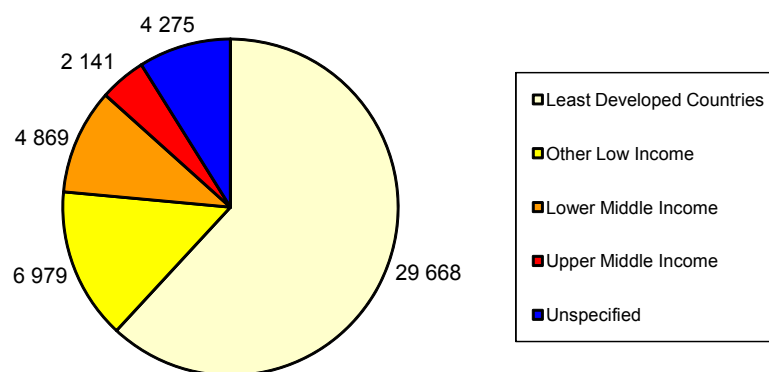

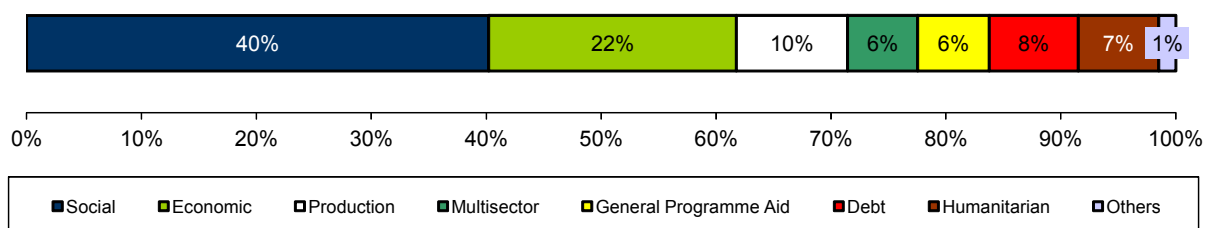
### 2.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2010, net disbursements



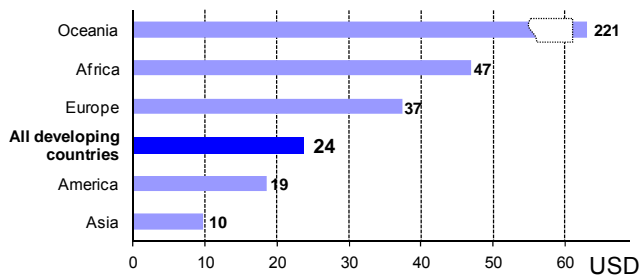

### 2.1.5. Sectors in 2010 commitments



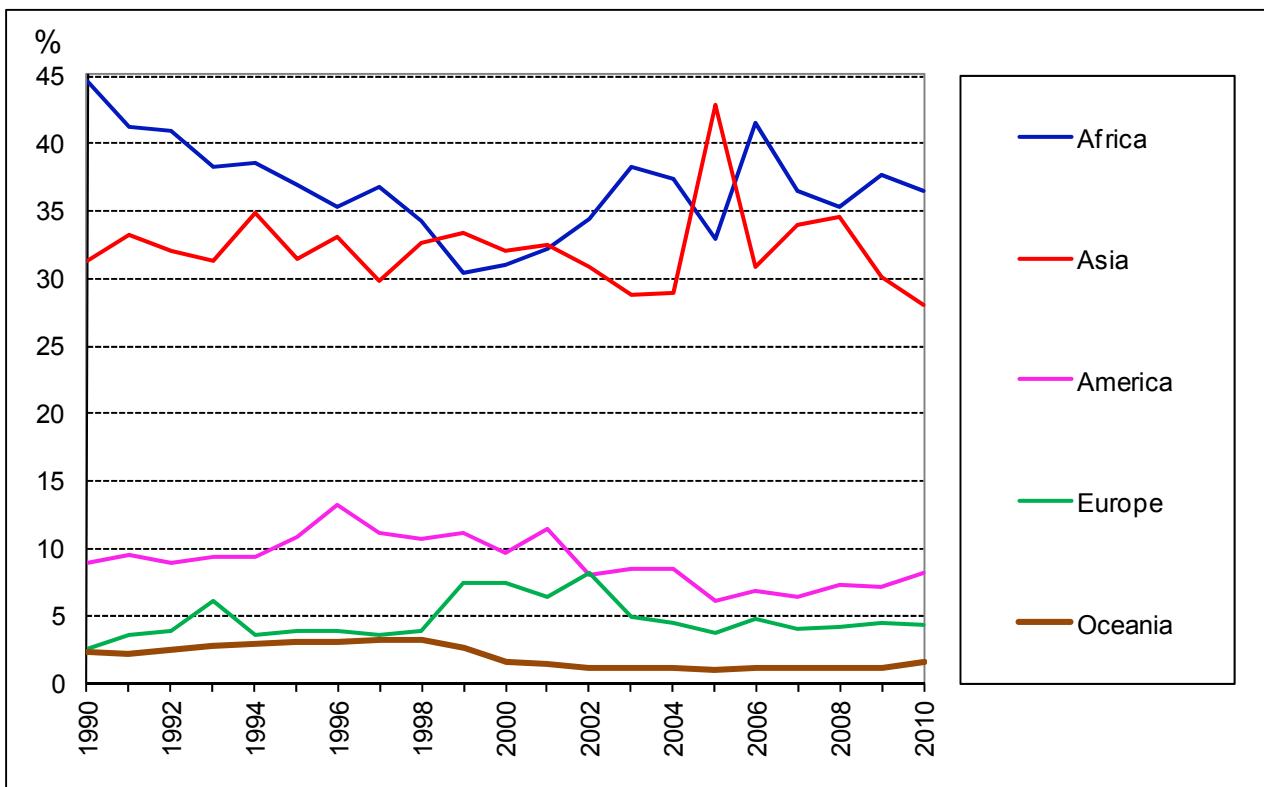
**2.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2010**

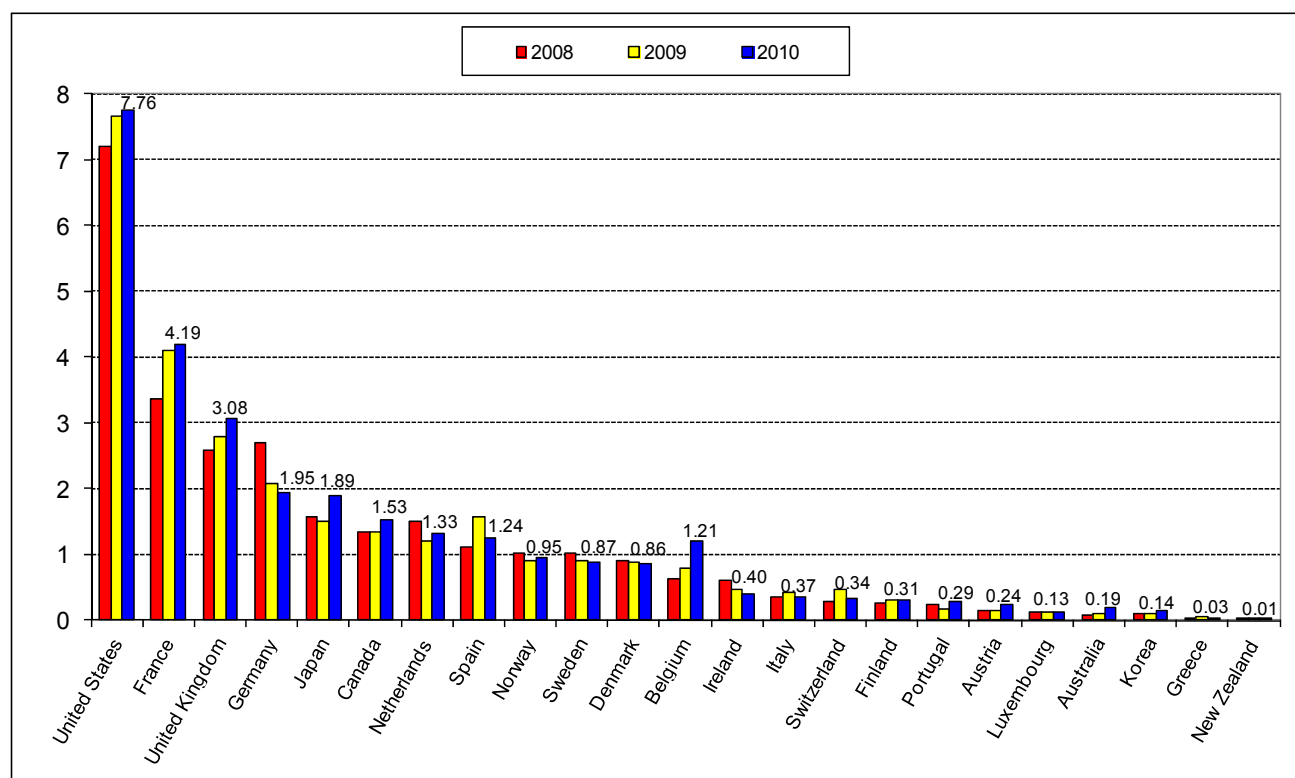

USD billion, values shown for 2010, net bilateral disbursements



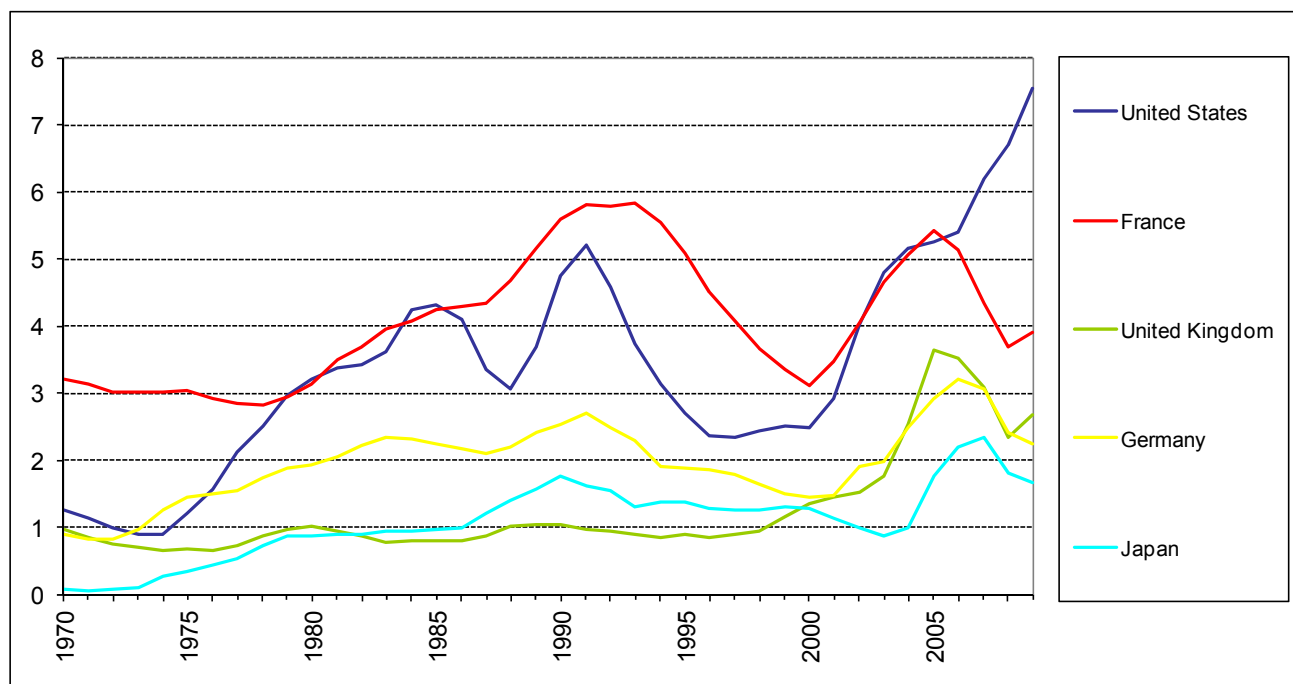

### 2.2.4. ODA to Africa by largest bilateral donors since 1970

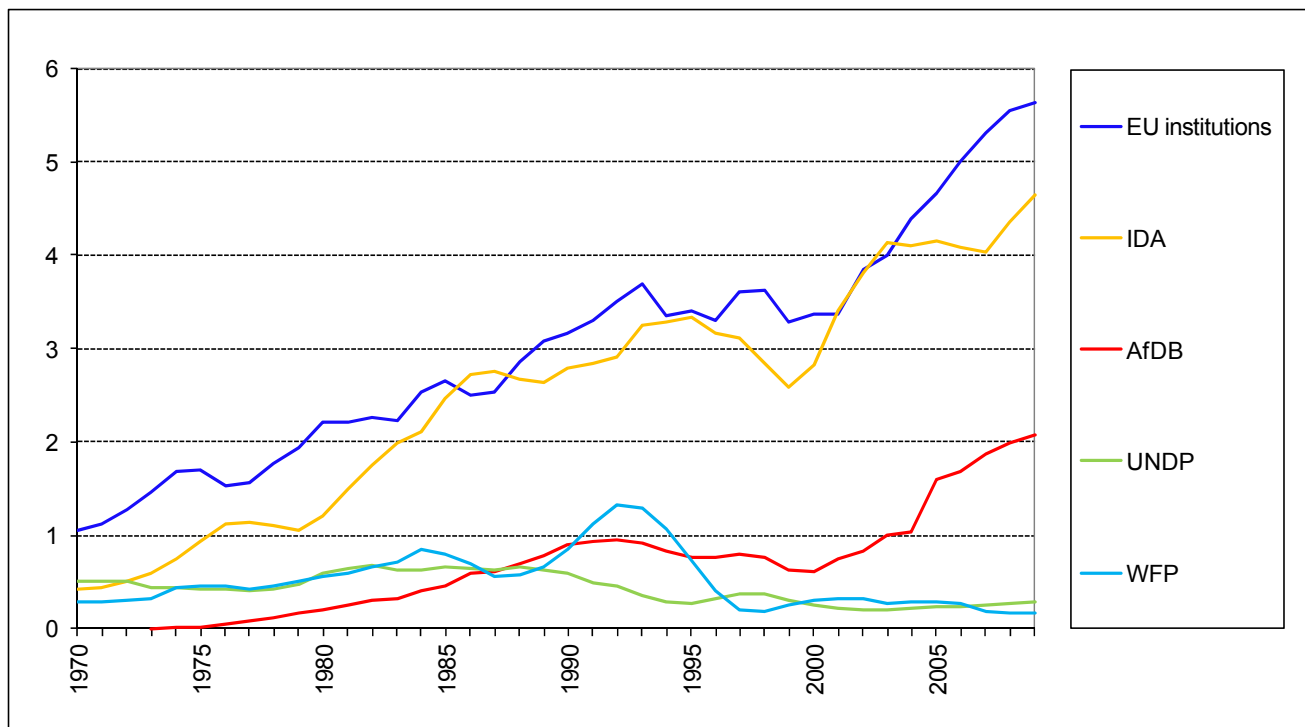
USD billion, 2009 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net bilateral disbursements

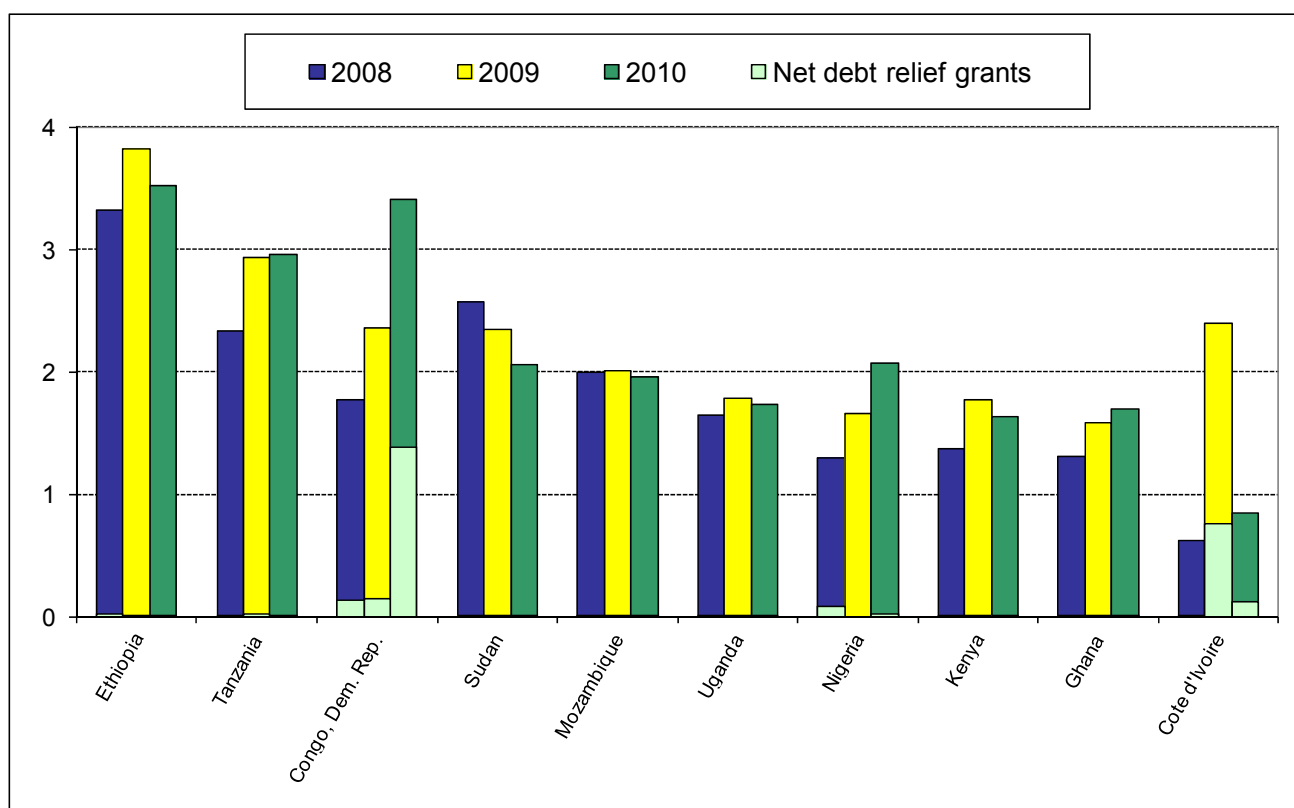
**2.2.6. ODA to Africa by largest multilateral donors since 1970**

*USD billion, net ODA receipts*



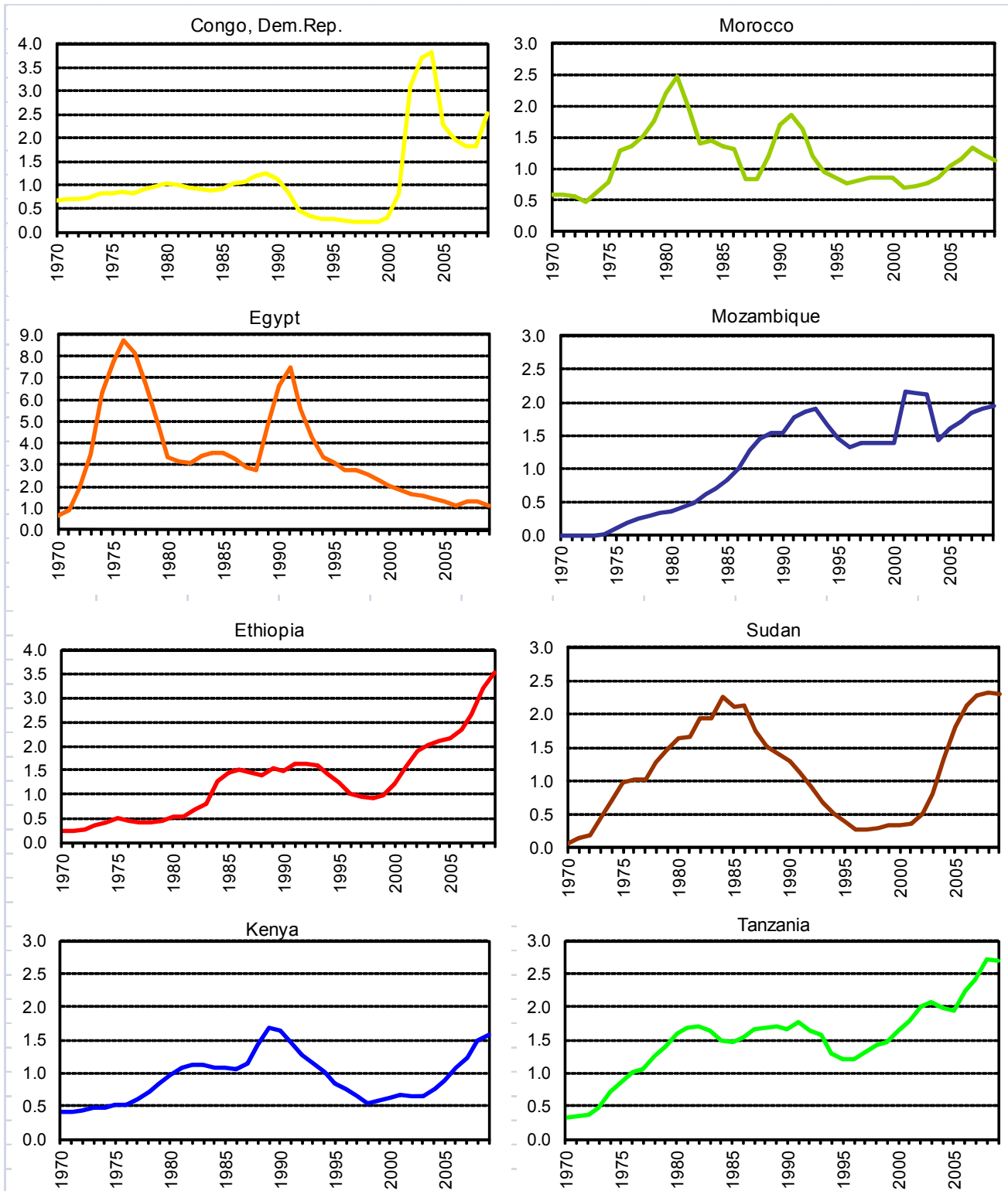

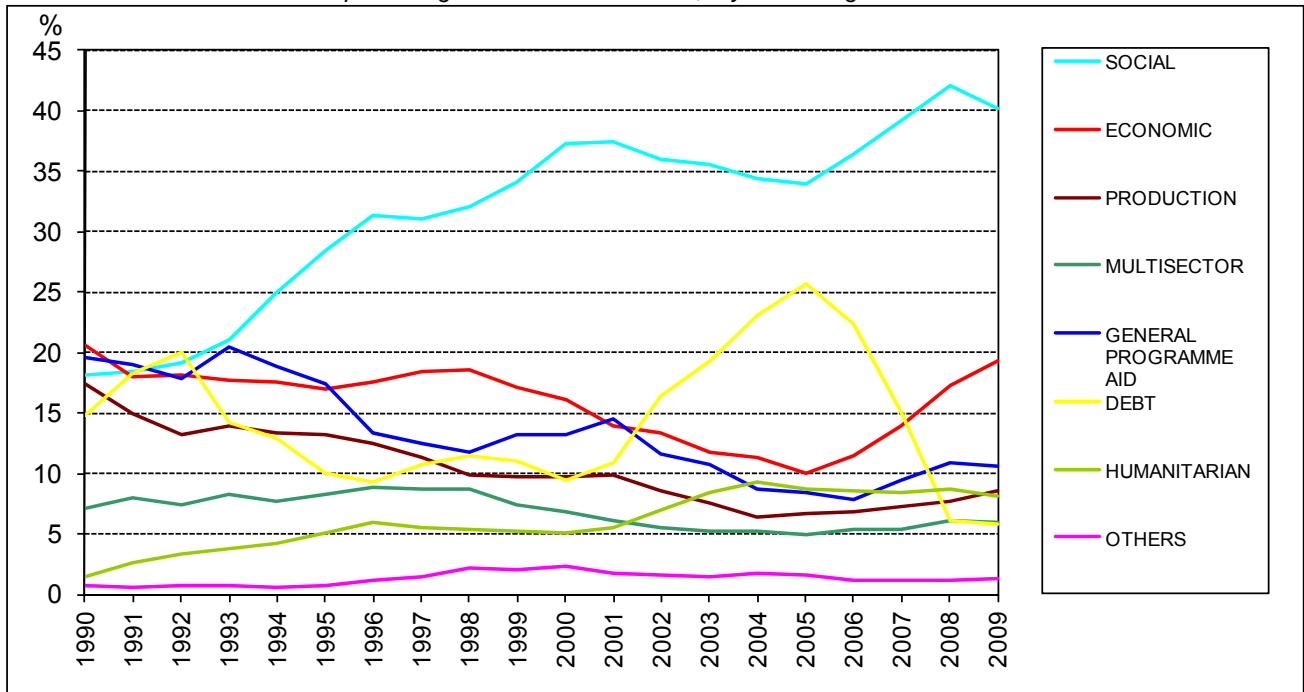
**2.2.10. Trends in aid to largest African recipients since 1970**

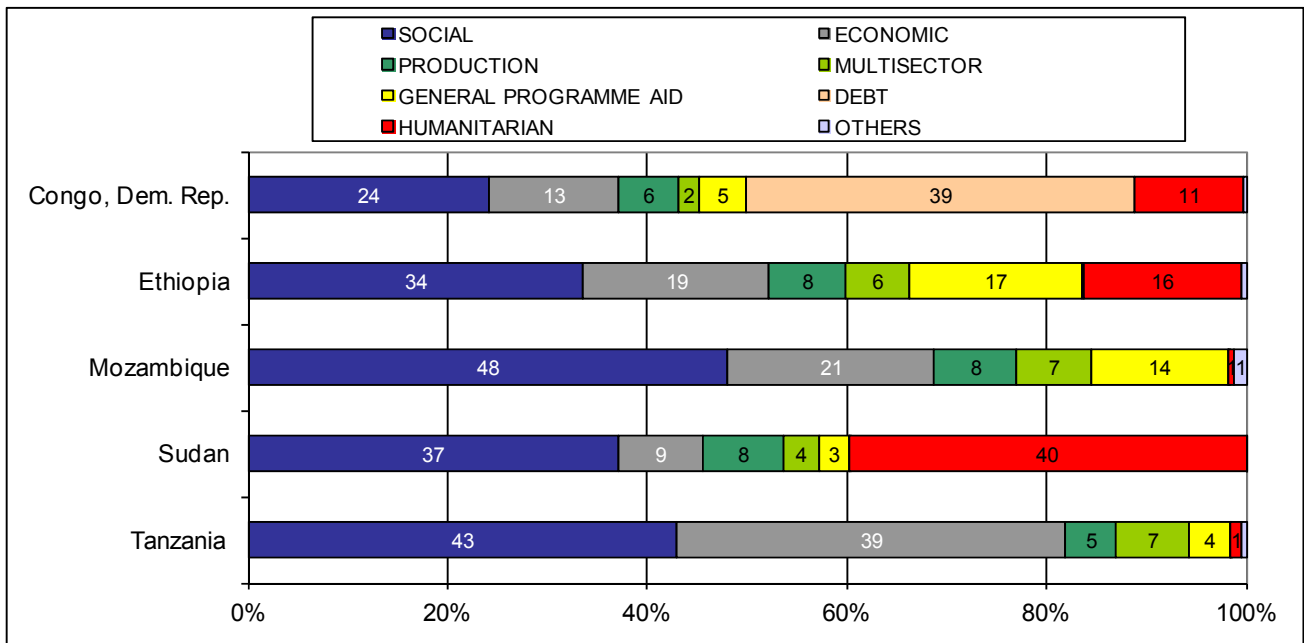
### 2.3.1. ODA to Africa by sector since 1990

As a percentage of total ODA committed for each country



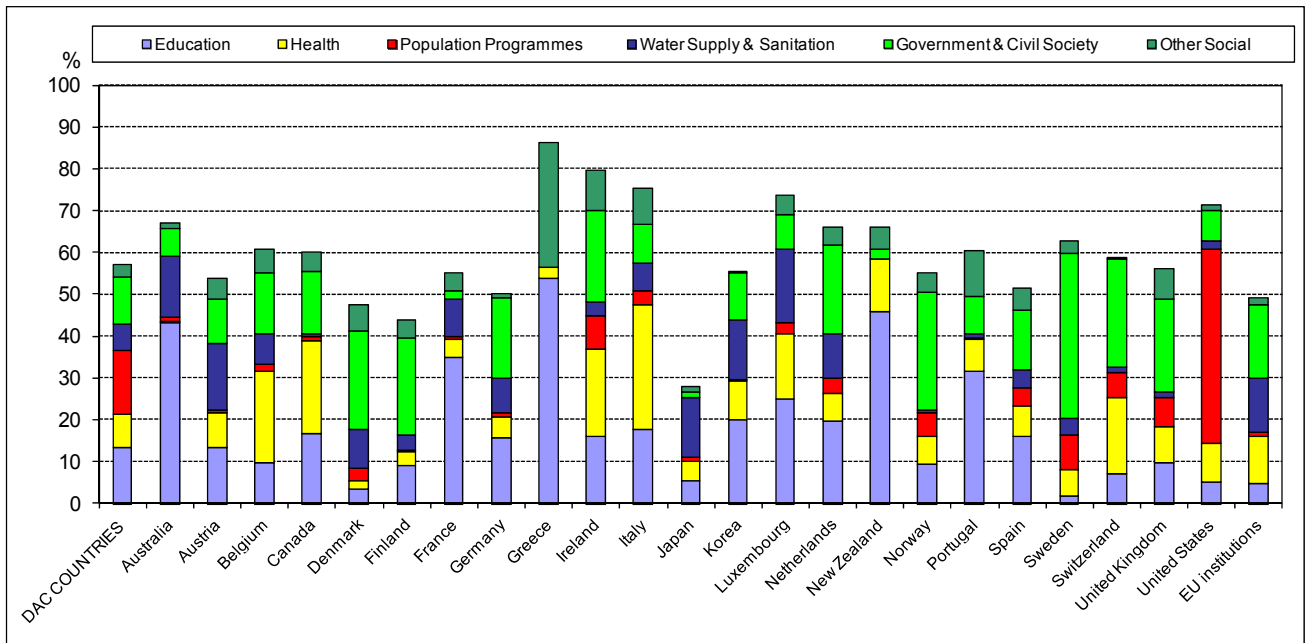

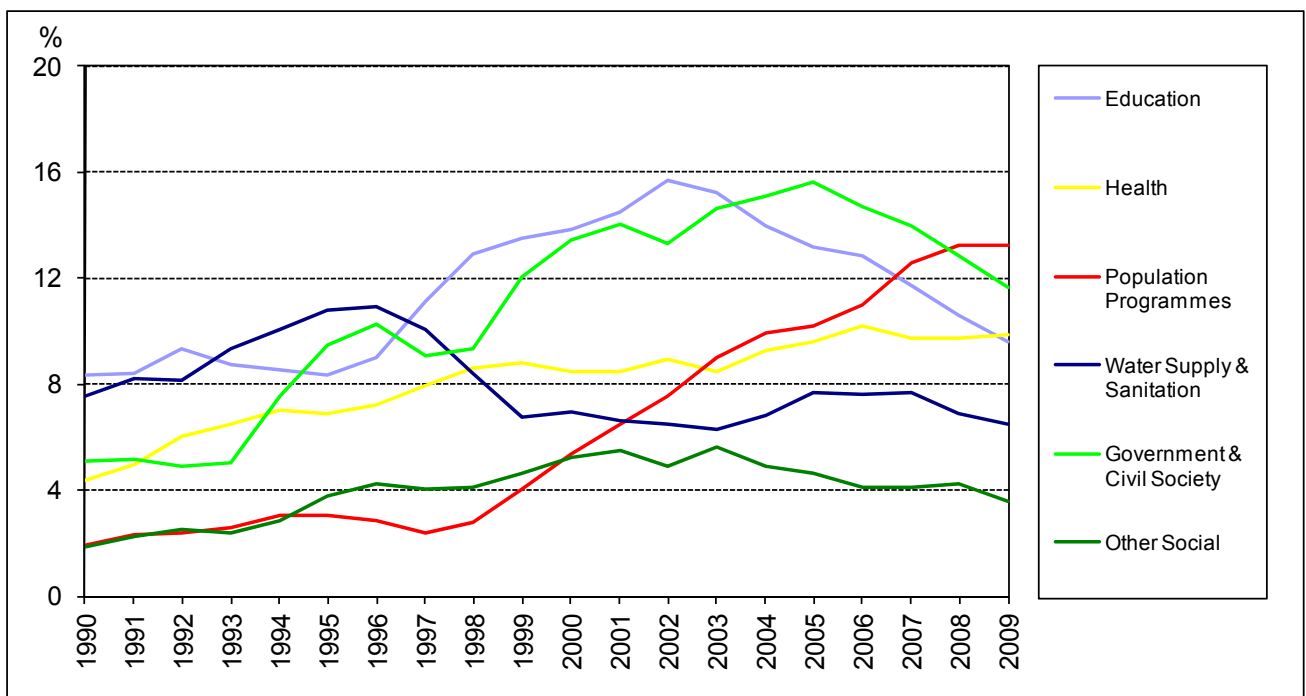

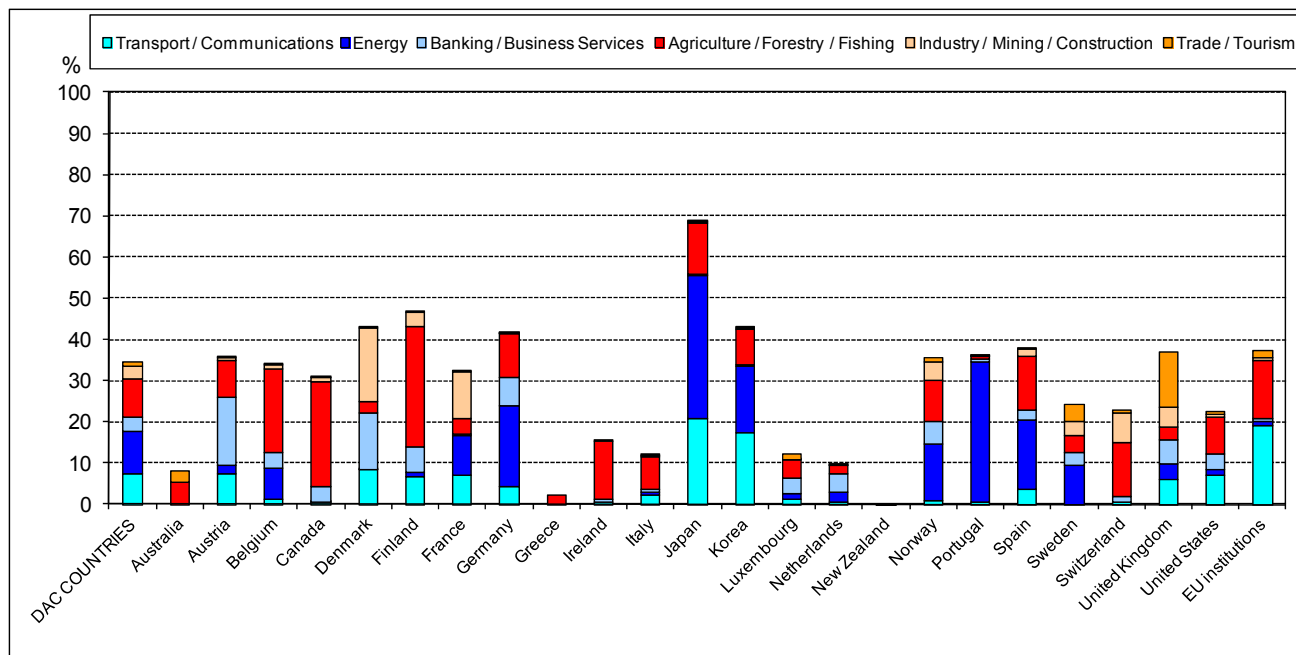
**2.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA to Africa by donor**  
*As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2010*



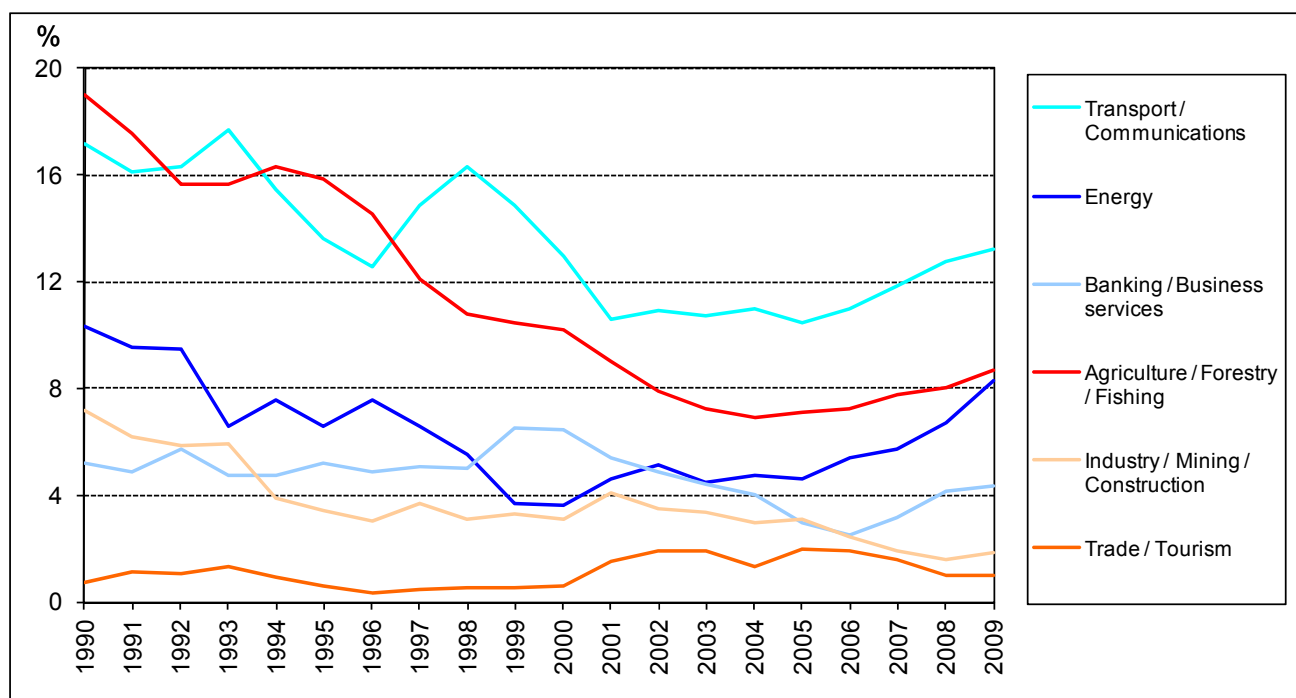
**2.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA to Africa since 1990**

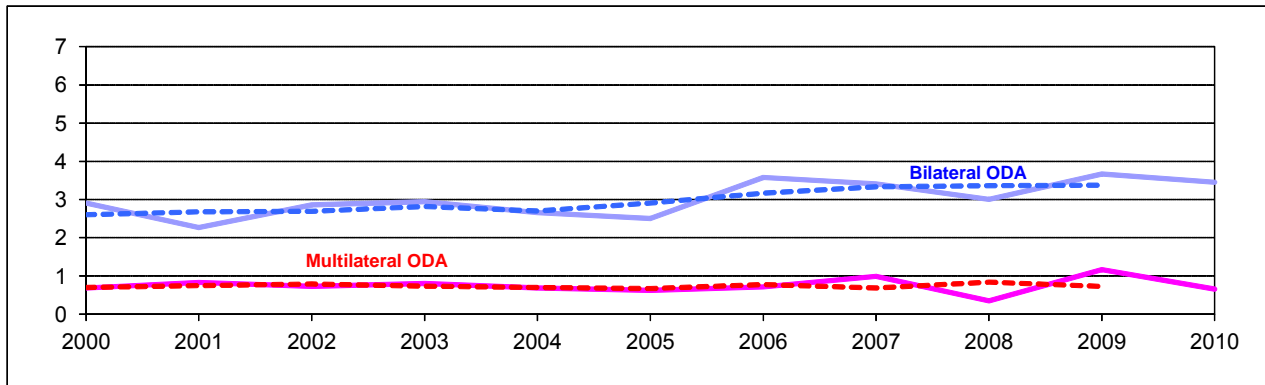

USD billion, 2009 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving averages

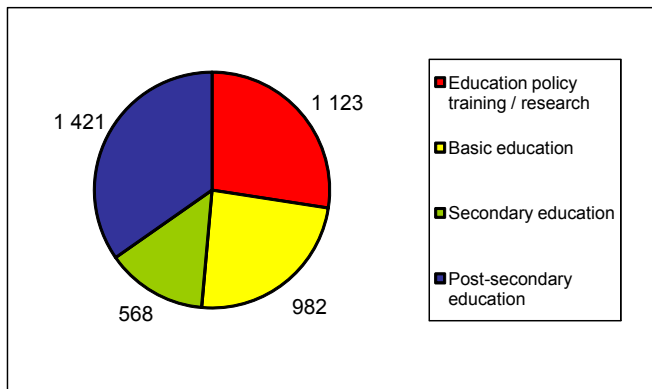

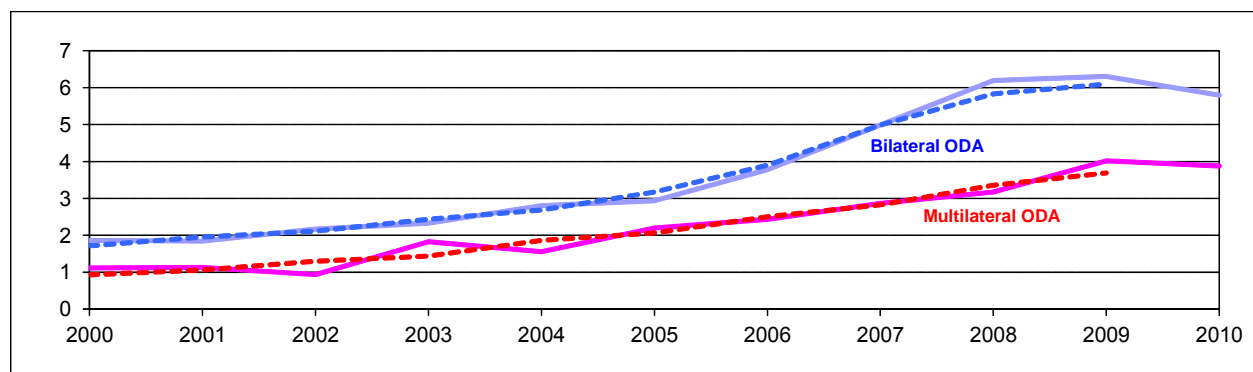

USD billion, 2009 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving averages

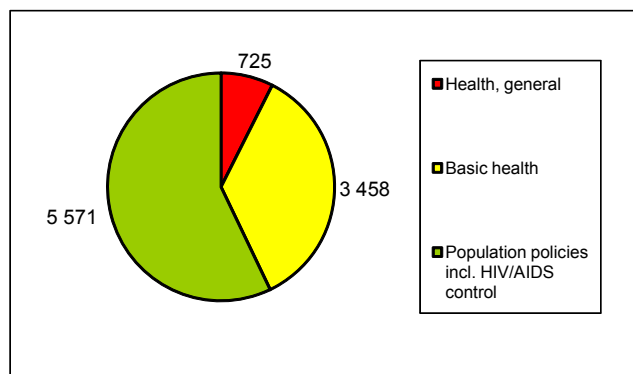

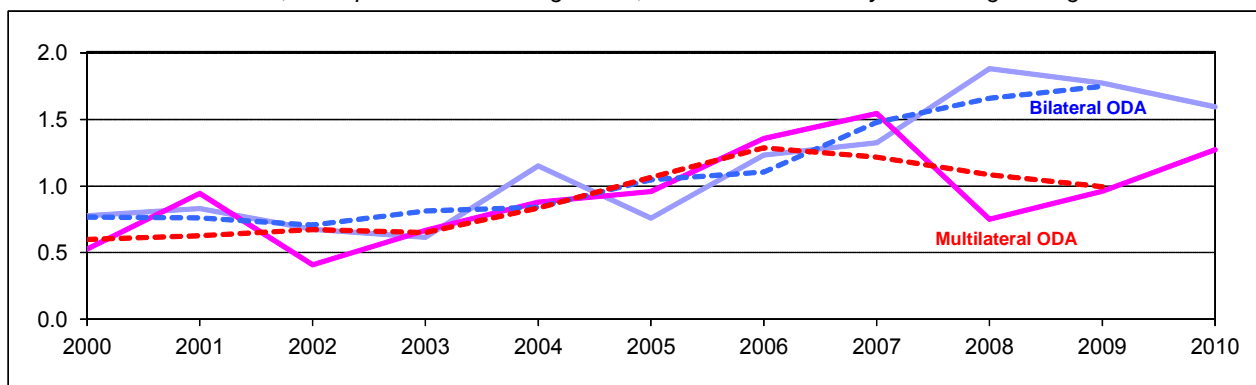

USD billion, 2009 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving averages

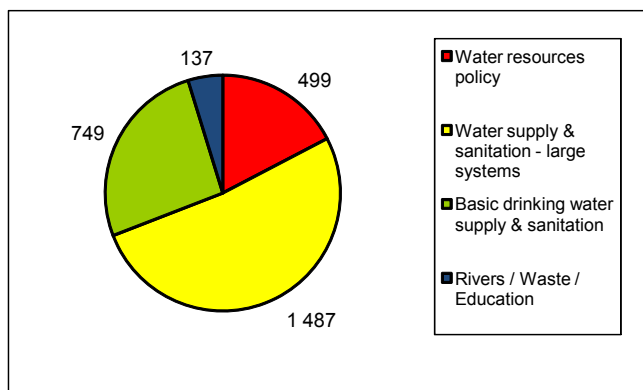
