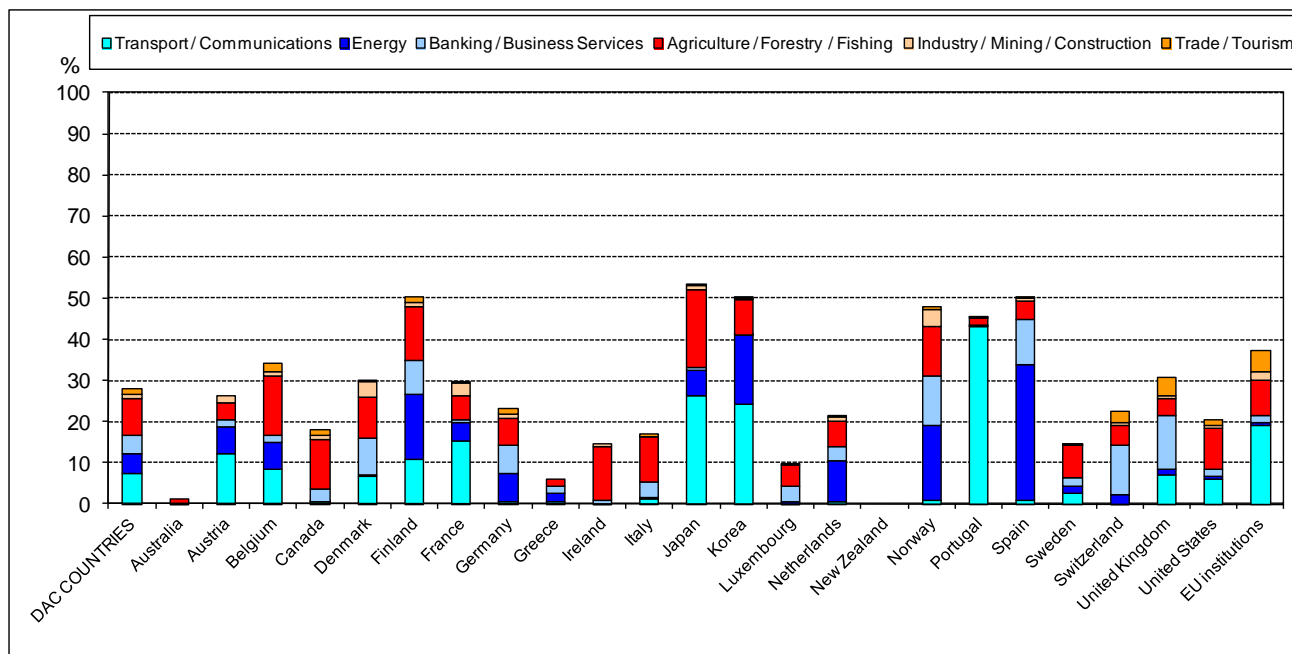
2.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA to Africa by donor
As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2009



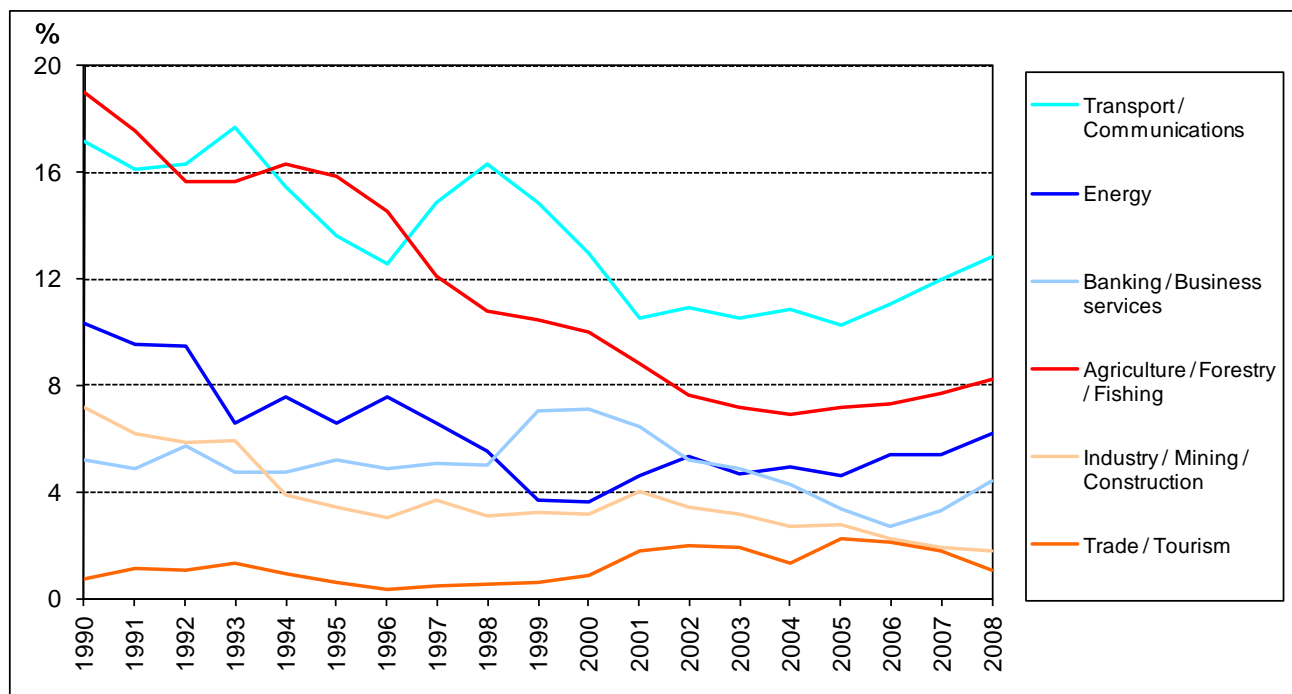
2.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA to Africa since 1990

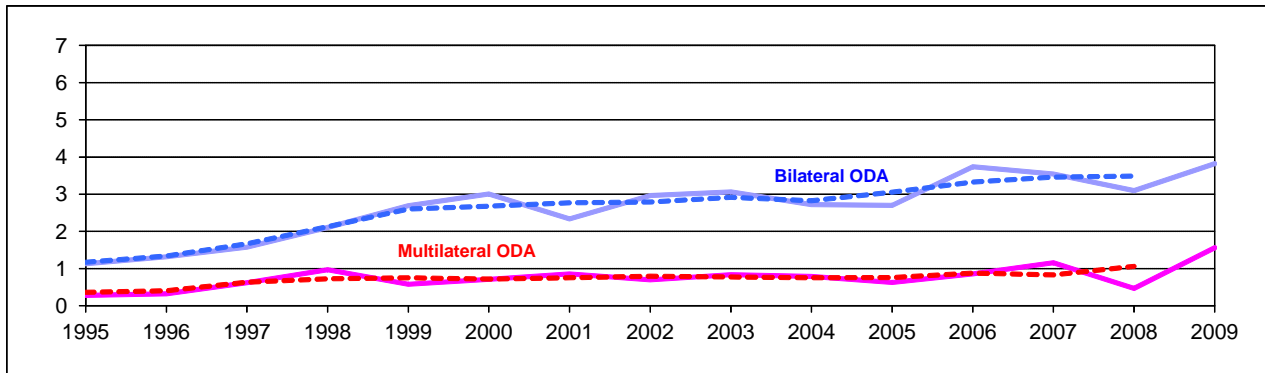

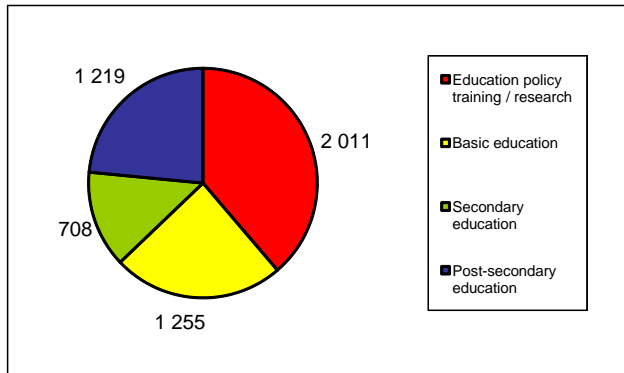

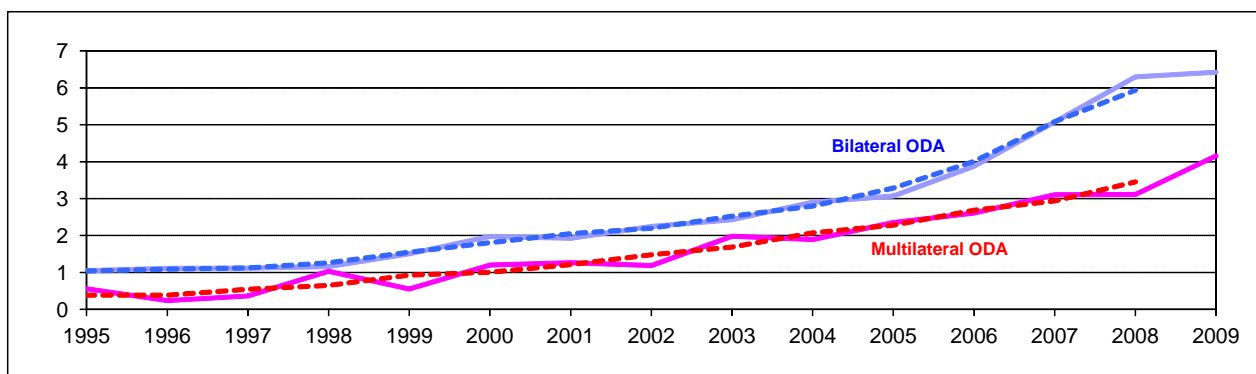

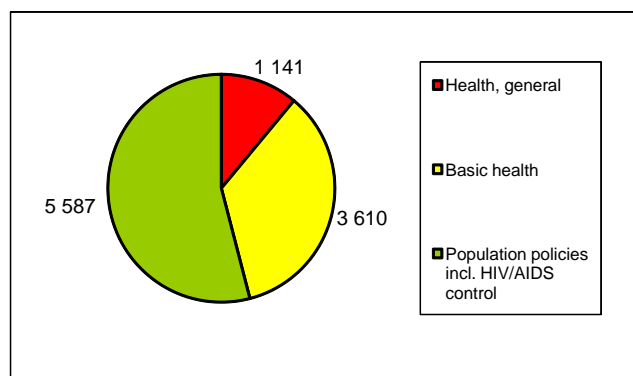

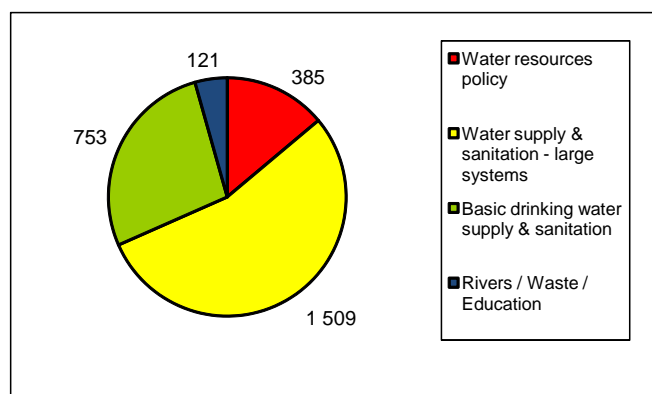
