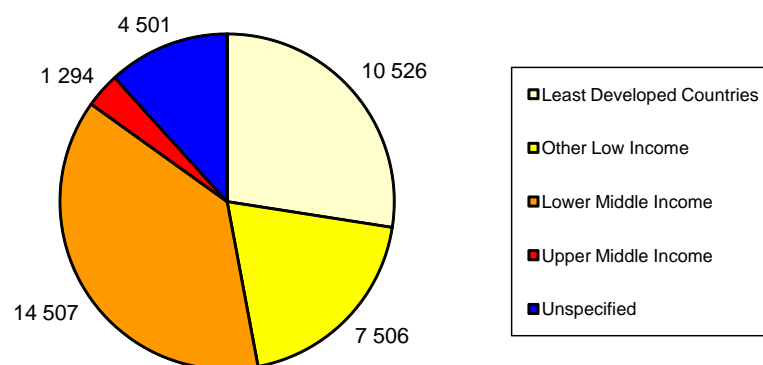

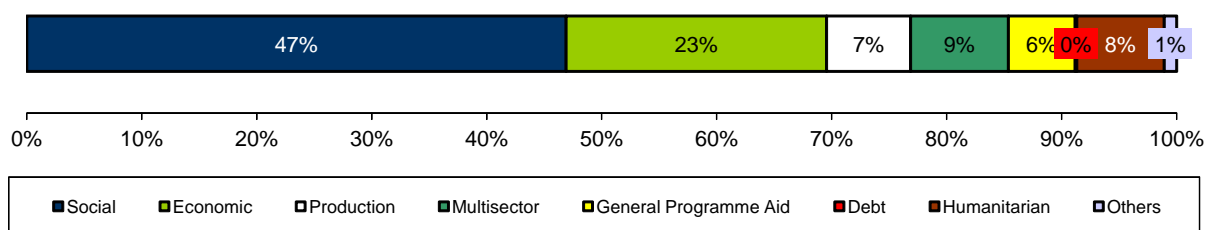
4.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2009, net disbursements



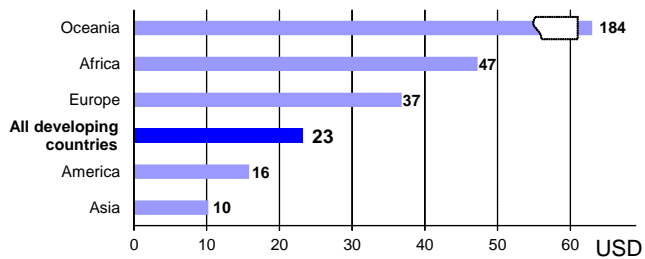

4.1.5. Sectors in 2009 commitments



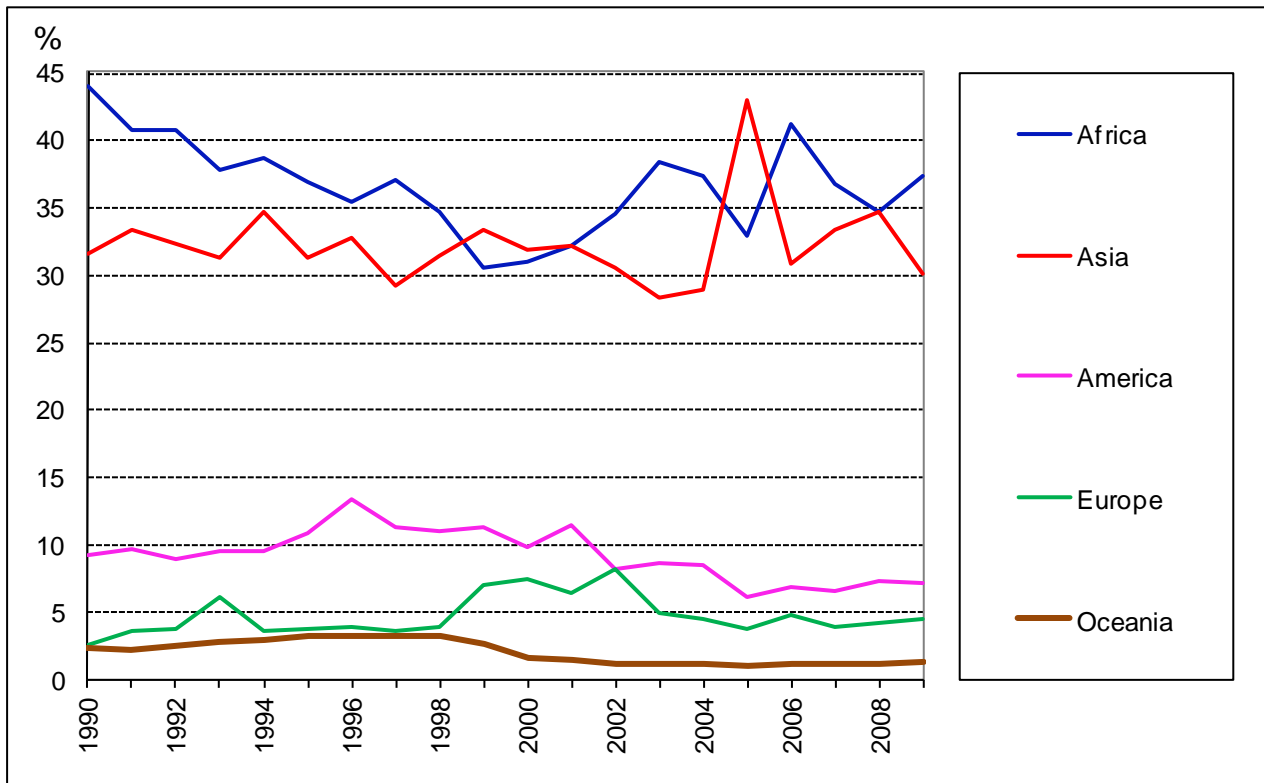
4.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2009

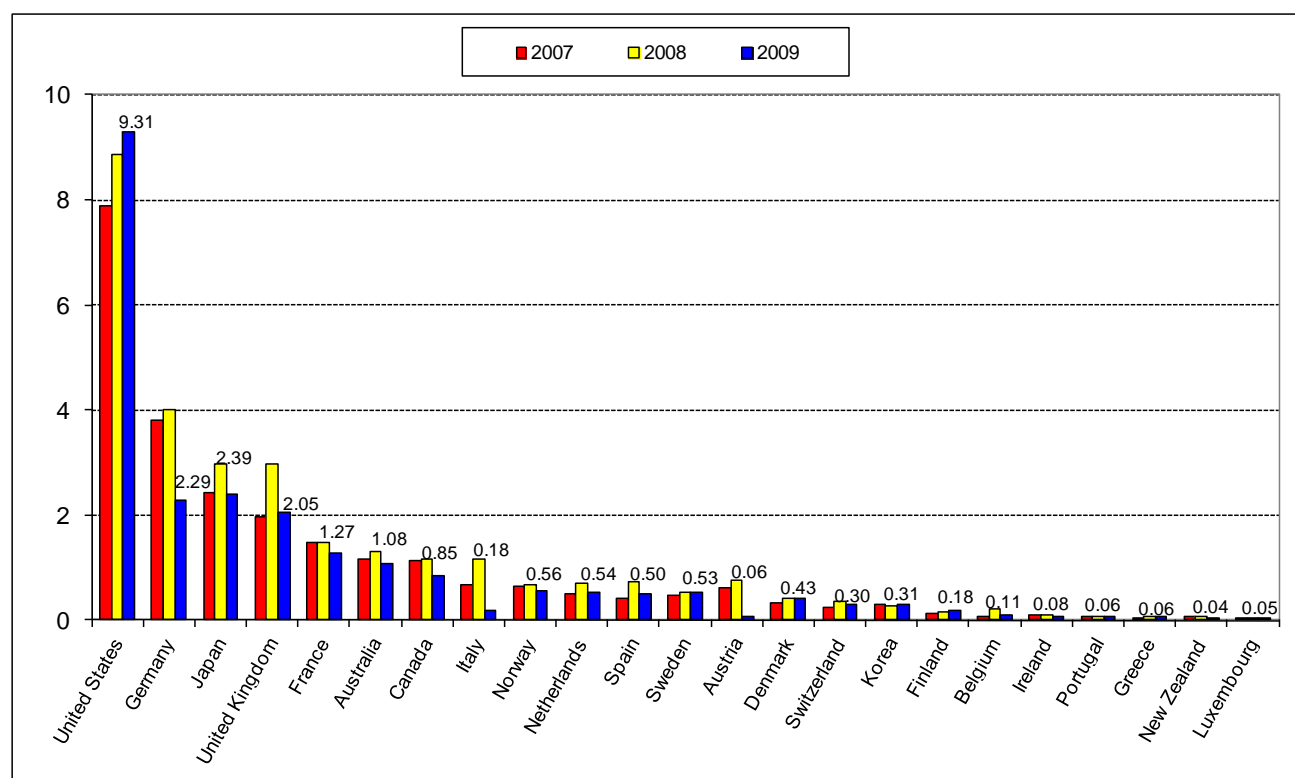

USD billion, values shown for 2009, net bilateral disbursements



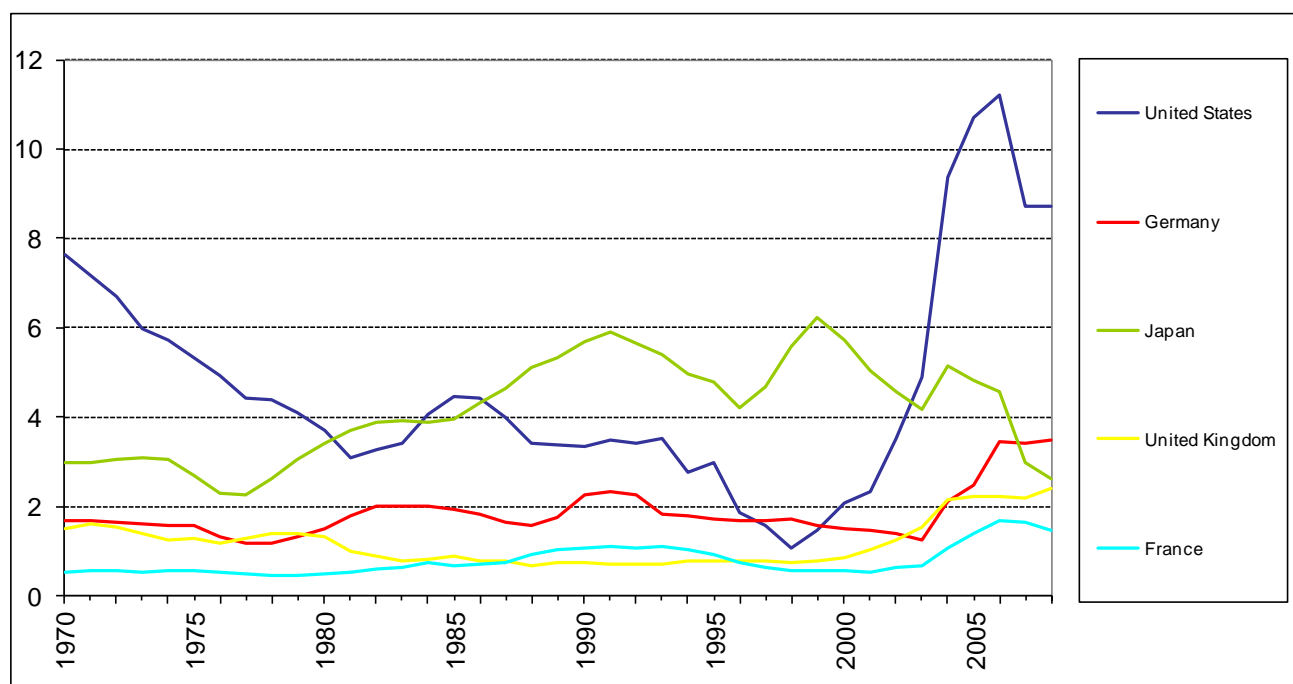

4.2.4. ODA to Asia by largest bilateral donors since 1970

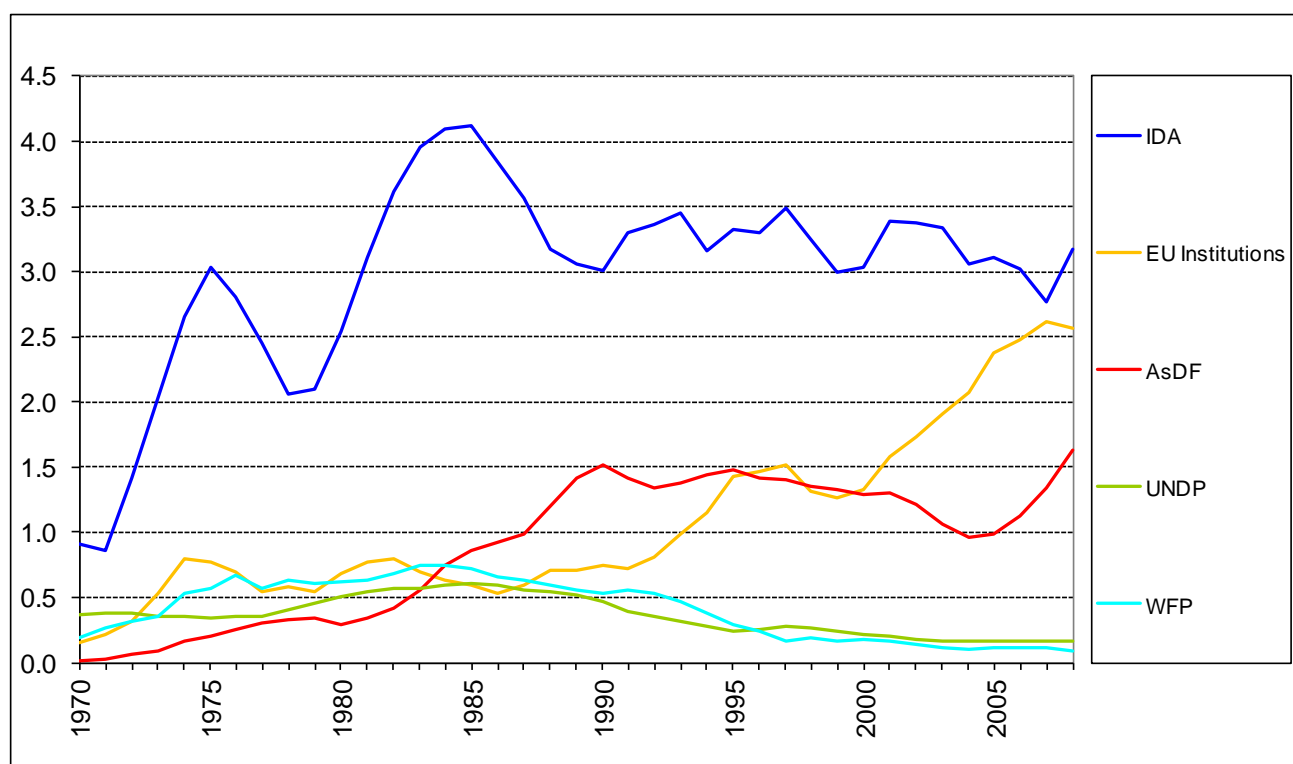
USD billion, 2008 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net bilateral disbursements

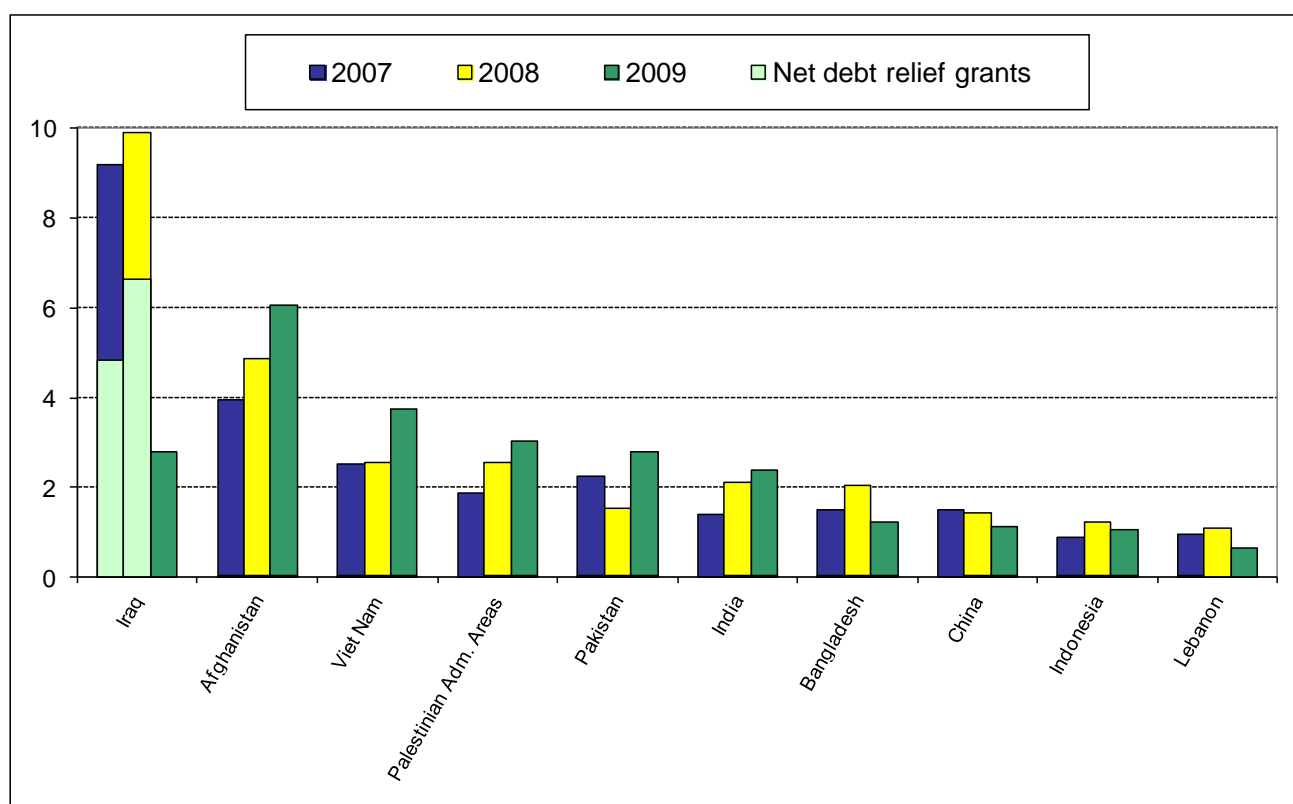
4.2.6. ODA to Asia by largest multilateral donors since 1970

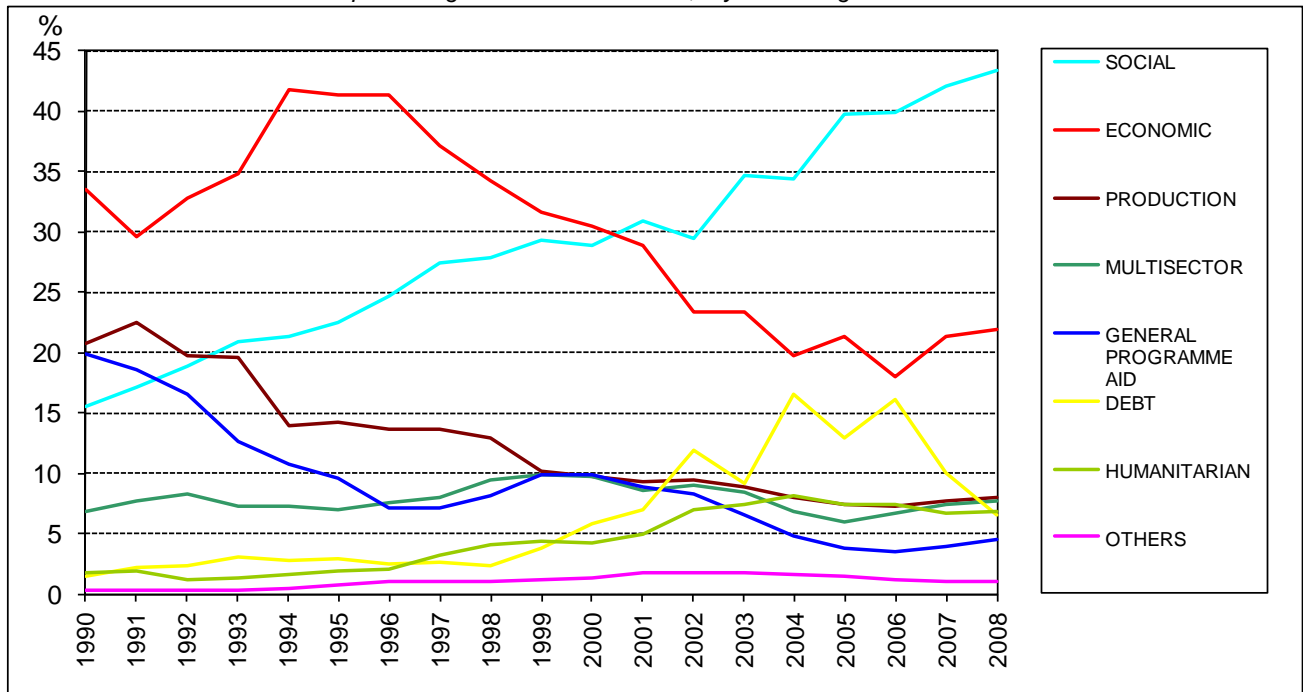
4.2.10. Trends in aid to largest Asian recipients since 1970

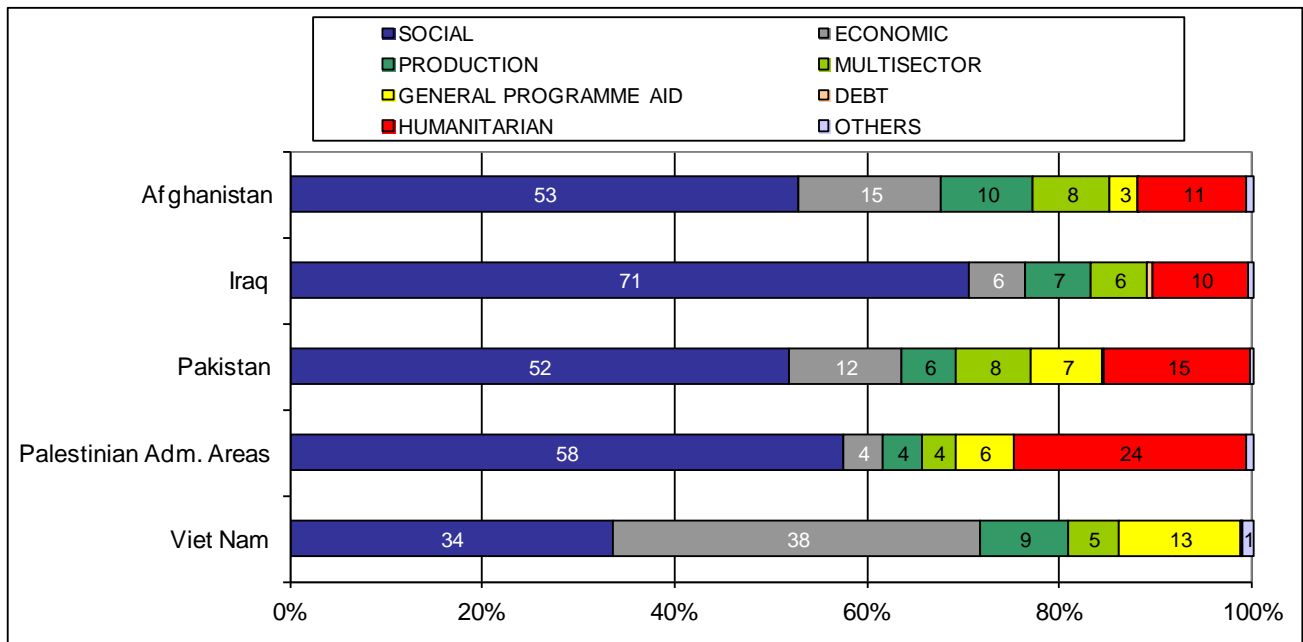
4.3.1. ODA to Asia by sector since 1990

4.3.2. ODA to 5 largest recipients in Asia by sector in 2009

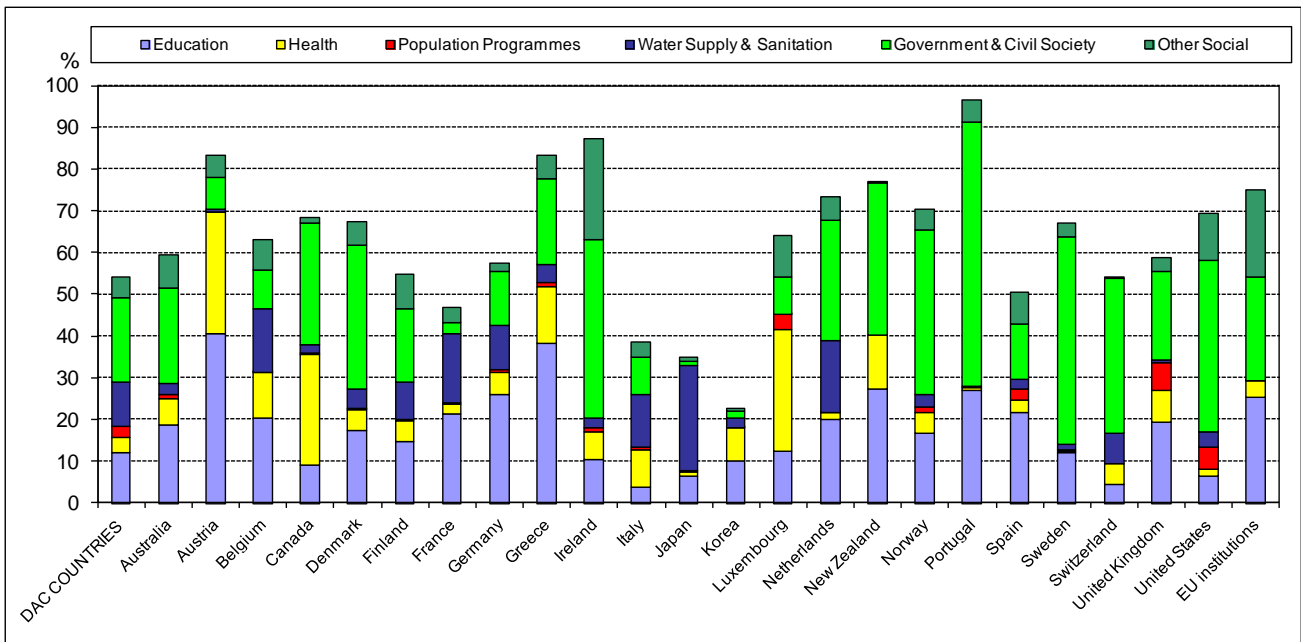

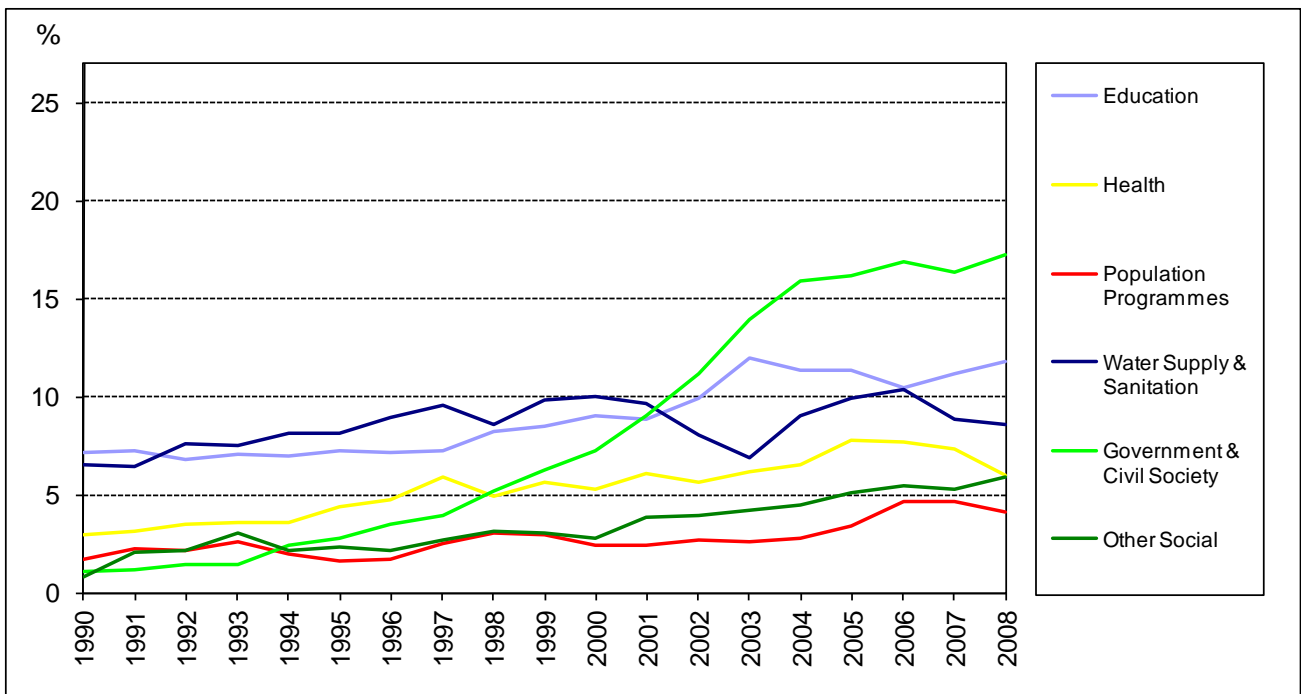

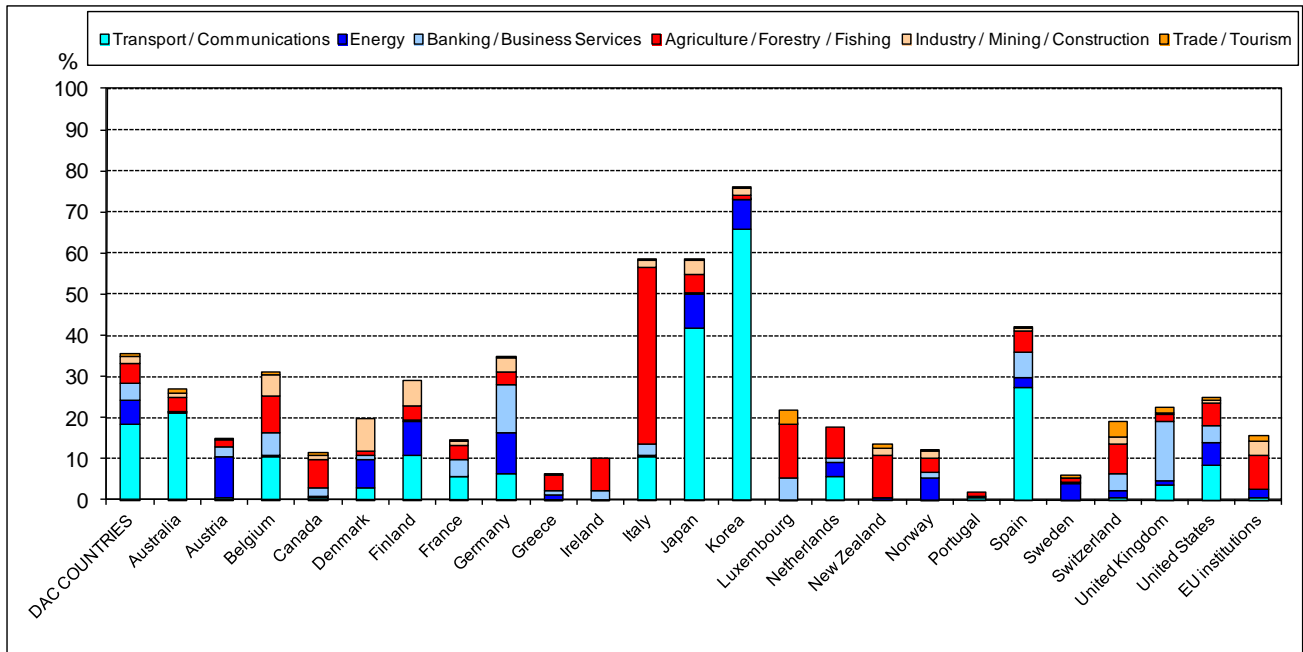
4.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA to Asia by donor
As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2009



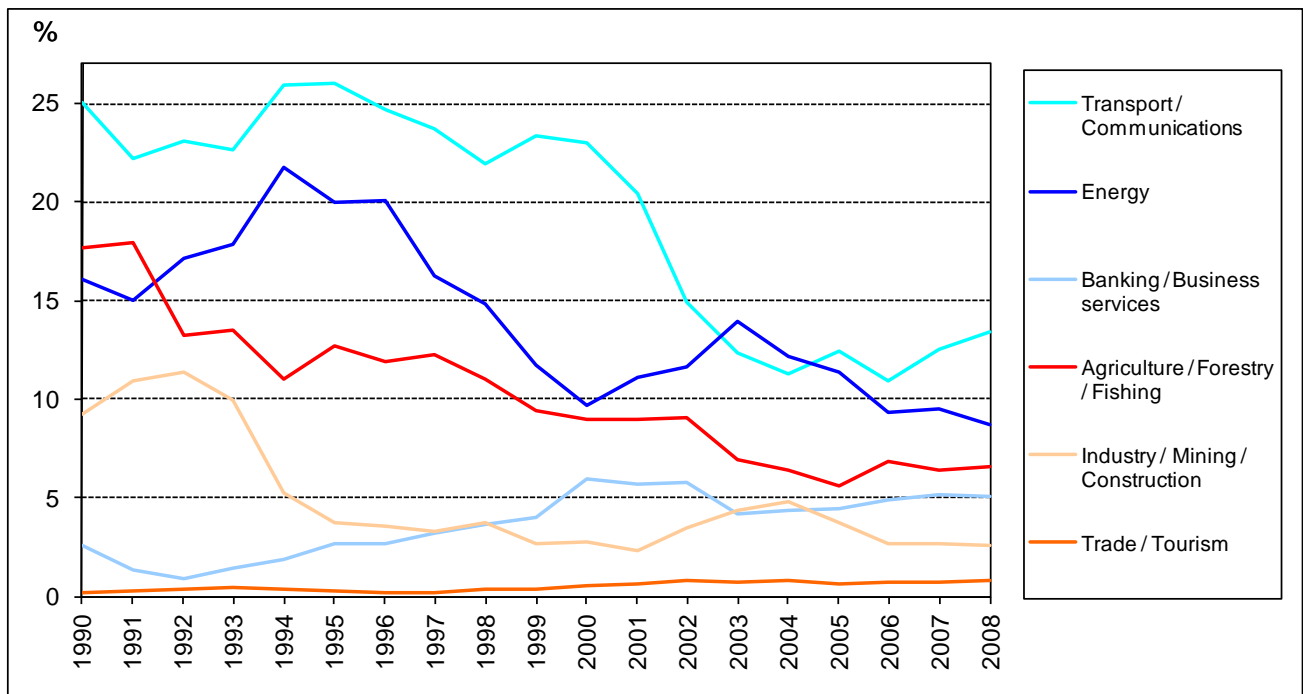
4.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA to Asia since 1990

As a percentage of total sector-allocable ODA, 3-year average commitments



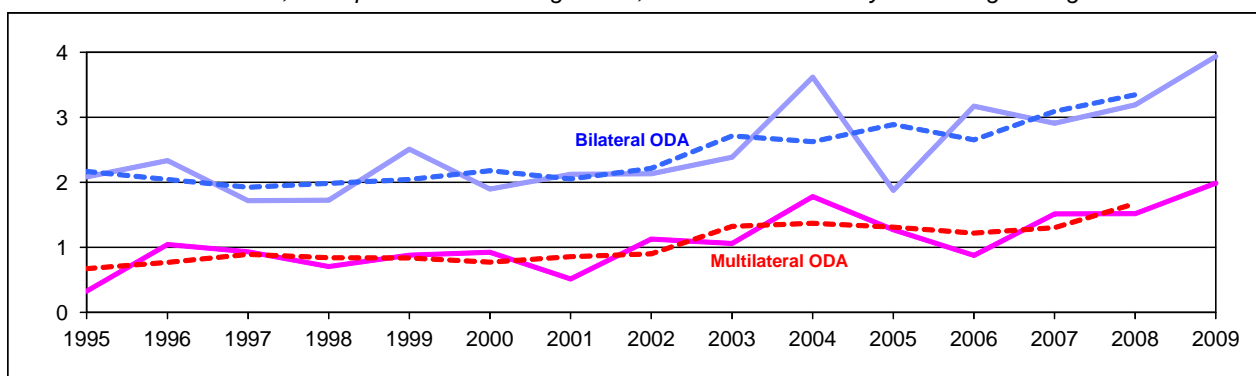

USD billion, 2008 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving averages

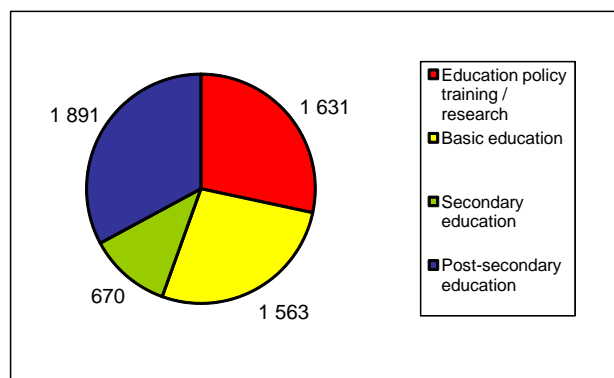

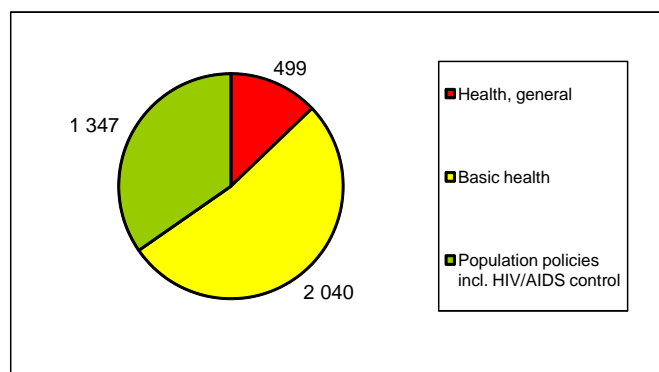

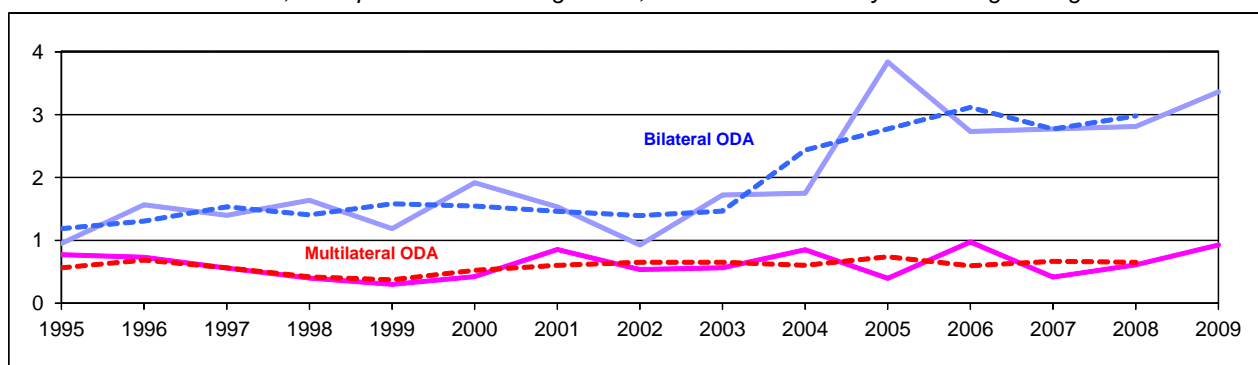

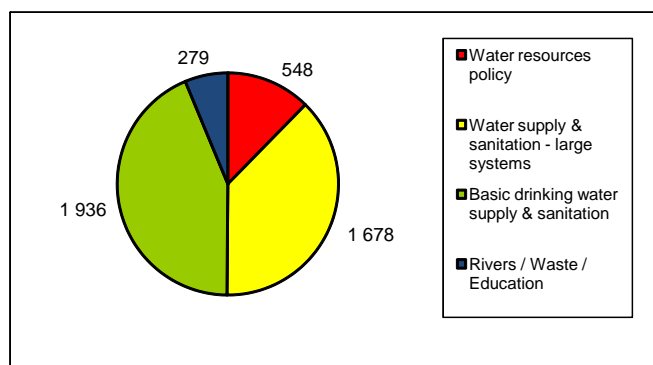
