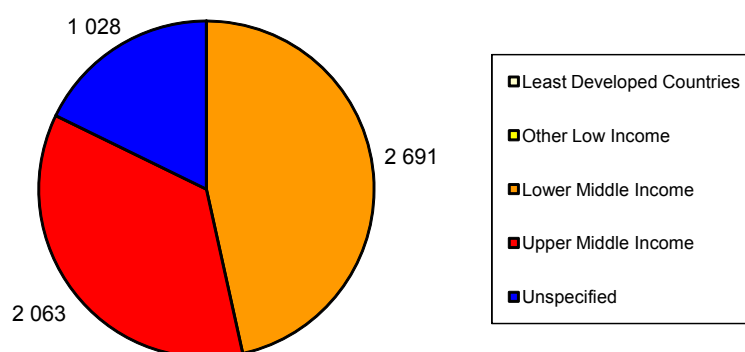

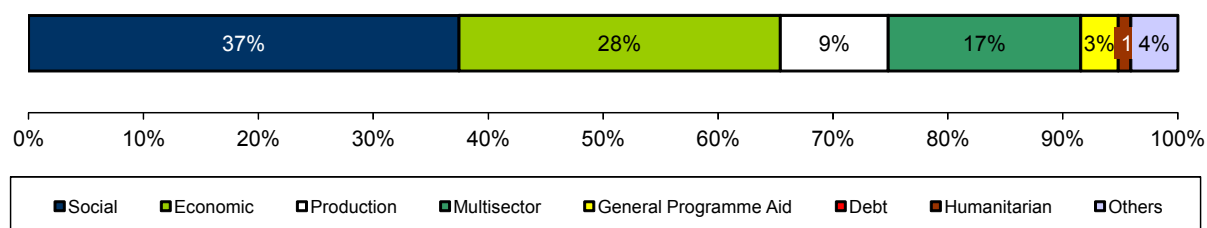

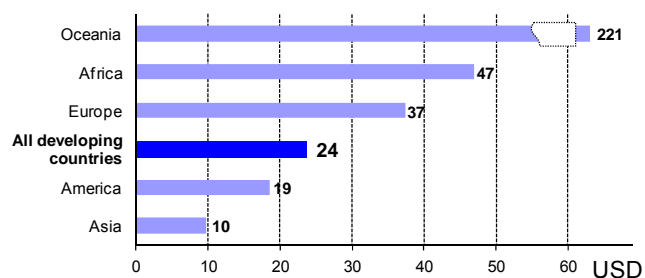

### 5.1.5. Sectors in 2010 commitments



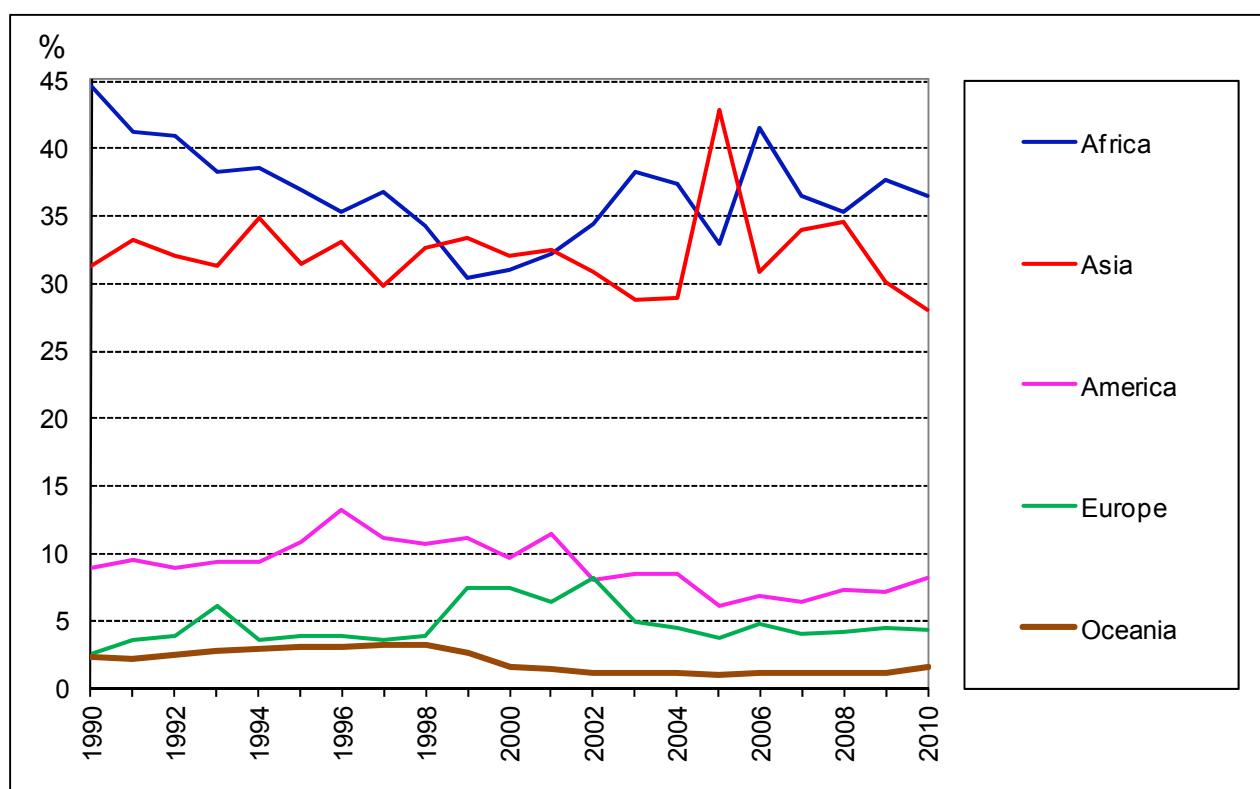
**5.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2010**

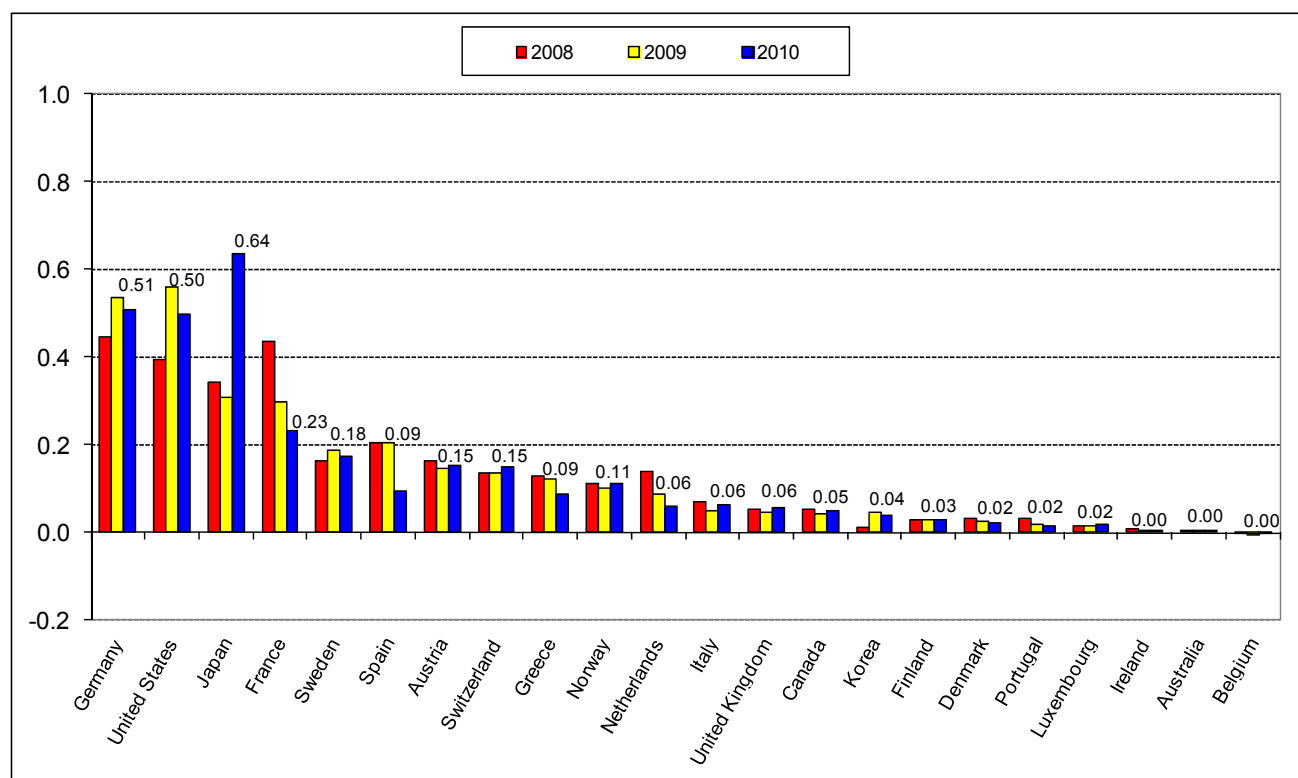

*USD billion, values shown for 2010, net bilateral disbursements*



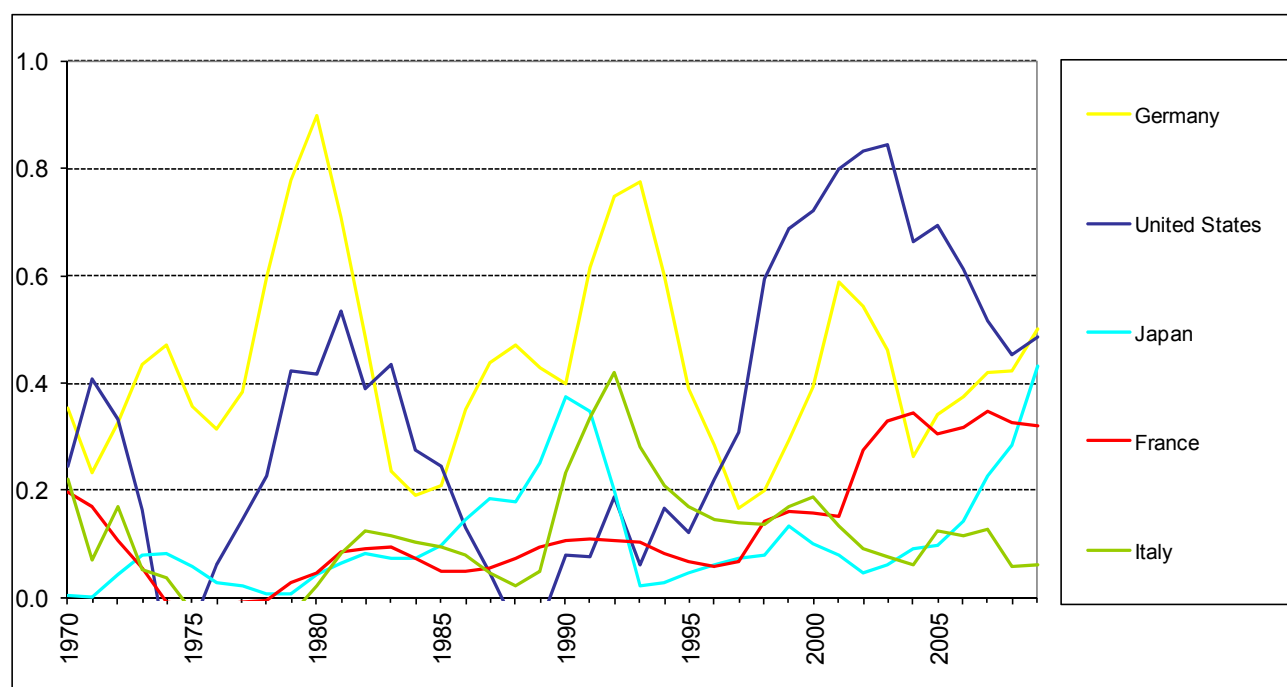

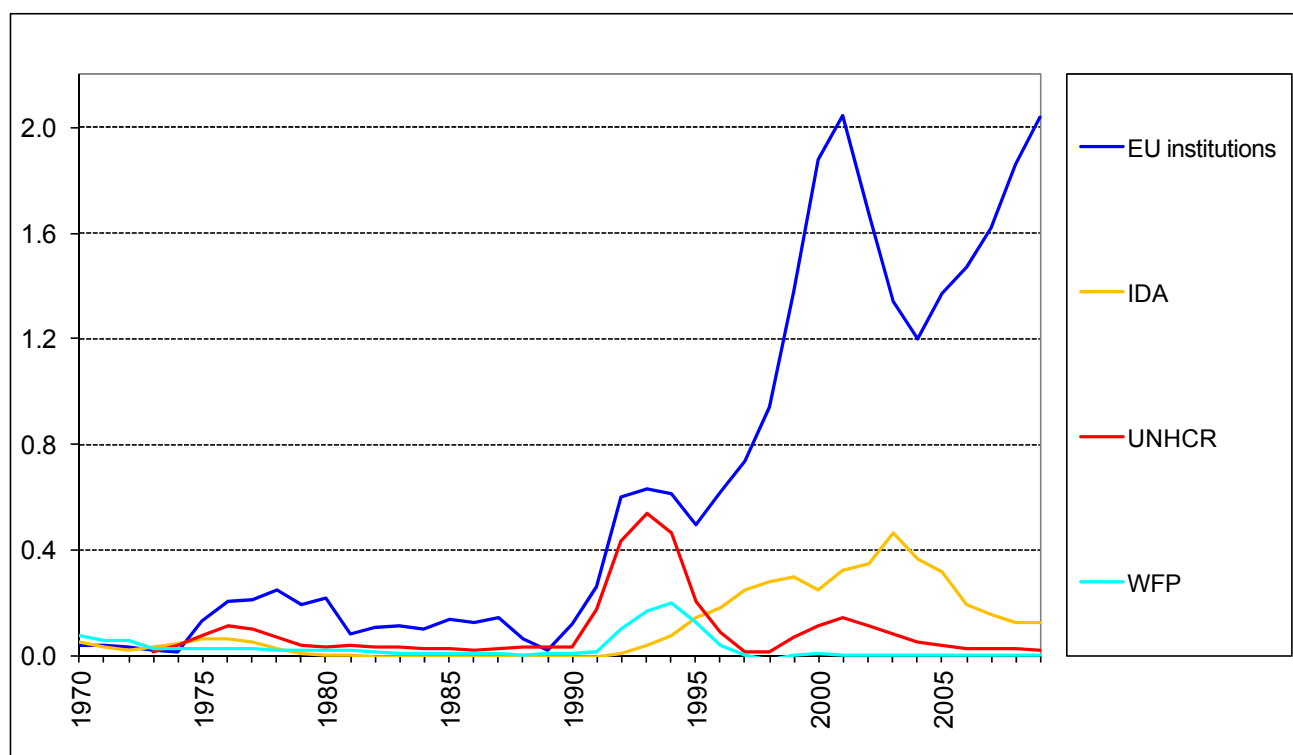

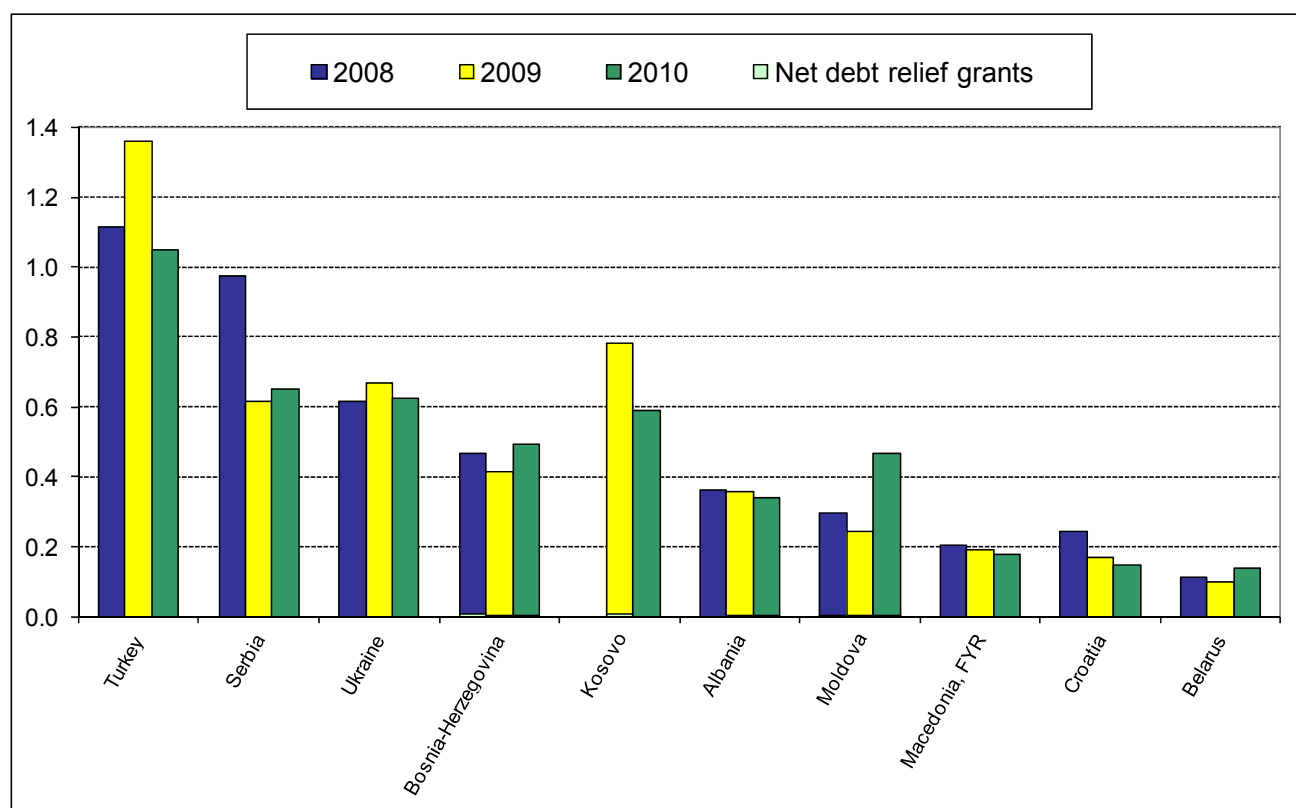
**5.2.6. ODA to Europe by largest multilateral donors since 1970**

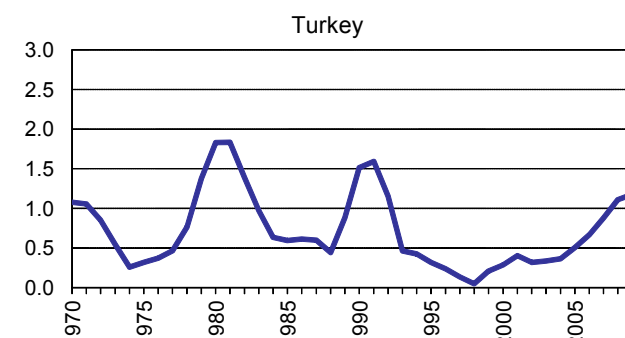

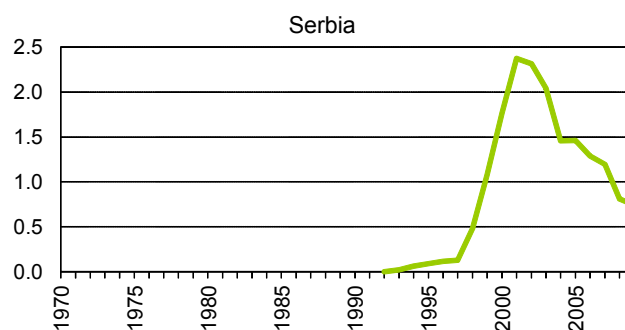
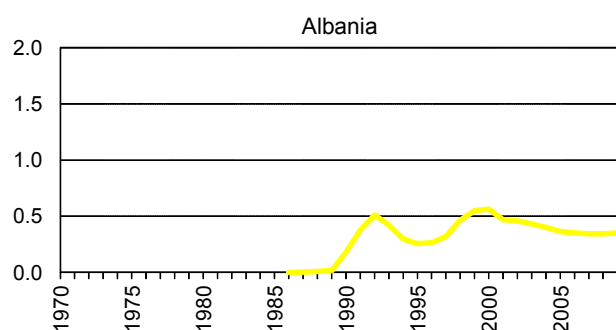

USD billion, 2009 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net ODA receipts

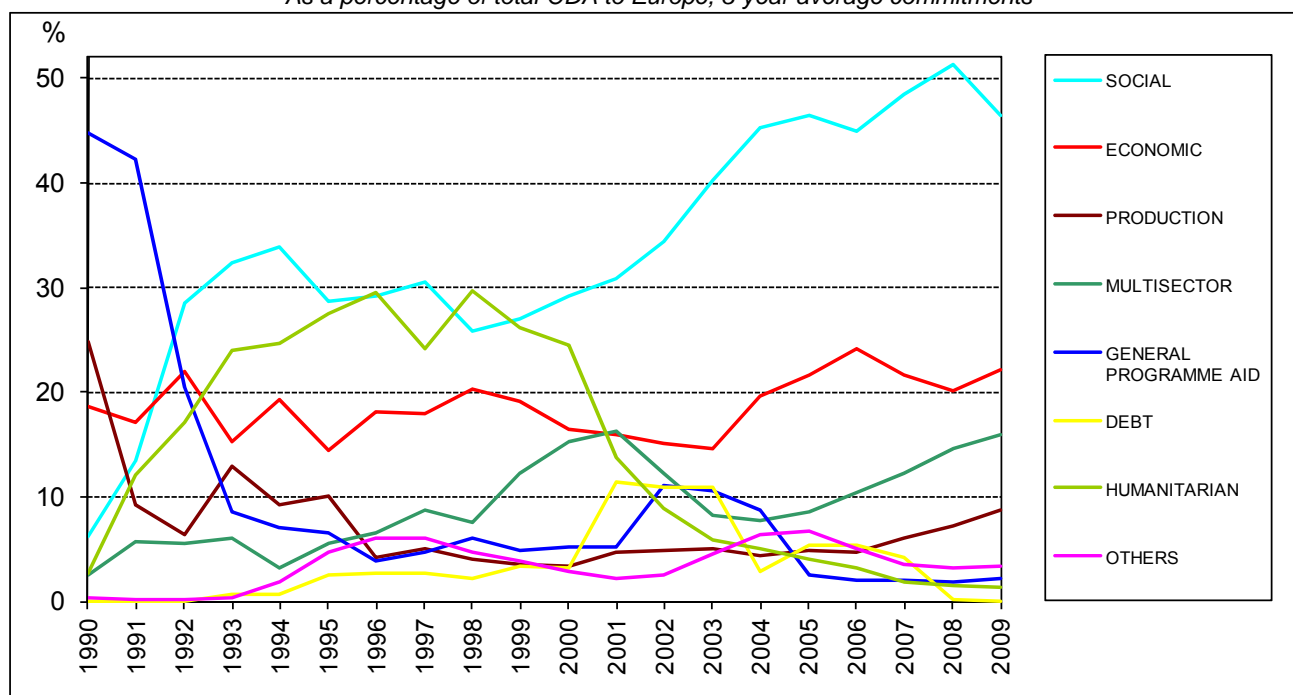

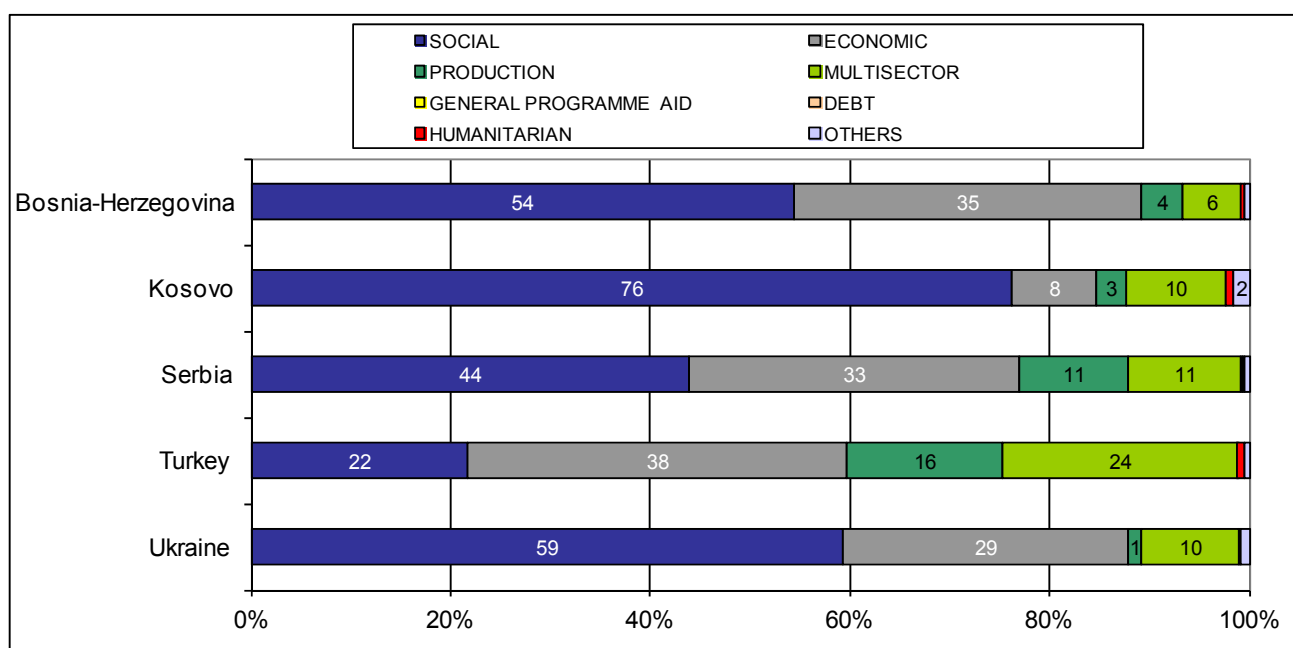
### 5.3.1. ODA to Europe by sector since 1990

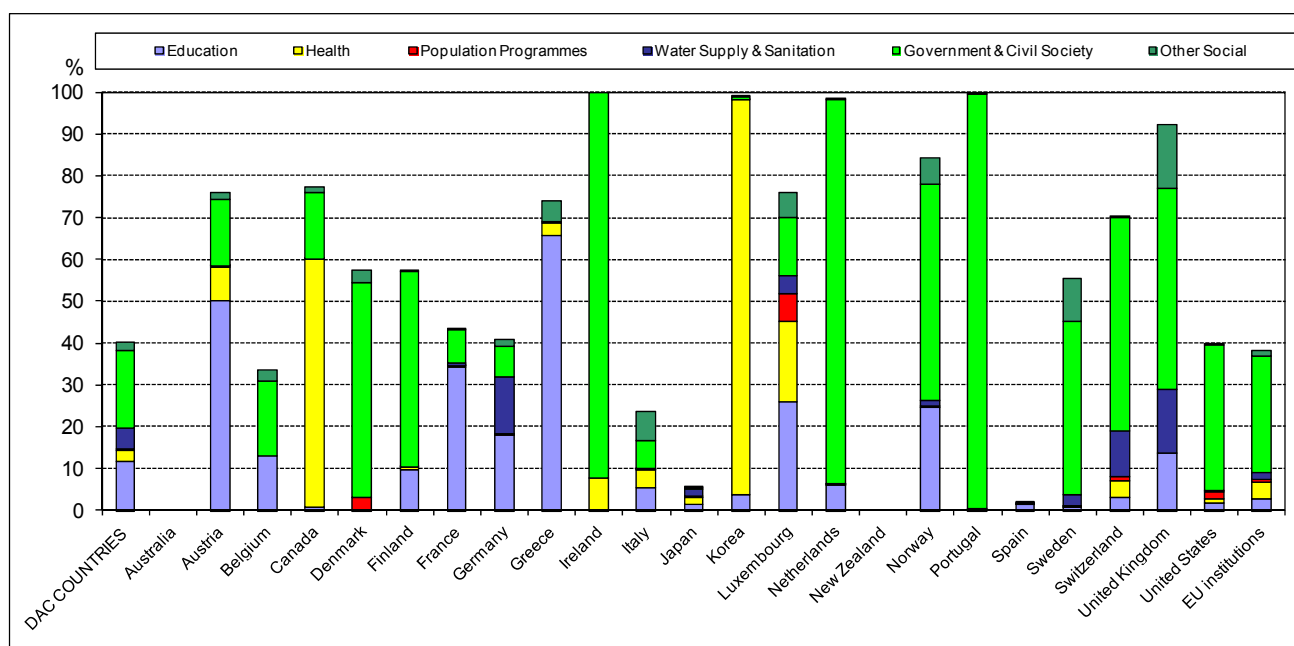

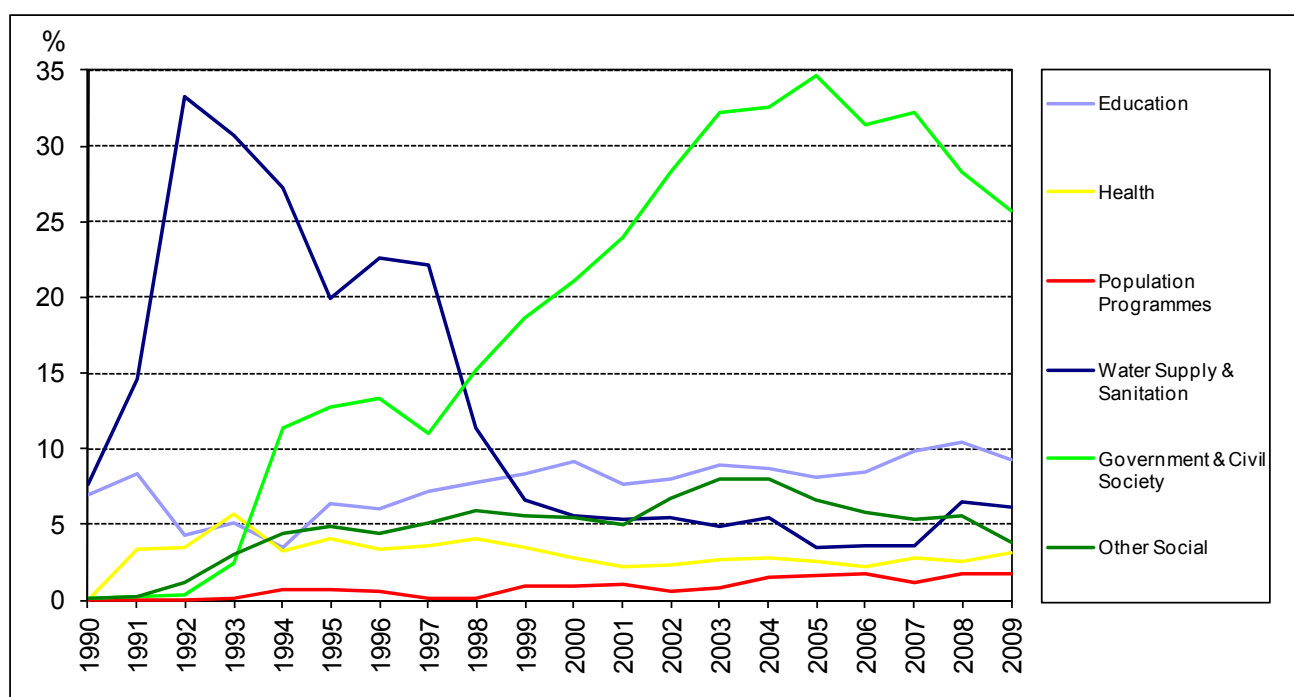
### 5.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA to Europe by donor

*As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2010*

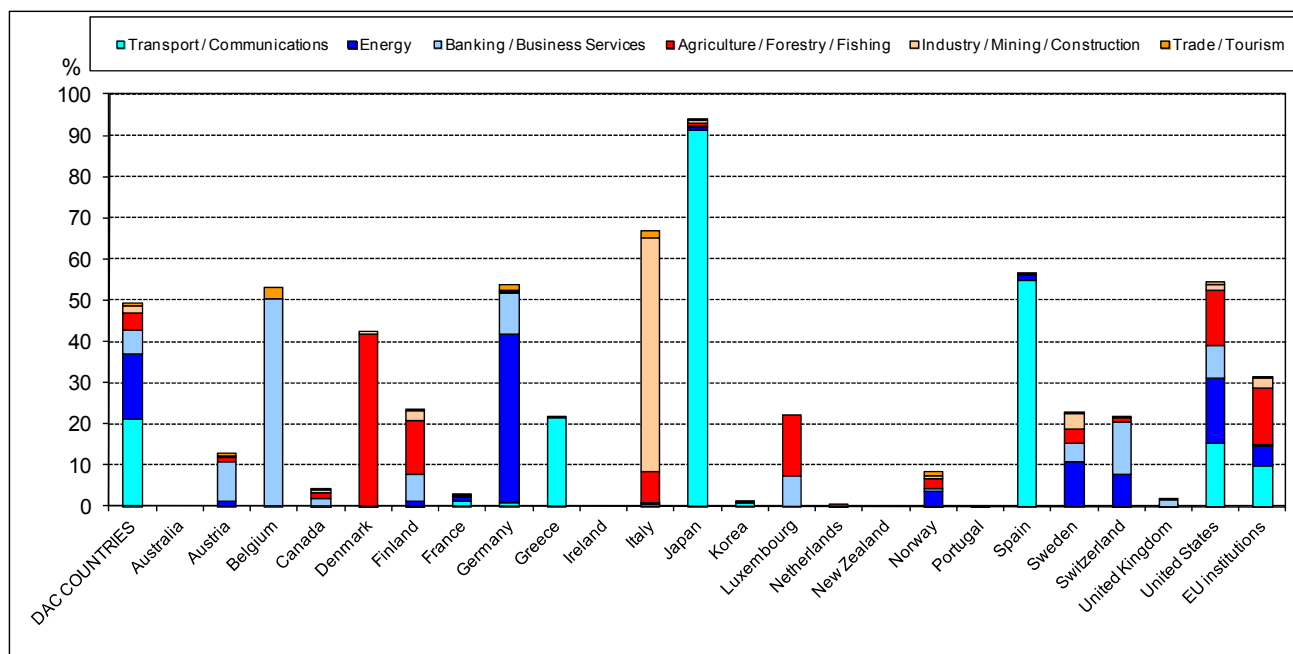


### 5.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA to Europe since 1990
