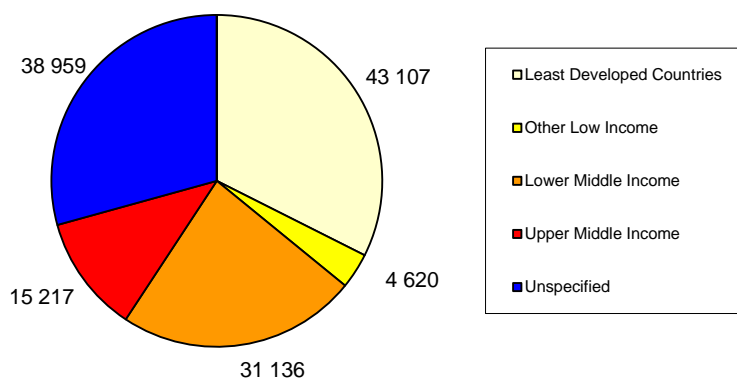

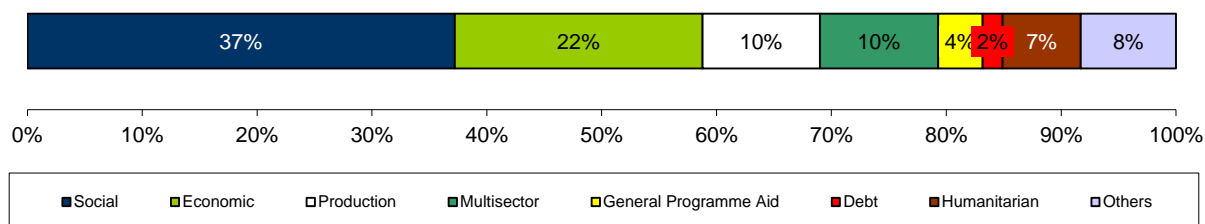
1.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2012, net disbursements

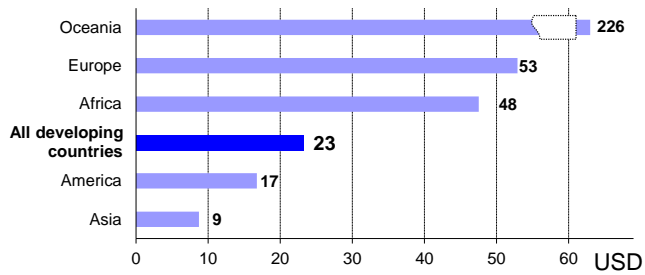

1.1.5. Sectors in 2012 commitments



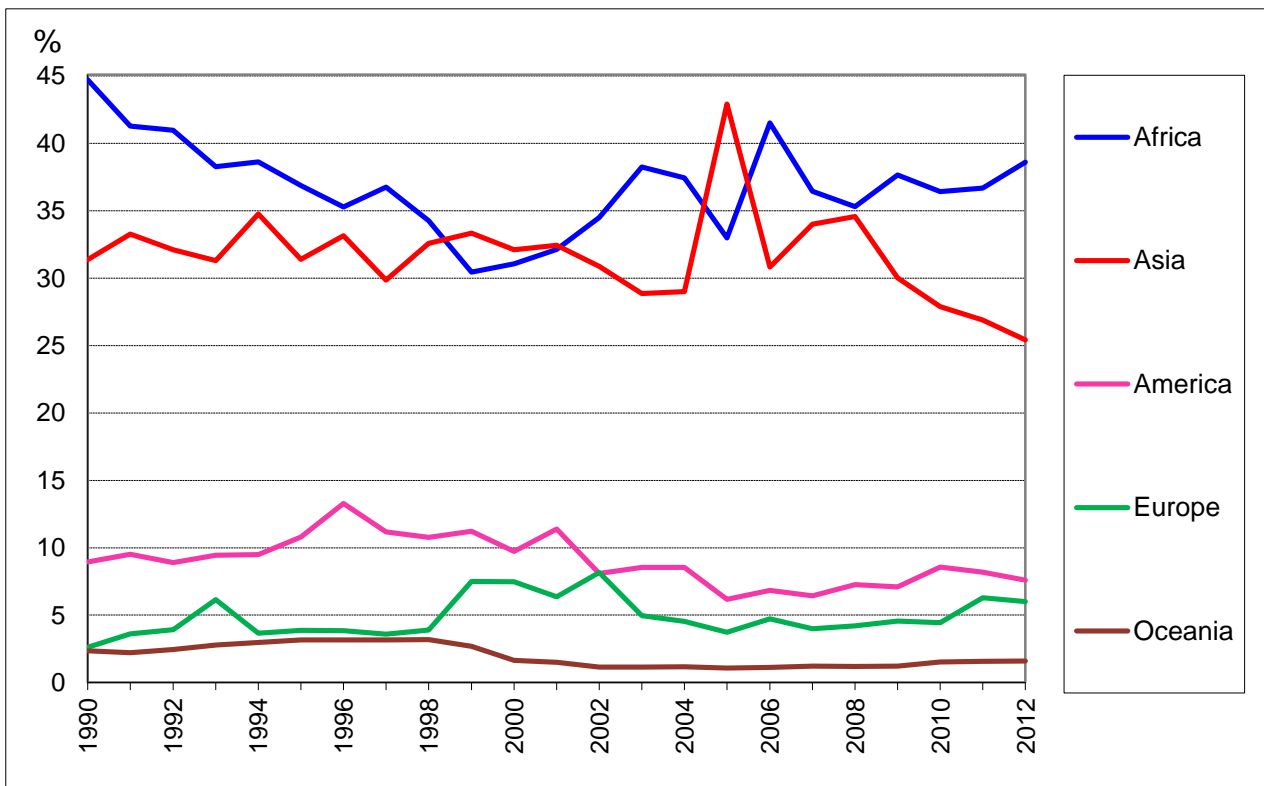
1.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2012

As a percentage of total ODA



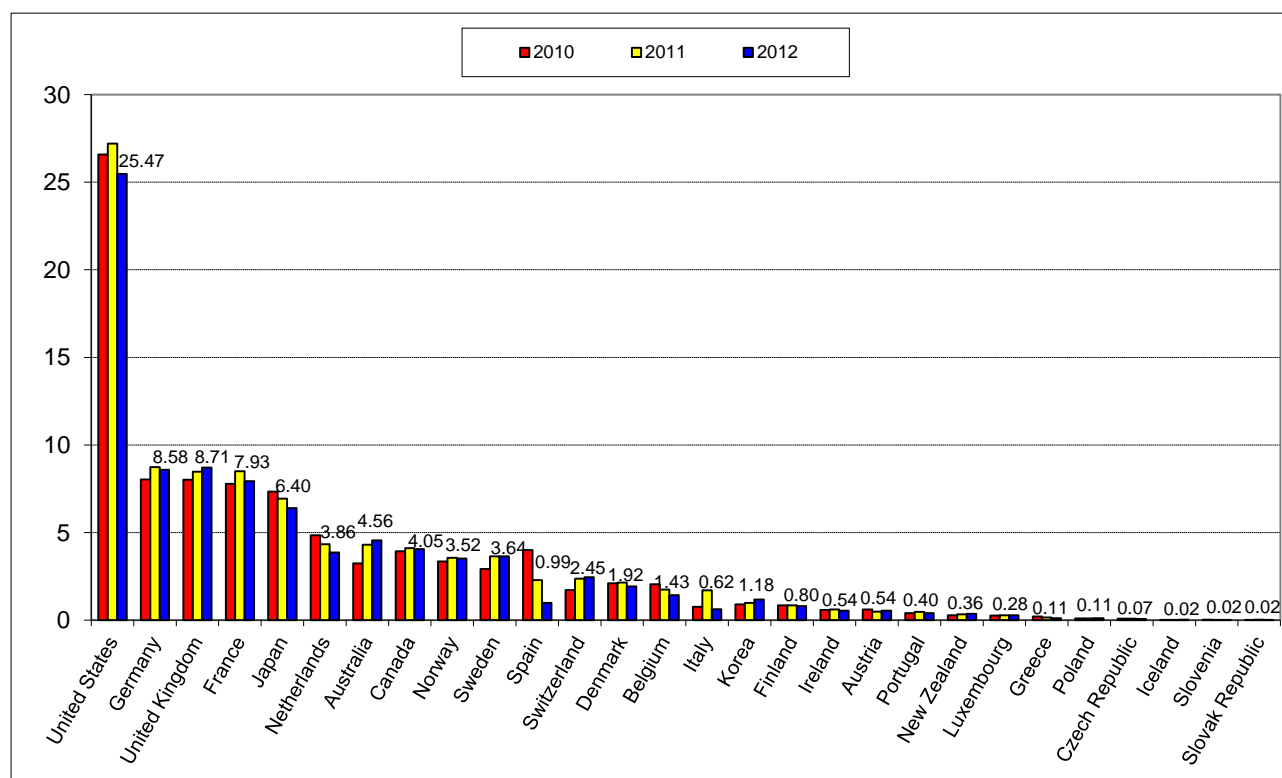

USD billion, values shown for 2012, net bilateral disbursements



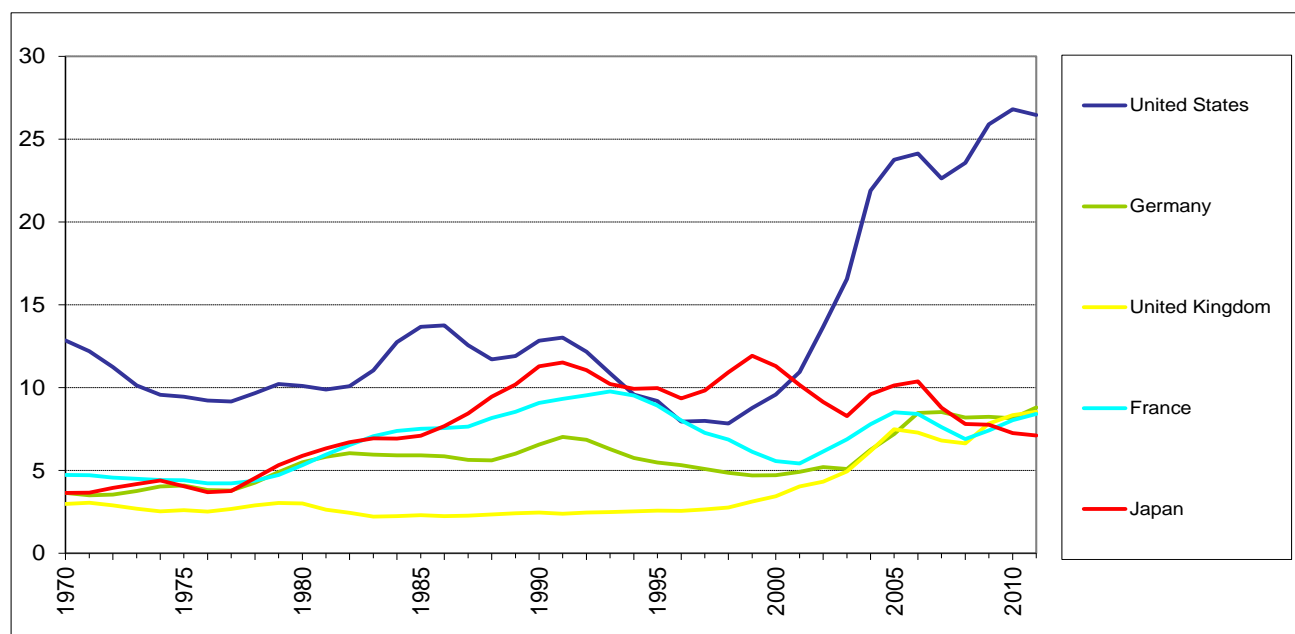

1.2.4. ODA by largest bilateral donors since 1970

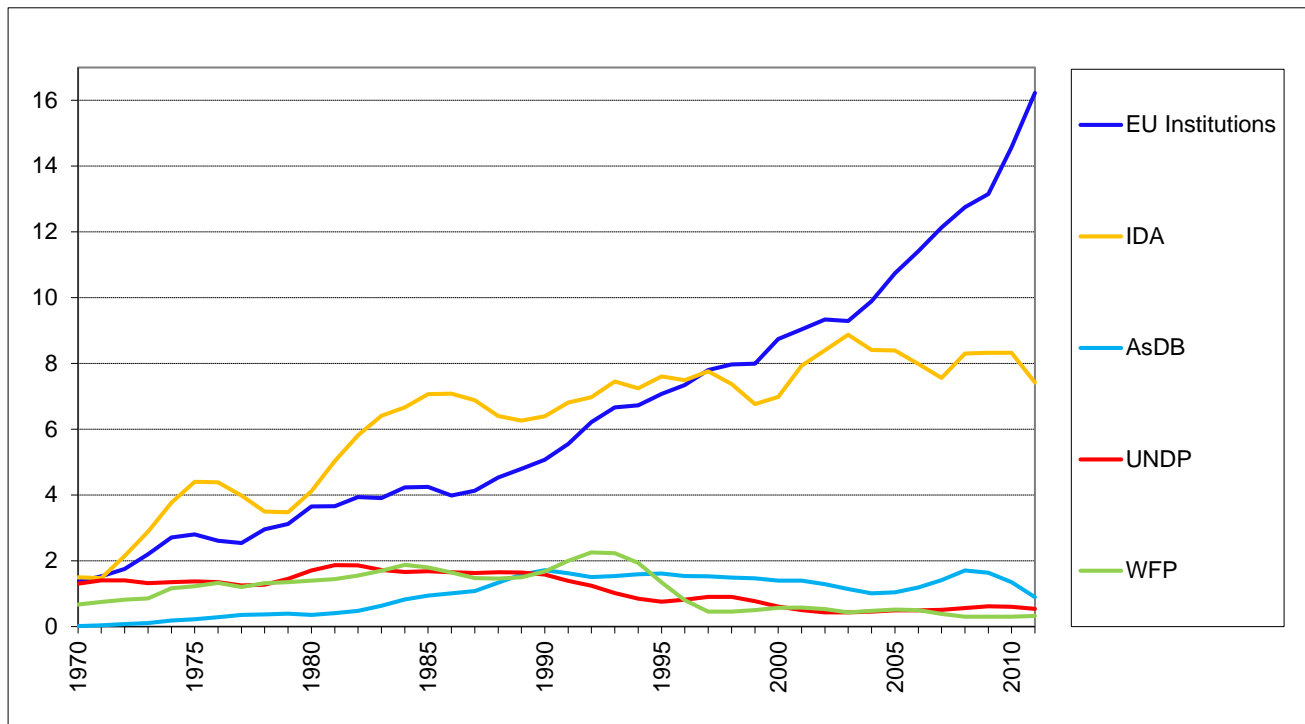

USD billion, 2012 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net disbursements



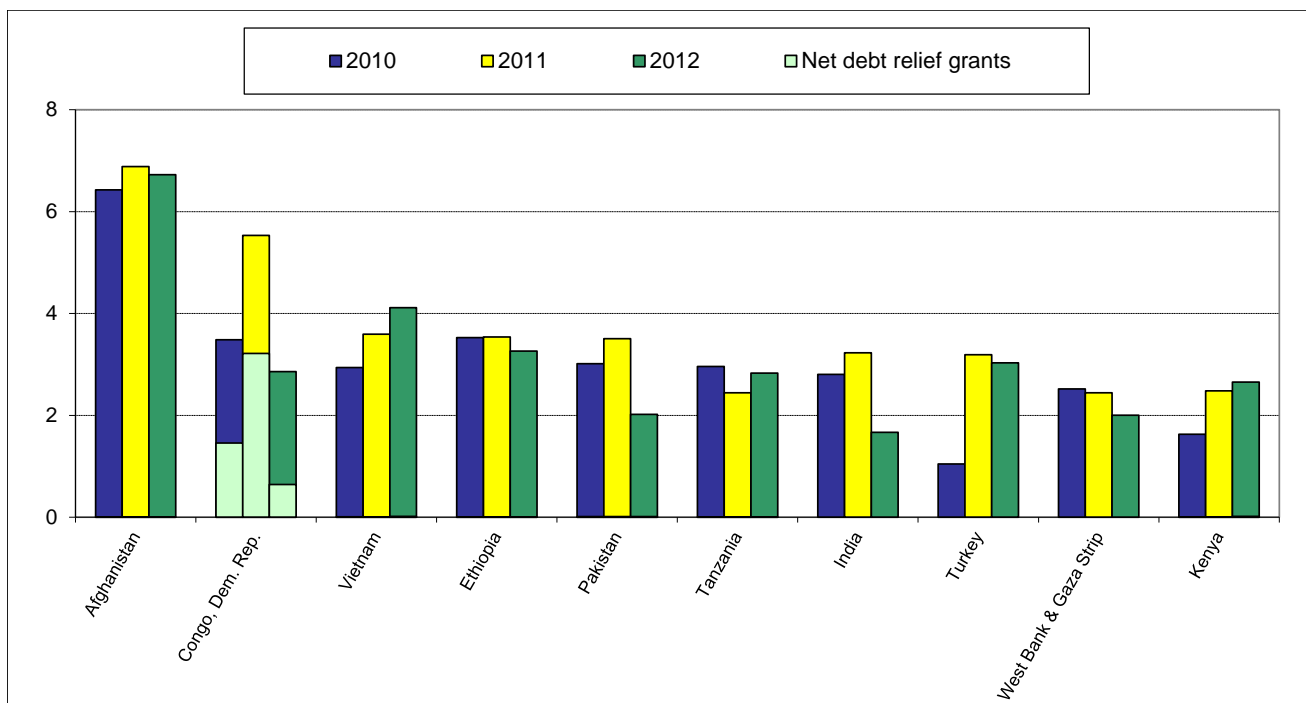

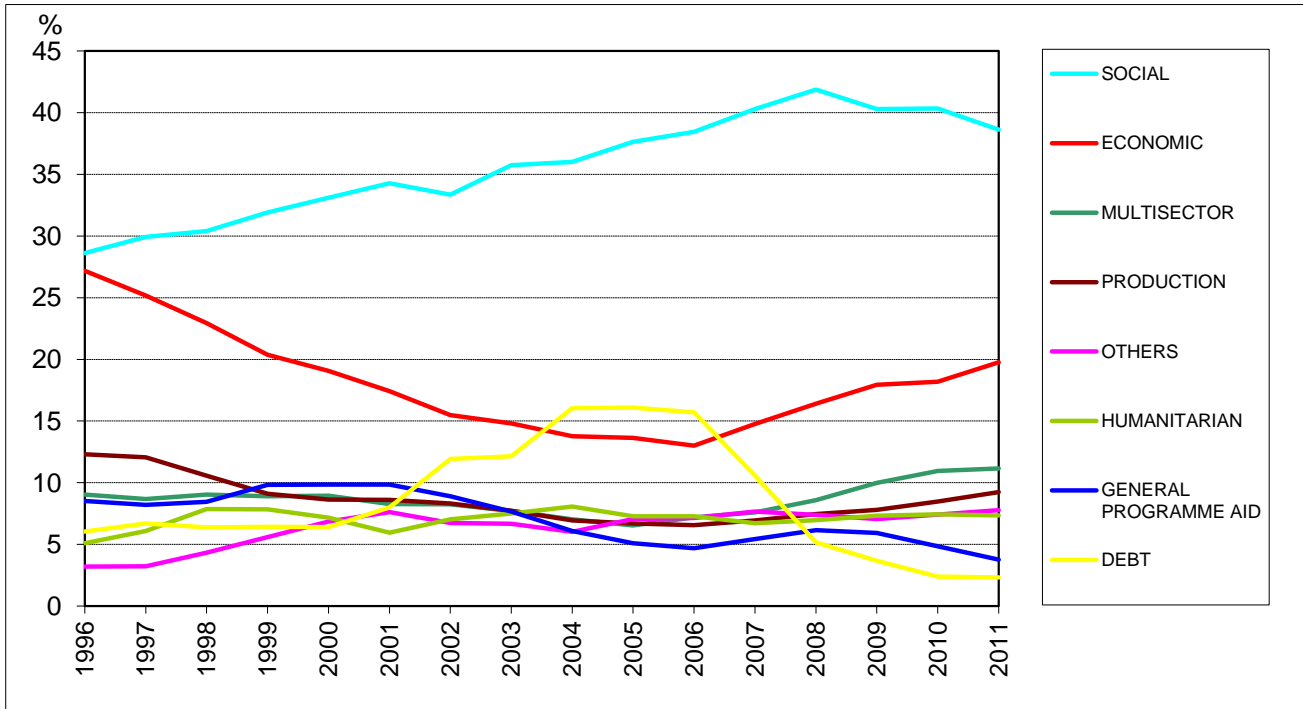
1.2.10. Trends in aid to largest recipients since 1970
USD billion, 2011 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net ODA receipts



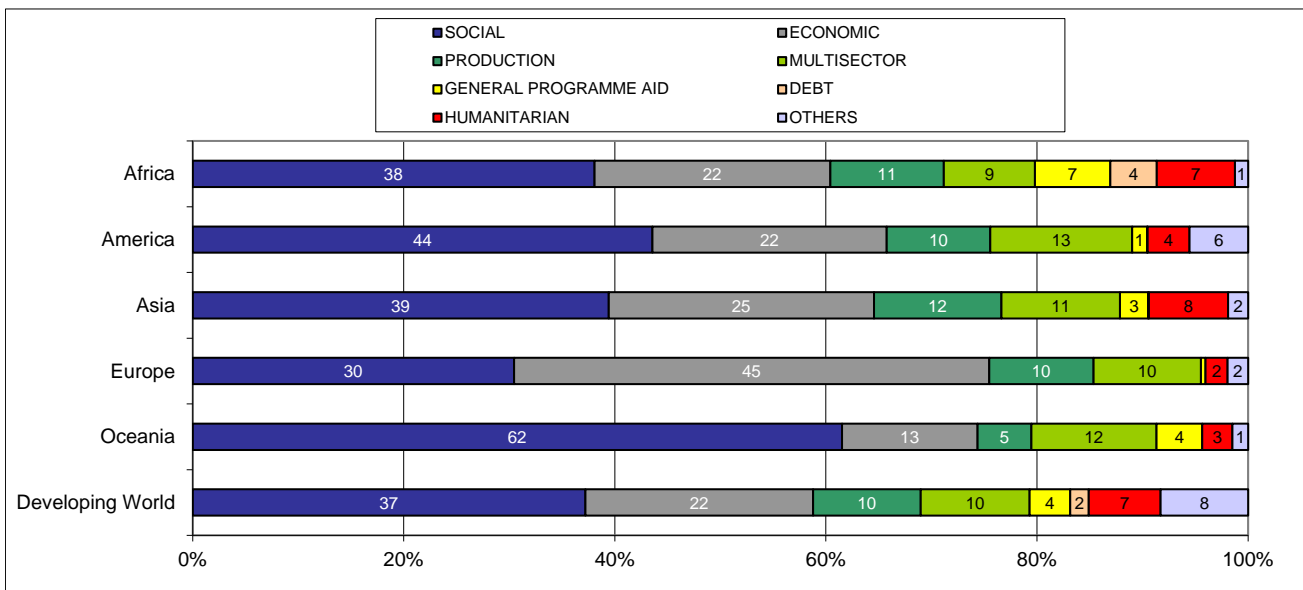

As a percentage of total ODA for each region

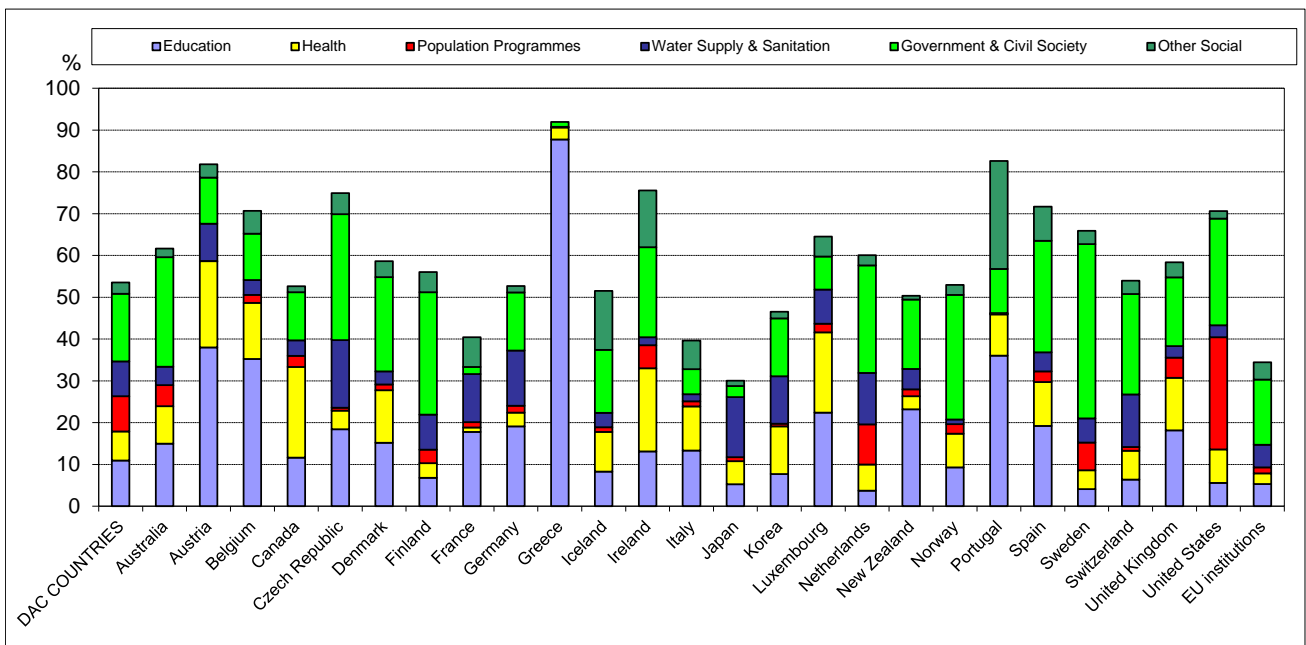

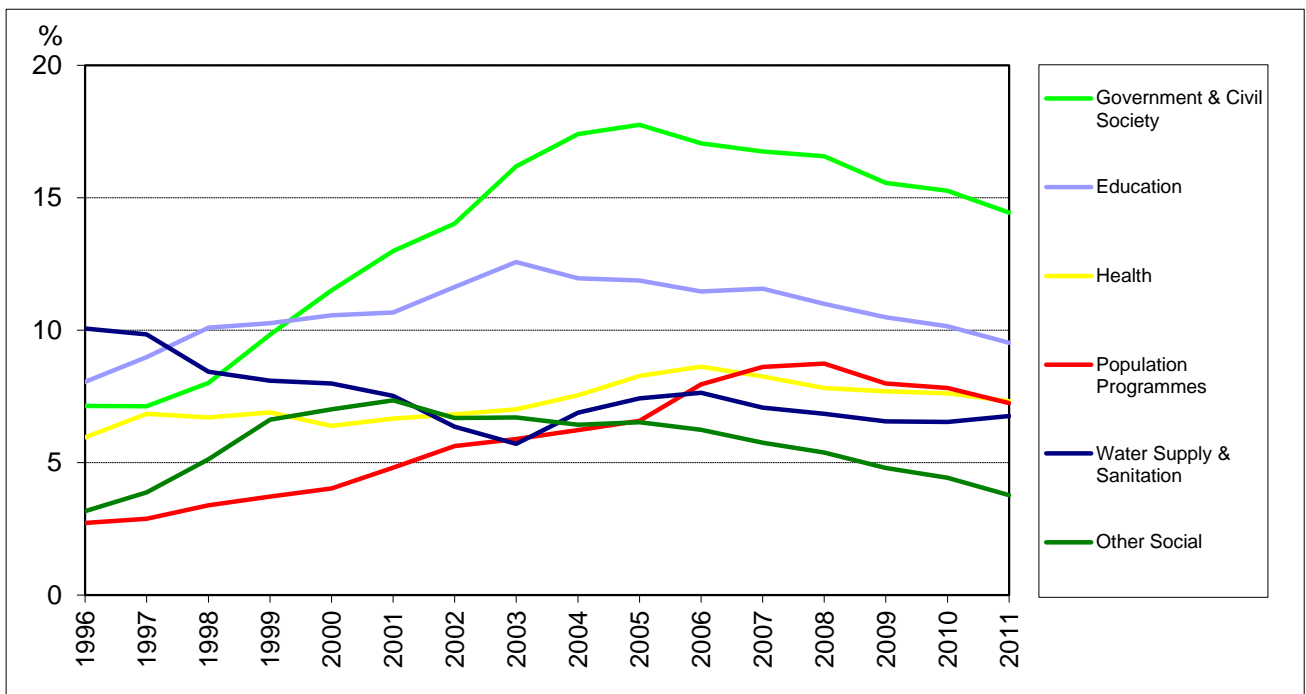

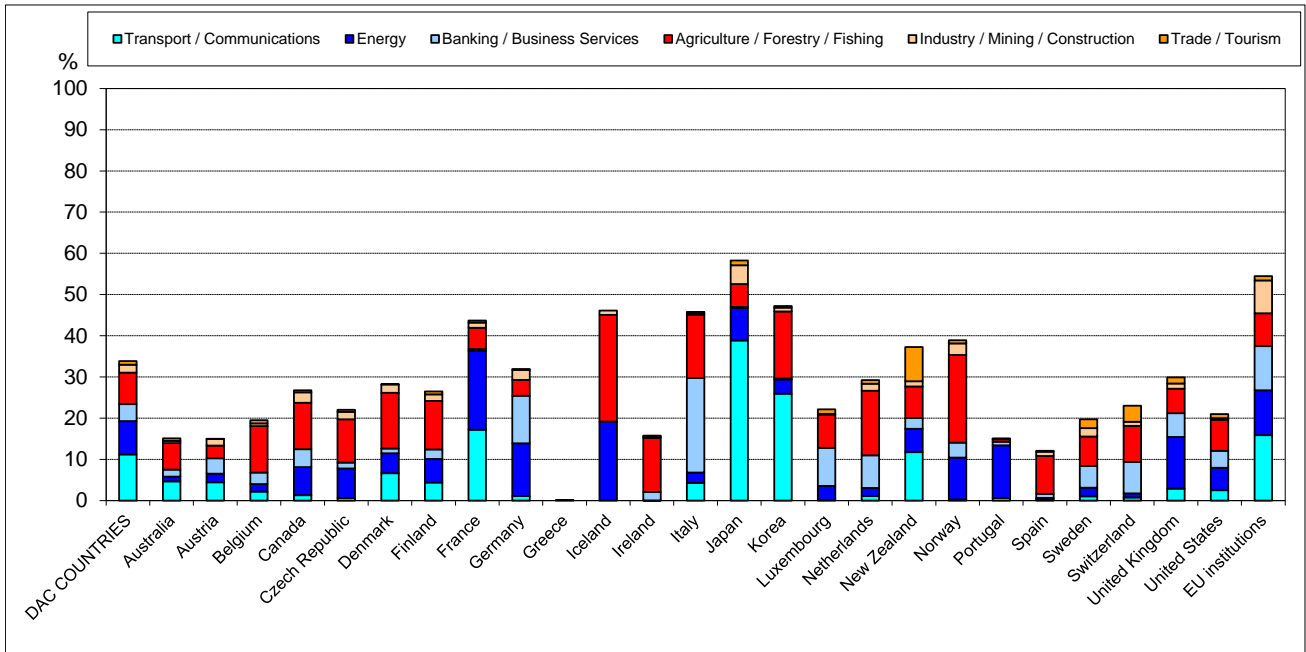
1.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA by donor
As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2012



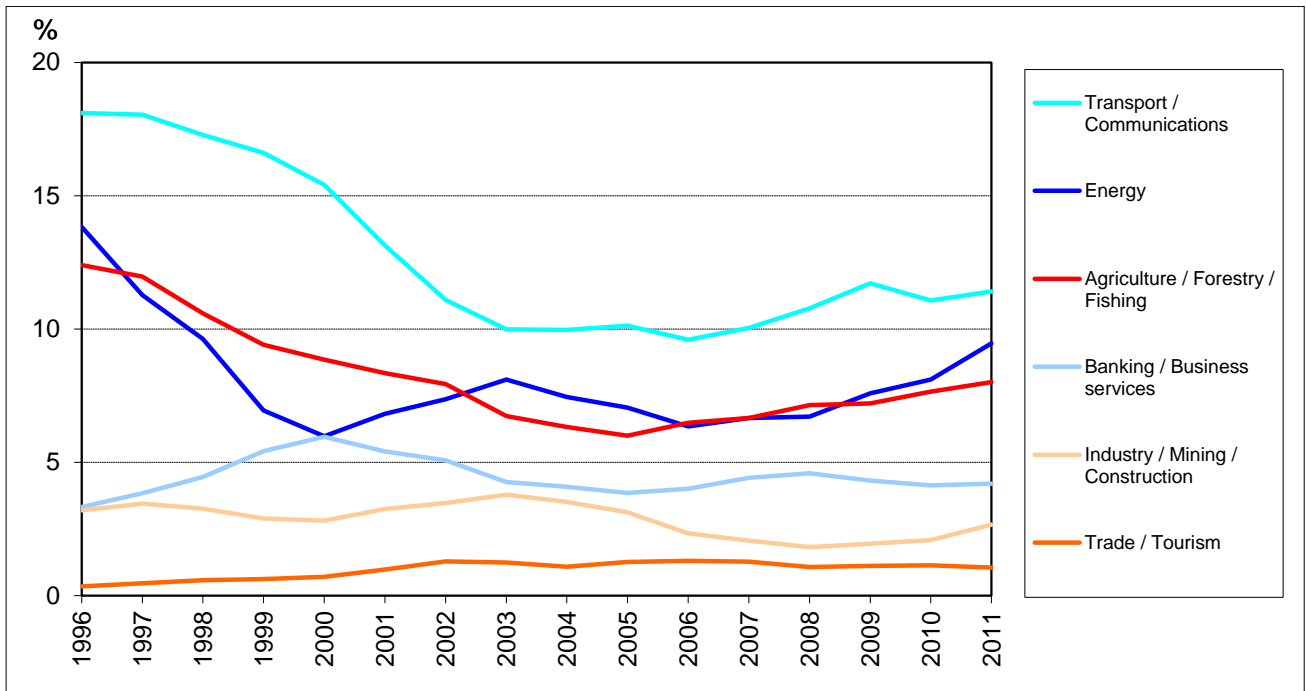
1.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA since 1995

As a percentage of total sector-allocable ODA, 3-year average commitments



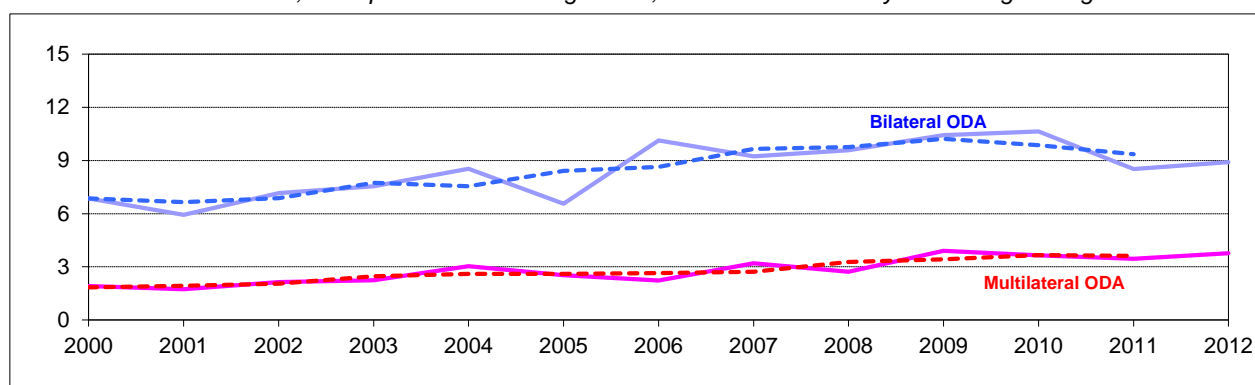

USD billion, 2011 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving average

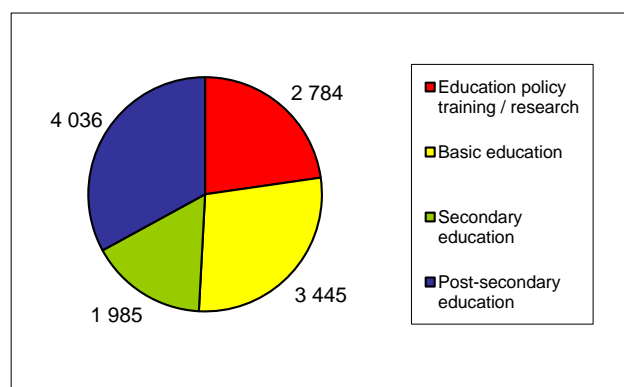

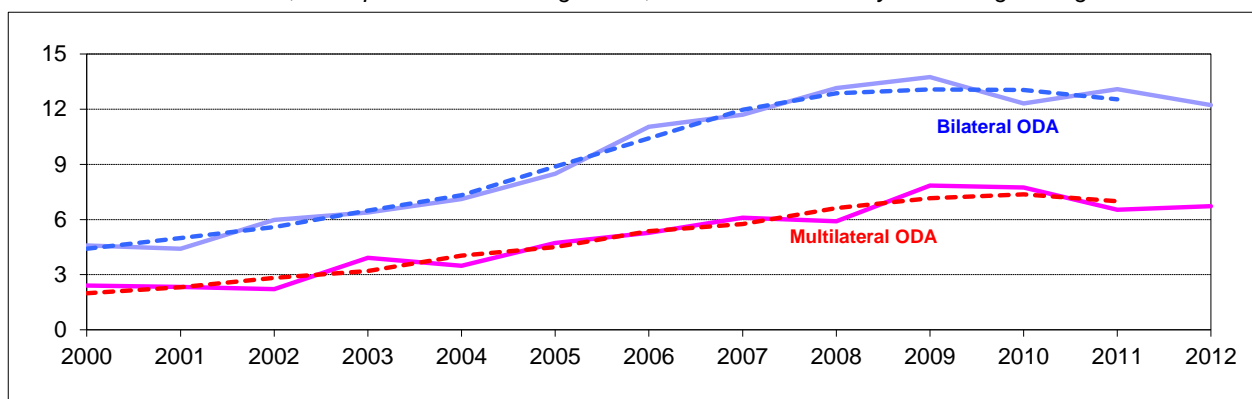

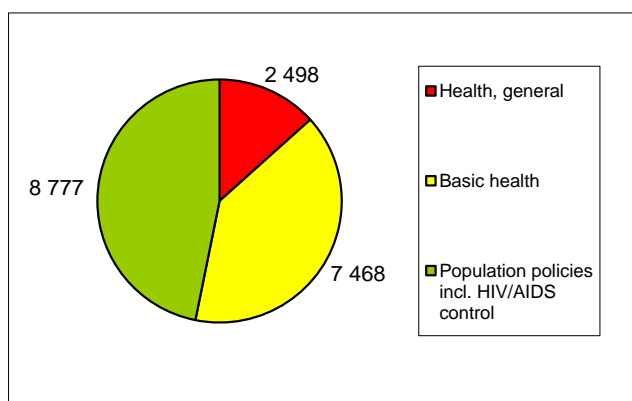

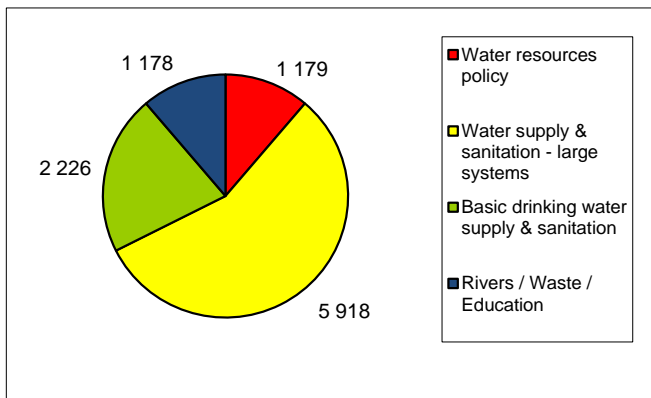
