DEPARTMENT PRESENTATION

The 12th Asia Week of the Department of Asia and the Pacific of the IIR took place on 24th-27th August. It was a successful event, which had the participation of all members of the Department, as well as the support of various Asian artistic and cultural organizations of the city of La Plata. On Wednesday 24th, Thursday 25th and Friday 26th the different centers of the Department of academic organized a series lectures presentations on different issues about the countries of the region. Wednesday 24th was China Day, where María Francesca Staiano, along with Matías Caubet, Solange Seijas, Isadora Soto and Andrea Pappier, members of the Center for Chinese Studies, presented "Discursive papers. Also, the special conference Traditions and the Role of Leadership in the People's Republic of China: The Case of Xi Jinping and The Governance of China" was given by Dr. Gustavo Santillán took place and the book "Studies on the People's Republic of China: International Relations and Domestic Politics", a product of the collaboration between CeChine and Censud, by Maria Francesca Staiano, Laura Bogado Bordazar, and Laura Bono was presented. Thursday 25 was Japan Day and Southeast



Asia Day, in charge of Laura Cea and Ezequiel Ramoneda, respectively. Friday 26th was Korea and India Day. Barbara Bavoleo, along with Estefanía Kuhn, Manuel Lee, María Florencia Colavita, Verónica del Valle, Matías Benítez and Micaela Colavita, members of the Center for Korean Studies, presented papers. Finally, Saturday 27th was the Cultural Day, when diverse cultural activities were carried out in the building of the Presidency of the University, with the participation of different artistic and martial arts groups of the peoples of East Asia, including exhibitions of Aikido, Sumo, Judo, Kendo, Japanese traditional dances and drums (taiko), Taekwondo practice and philosophy exhibition by Tung Yen, and Indian dances by María Luz Cohen.

It was in the context of this event that the 25th anniversary of the creation of the Department of Asia and Pacific of IIR was commemorated. The activity, organized on Thursday 25th, was presided by Cecilia Onaha, Coordinator of the Department, and included a brief of its history, making a recognition to those who participated or made fundamental contributions to it. Then a presentation was given by the international environmental specialist Pablo Martínez Lestard of the United Nations University - Institute of Advanced Studies (UNU-IAS), Japan, one of the first members of the Department. At the end a commemorative plaque was discovered.

Finally, we inform that from this numer onwards, the sections "News from the Centers and Chair" and "Conferences, Seminar and Courses at NULP" will be translated into English, so to keep informed out English-speaking readers about our activities.

Title: Participation in the Centennial Celebration of the Japanese Association in Argentina.

Description: As part of the celebration of the Centennial of the Japanese Association in Argentina, a set of activities were organized in the city of San Miguel de Tucumán, paying homage to Argentina in the cradle of its Independence in the year of its Bicentennial. It had the invaluable support and participation of the local Japanese community, in addition to the National University of Tucuman, by means of its Rector - a former student in Japan - and the Center for Asian and African Studies, in charge of Prof. Liliana Palians of Cosiansi, Professor Sergio Naessens, Professor Keiko Saito, the Japanese language teacher, and researchers and students of the same university.

In the morning, two commemorative medals were handed out by two recognized artists at the Musean of the Historical House of Independence. The first medal is a commemorative of the Bicentennial and was given by Juan Pablo Marturano, Phd in Arts from Tama Art University of Tokyo, and the second is commemorative of the Centenary of the Association and was given by Morena Maehashi, daughter of a prominent Nikkei sculptor from Salta. This event was attended by a representative of the provincial government, authorities of the National University of Tucumán, authorities of Japanese Association, as well as members of the community.

In the afternoon the academic day was developed in the auditorium No. 2 of the Faculty of Philosophy and Letters of the National University of Tucumán, divided into two panels. The first one consisted of Luis Arguero, a PhD from Hiroshima University, Rodolfo Molina, a former PhD fellow at the University of Tokyo, and Cecilia Onaha, PhD from the School of Cultural Studies, Department of Japanese Studies, Graduate University of Advanced Studies of Kyoto, who presented their papers related to the political situation of the East Asian region, regional development in Japan and the link between Japanese and Okinawan culture. And the second consisted of Porfessors Sergio Naessens, Liliana Palacios, Engineer Luis Muraki and Arch. Keiko Saito, who presented their papers on the history of Japanese immigration to the province, undokai as a community cultural expression in Japan and in the Japanese Association in Tucuman, the development of the Japanese Association of Tucumán and the panorama of the teaching of the Japanese language.

Finally, the activities were completed with an artistic and cultural day in the same venue, with the participation of Tamiji Kanzawa, Rodolfo Oyamada, Lilia Ui, Solana Peralta and Hiroshi Kaneko, from the Japanese community of Tucumán and Salta, the Aikido school of Professor Armando Hamada, the Kizuna Daiko group of the Japanese Association of Salta, led by its president Moisés Onaga, Nicolás Kakisu of Santa Fe Wadaiko and in representation of the Japanese Association of Santa Fe, all under the direction of Bruno Cecconi of the Argentine Association of Taiko, Jorge Yohena with a presentation on Japanese cuisine, Analía Tengan, Mieko Itokazu and Elena Asato who presented Okinawan dances, Keila Santaella and Andres Sakuda with a sanshin presentation, and Ernesto Kimura, Vice President of Japanese Association, and the kendo group represented by Javier Rodríguez, Cintian Milanés, Andrea Fernández and Gonzalo Tanaka.

The event was sponsored by the Japanese Embassy in Argentina, the National University of Tucuman, the Japan Group of the Argentine Council for International Relations, ALADAA Argentina, and the Institute of International Relations - NULP, through the CeJ.

The 2013 and 2014 editions of the ASEAN Essay Contest were organized by the embassies of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries in the Argentine Republic, namely the Kingdom of Thailand, the People's Republic of Viêt Nam, Malaysia, the Republic of Indonesia and the Republic of the Philippines. This initiative sought to encourage students and graduates of public and private universities in Argentina to write essays on issues related to ASEAN and the relations of Argentina with that organization. Together with the diplomatic representations of the region, a jury composed of academics specialized in the studies of Southeast Asia belonging to universities with a clear international projection towards that region was formed. They formed a network under the auspices of the Ministry of Education of Argentina through MISIONES and REDES projects within the framework of the University Promotion Program. Also it counted with the collaboration of the Argentine diplomatic representations in that region. In this way, the publication "ASEAN Essay Contest, Compilation of Winner Essays 2013-2014" is the result of the collaboration between embassies, ministries and universities in order to promote the people and countries of Southeast Asia as an area of study with its own identity within Asian studies in Argentina.
