DEPARTMENT PRESENTATION

This new edition finds us with a promising initiative regarding the links between Argentina and the countries of the Asia-Pacific region. On November 2nd the relaunching of the Argentine Committee for Asia and the Pacific (CONAPAC) took place in the Argentine Ministry of Foreign Affairs. It was created in 1992 by decree 1378/92, with the aim of increasing the presence of Argentina in the markets and forums of the Asian region, but entered the new century lost momentum. The event, chaired by Foreign Minister Malcorra, was attended by the staff of the Asia and Pacific Department, which was present from the very beginning in CONAPAC, back then with the participation of its Coordinator Prof. Jorge Di Masi.

At the end of the year, the VIII Edition of the Congress of International Relations of the IIR was held on 23-25 November, in which the various centers of the Department participated actively. On Wednesday 23rd morning, a special conference by the Ambassador of the People's Republic of China in Argentina, HE Yang Wanming, took place. That same day in the afternoon was the session of the Department, moderated by Cecilia Onaha, which included presentations by

China-Argentina / Latin America: the Current, the Closer and the Distant", of Sergio Cesarín and Carlos Moneta, by Sergio Cesarín, Maria Francesca Staiano and Laura Bogado Bordazar took place. At the end of the CeChine session a special conference of the Ambassador of the Republic of Korea in Argentina, HE Choo Jong-Youn, on the bilateral relations of South Korea and Argentina, with the moderation of Barbara Bavoleo, was held. Finally, on Friday 25th, the session of the Chair for Indian Studies, moderated by Maria Agostina Cacault, was held, followed by the special conference of the Ambassador of the Republic of India in Argentina, HE Sanjiv Ranjan.

<u>Title:</u> Exhibition "Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Contribution to education for world peace".

Description: Within the VIII Edition of Congress of International Relations of IIR, the exhibition of posters: "HIROSHIMA - NAGASAKI. NEVER AGAIN", facilitated by the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Archive, was presented by Cecilia Onaha and Kayoko Sanuki, a volunteer from JICA, at the Institute of International Relations of the Faculty of Legal and Social Sciences. In August 1945, these two Japanese cities saw the effects of the two atomic bombs. In an instant they turned into ash, and during that year, more than 210 thousand people lost their lives. Those who barely survive had to carry a heavy burden that lasted throughout their lives, a suffering difficult to bear, that still continue to bear. More than 15 thousand nuclear bombs exist today and experiments with these weapons are still going. That is why we must be aware of the danger of nuclear weapons. The request for peace in Hiroshima and Nagasaki and its message is transmitted to the whole world for this purpose and every year there are exhibits related to the atomic bomb in other countries, along with video conferences, presentations of the testimony of those affected, by the website of this Archive that allows to transmit this message in different languages. The opening of exhibits also seeks to contribute to this goal: to make education for peace effective in all regions of the world.
