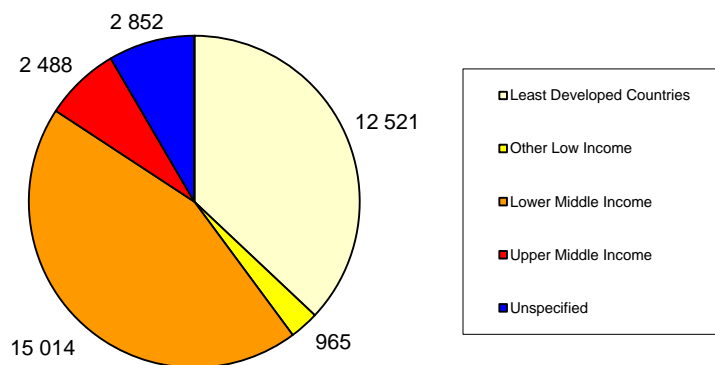

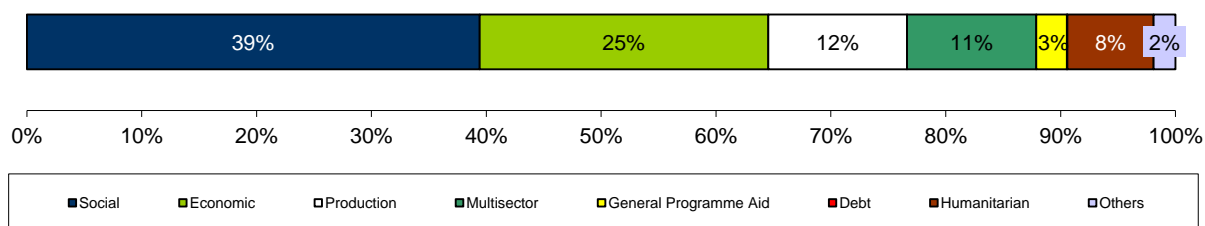
4.1.4. ODA by income group USD million, 2012, net disbursements

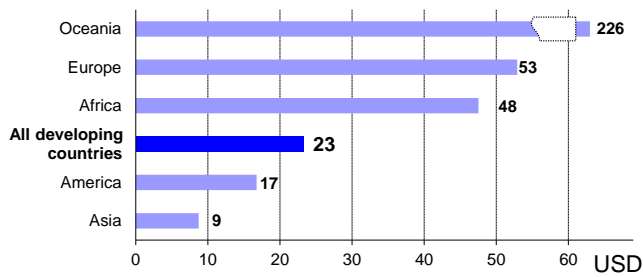

4.1.5. Sectors in 2012 commitments



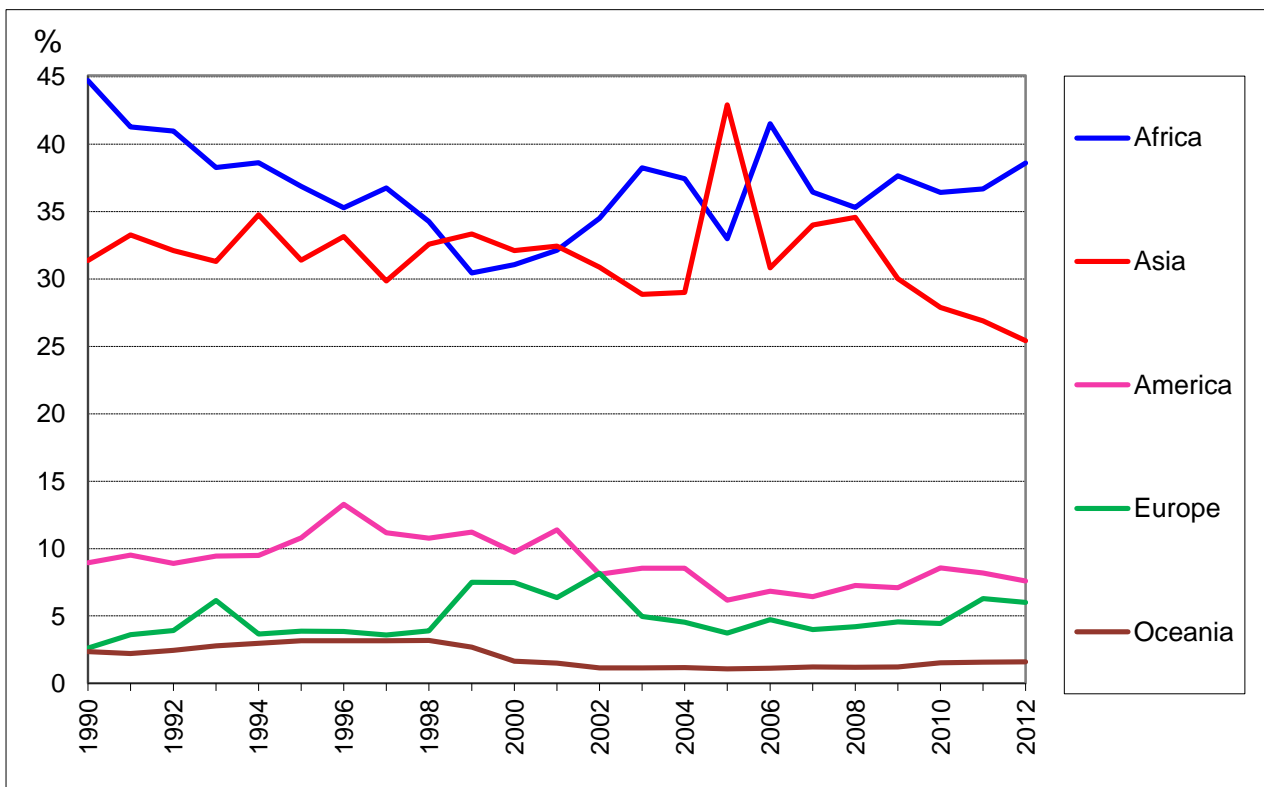
4.1.6. Net ODA receipts per person in 2012

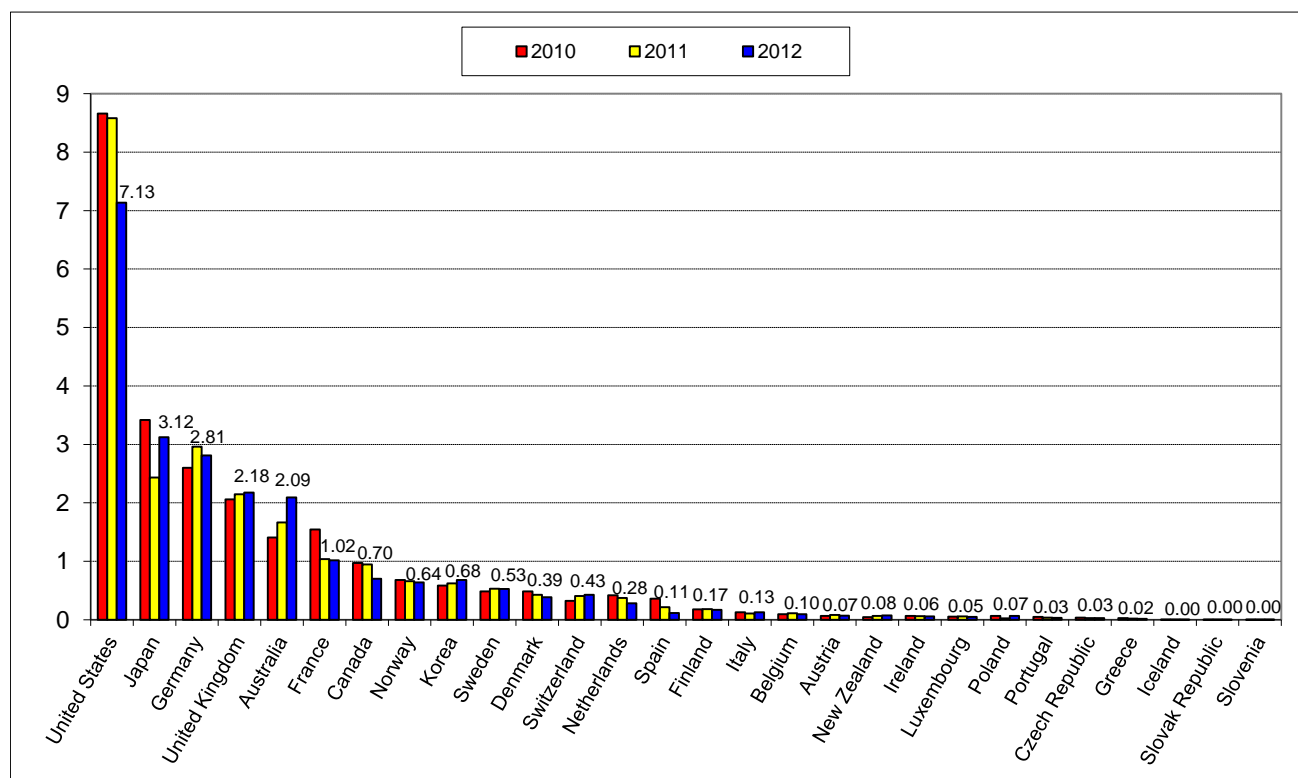

USD billion, values shown for 2012, net bilateral disbursements



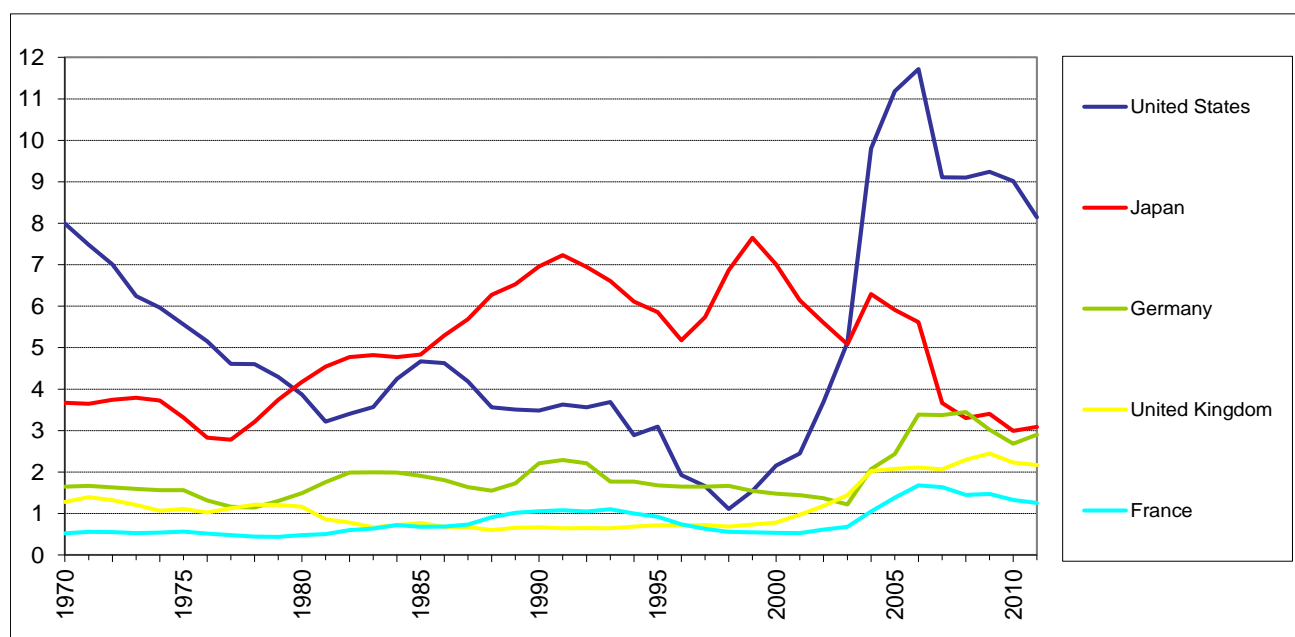

4.2.4. ODA to Asia by largest bilateral donors since 1970

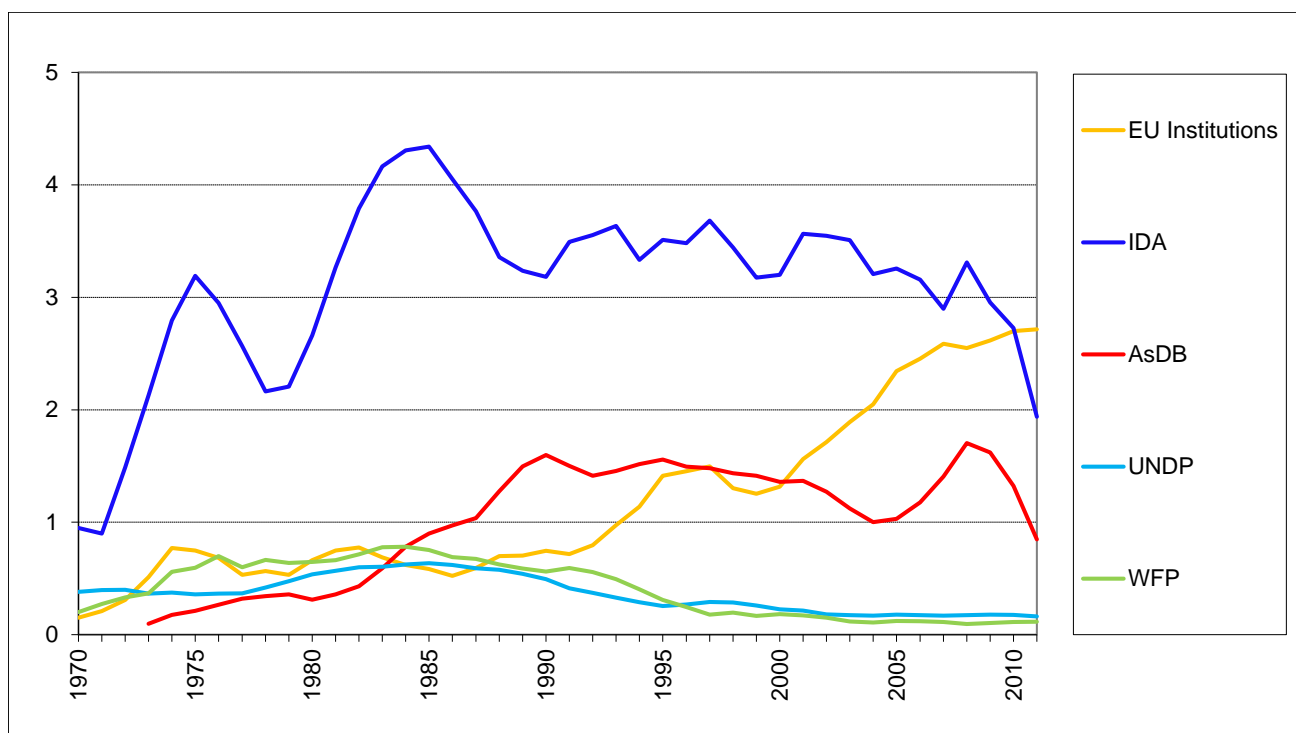
USD billion, 2012 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net bilateral disbursements

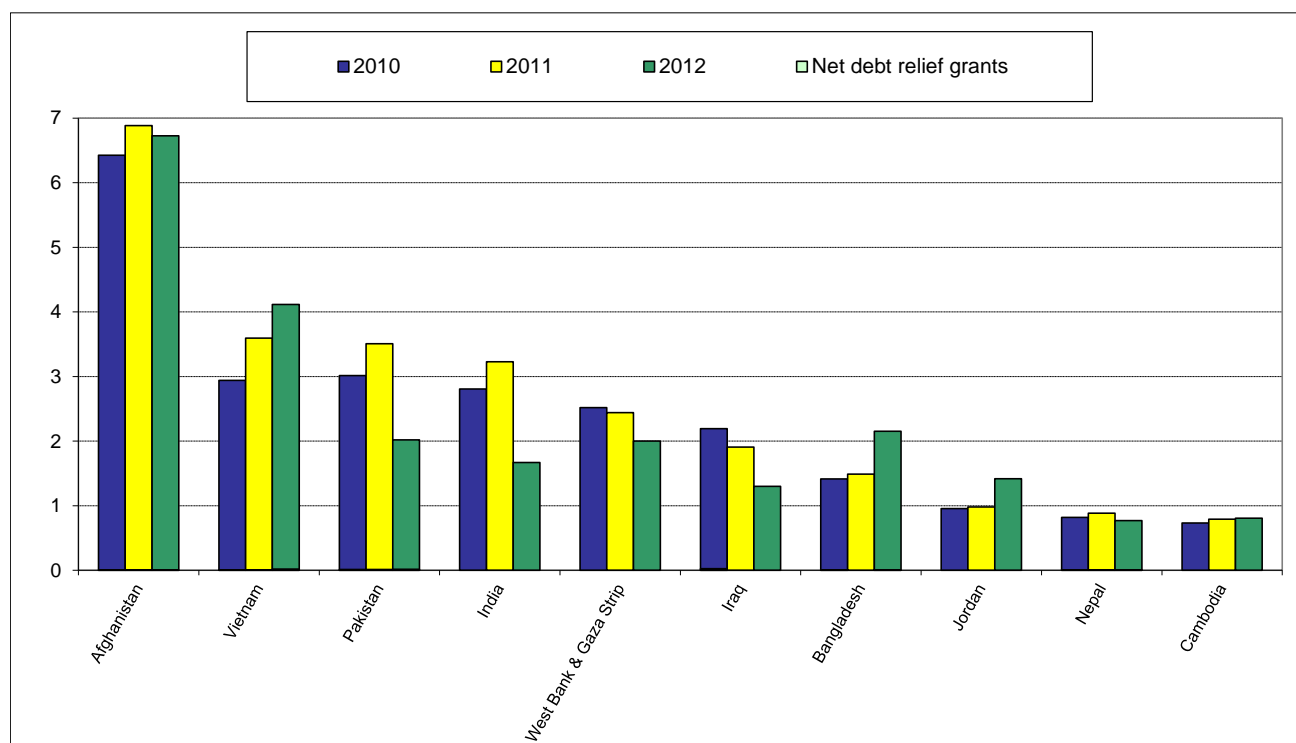
4.2.6. ODA to Asia by largest multilateral donors since 1970

USD billion, 2011 prices and exchange rates, 3-year average net ODA receipts

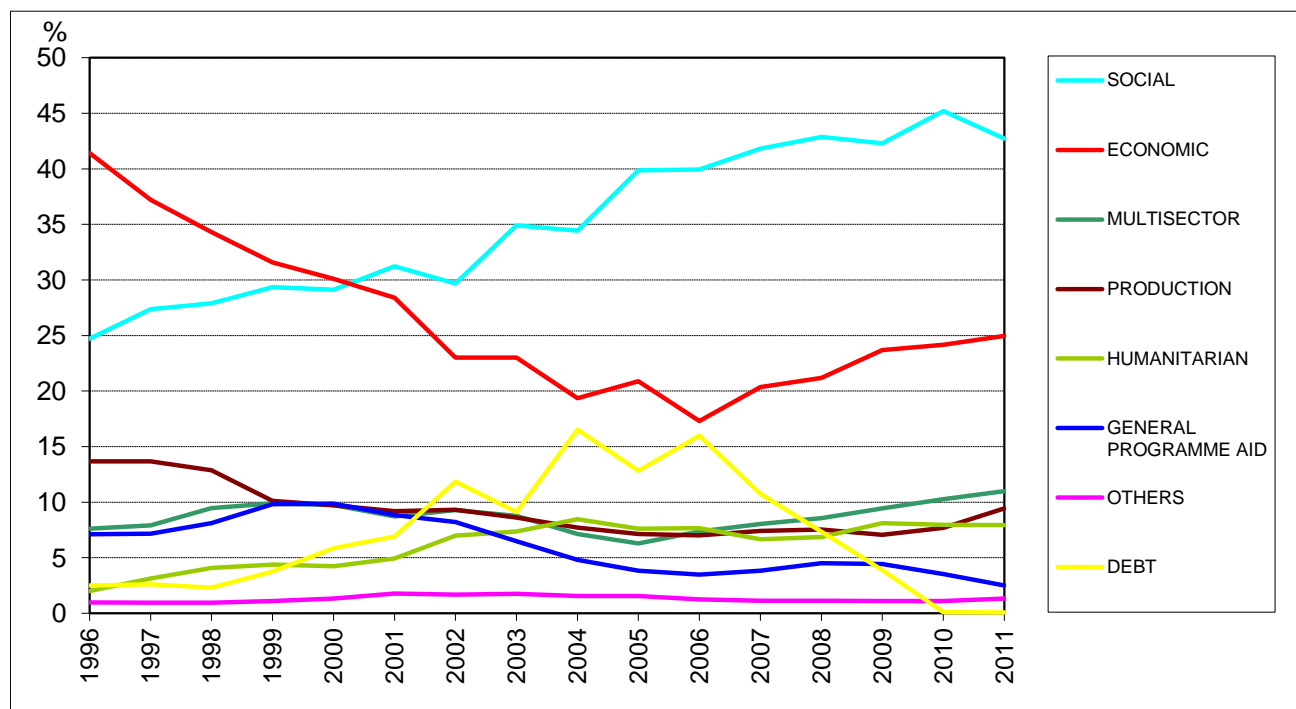

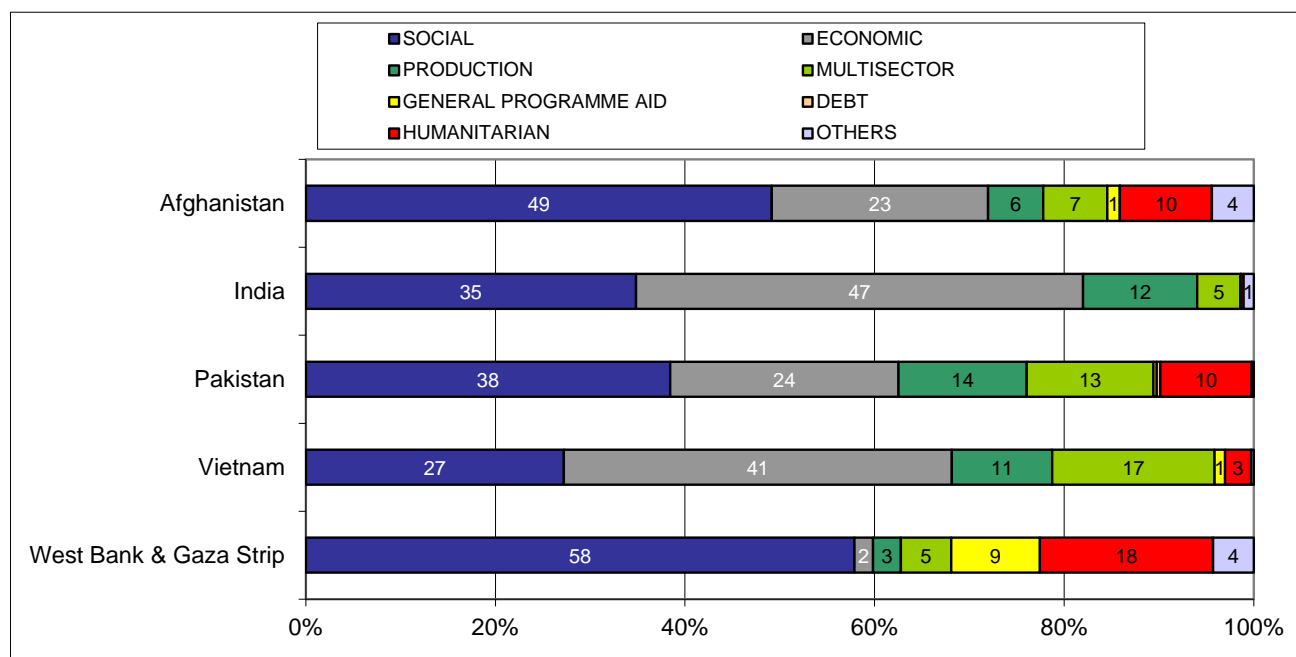
4.3.1. ODA to Asia by sector since 1996

As a percentage of total ODA committed for each country



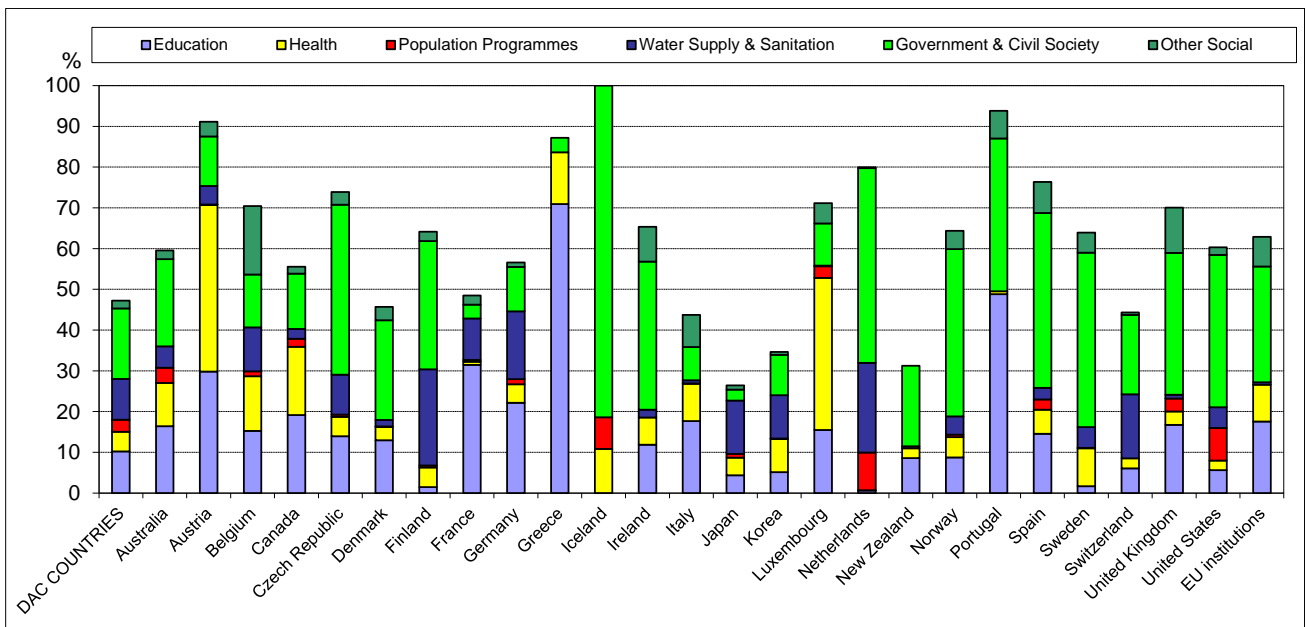

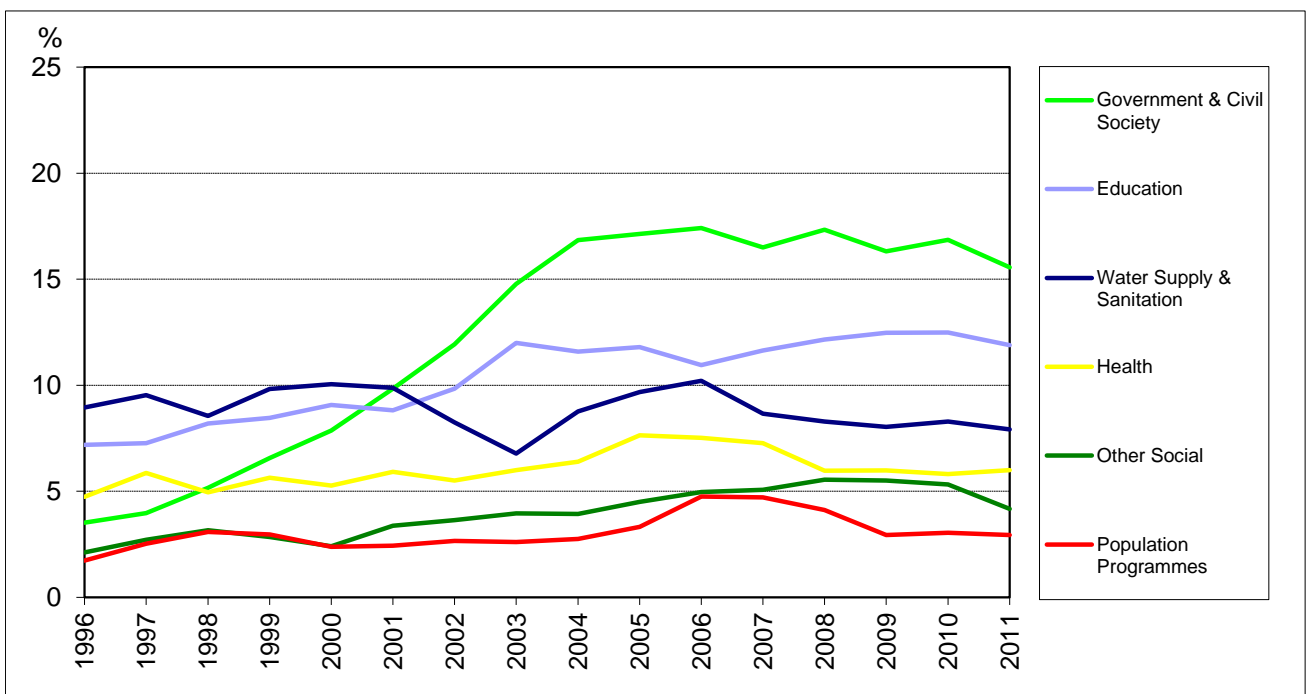

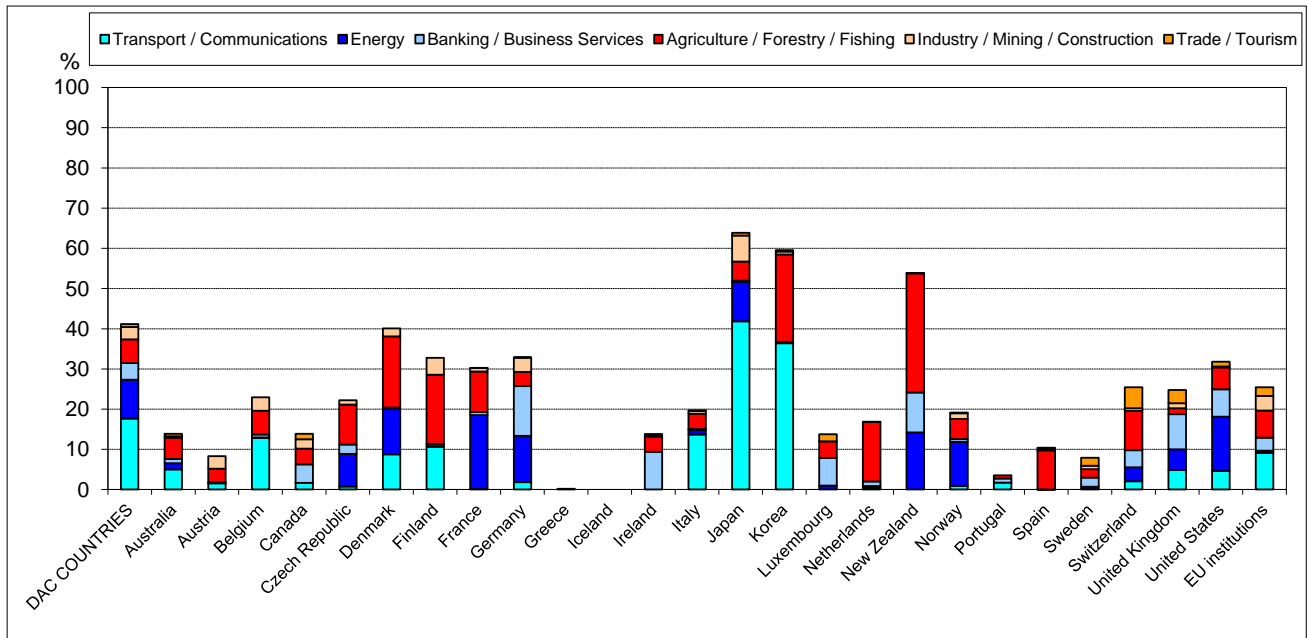
4.3.4. Analysis of social sector ODA to Asia by donor
As a percentage of total sector-allocable commitments for each donor in 2012



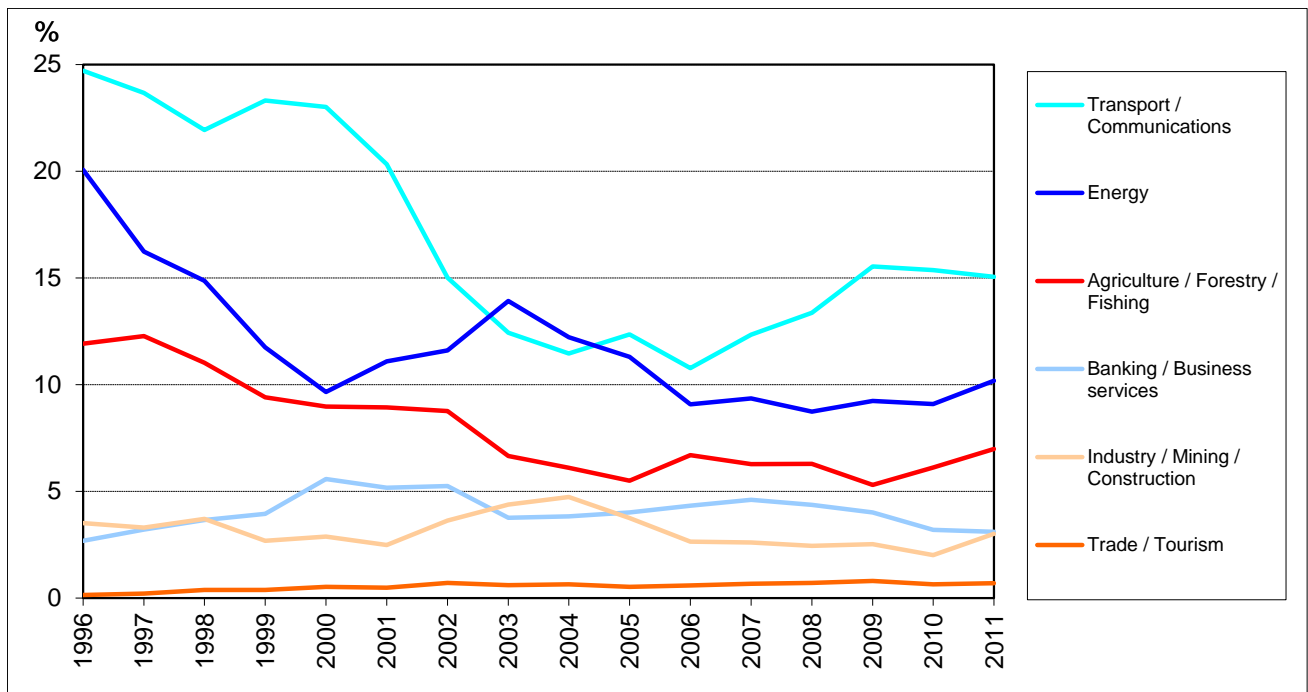
4.3.5. Analysis of social sector ODA to Asia since 1996

As a percentage of total sector-allocable ODA, 3-year average commitments



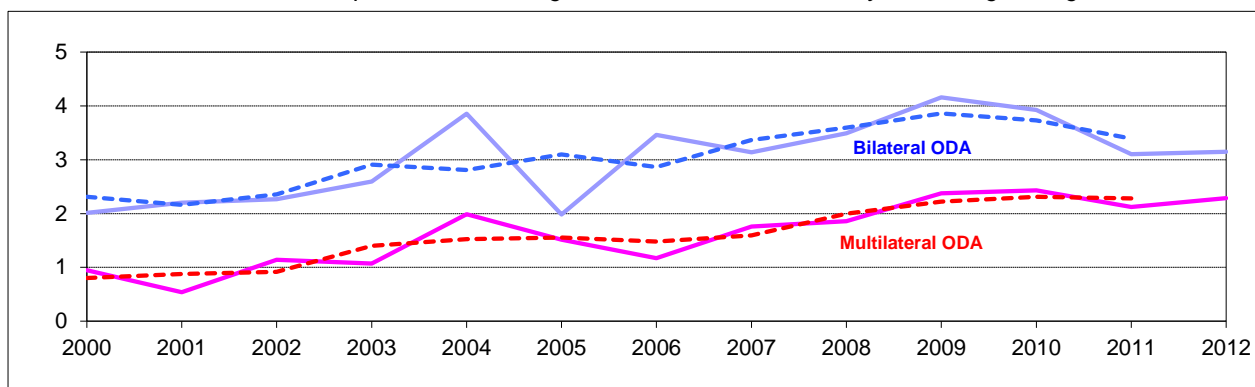

USD billion, 2011 prices and exchange rates, commitments with 3 year moving averages

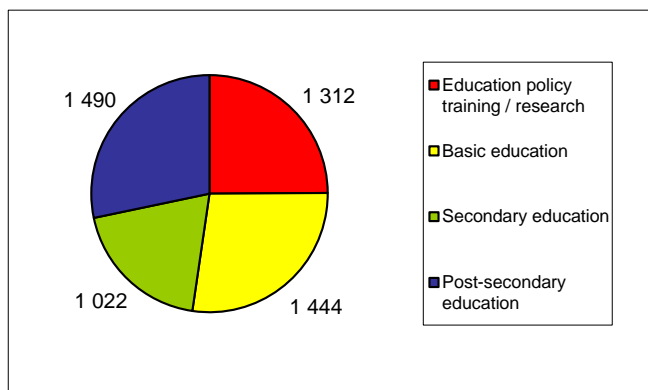

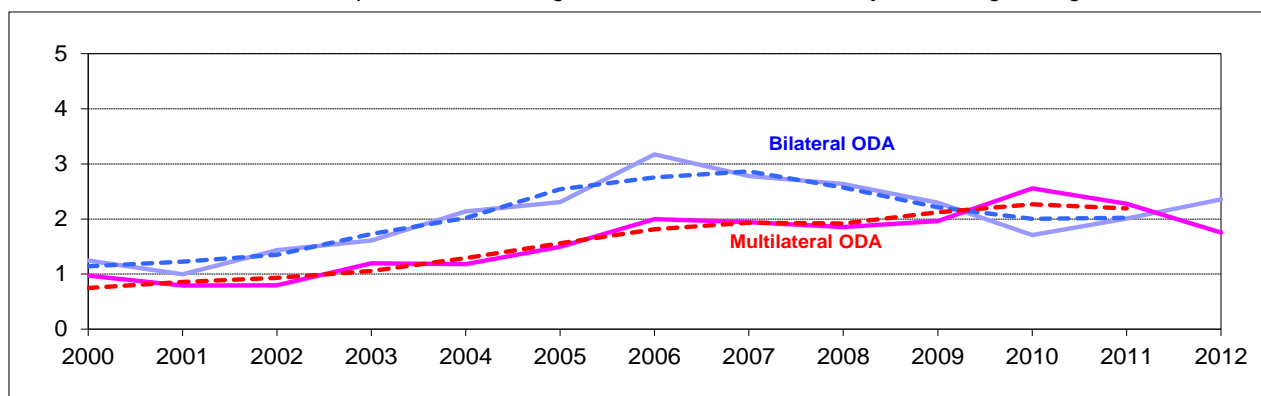

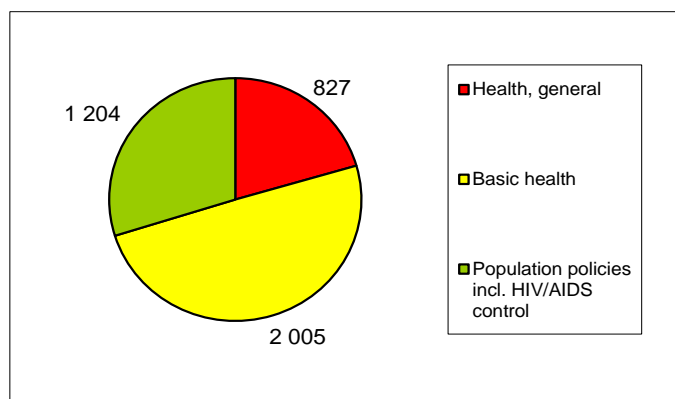

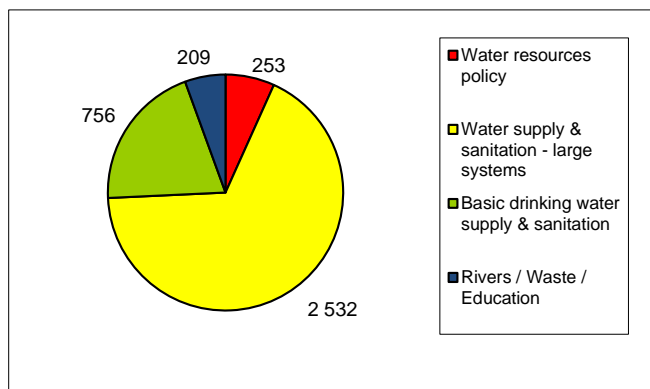
